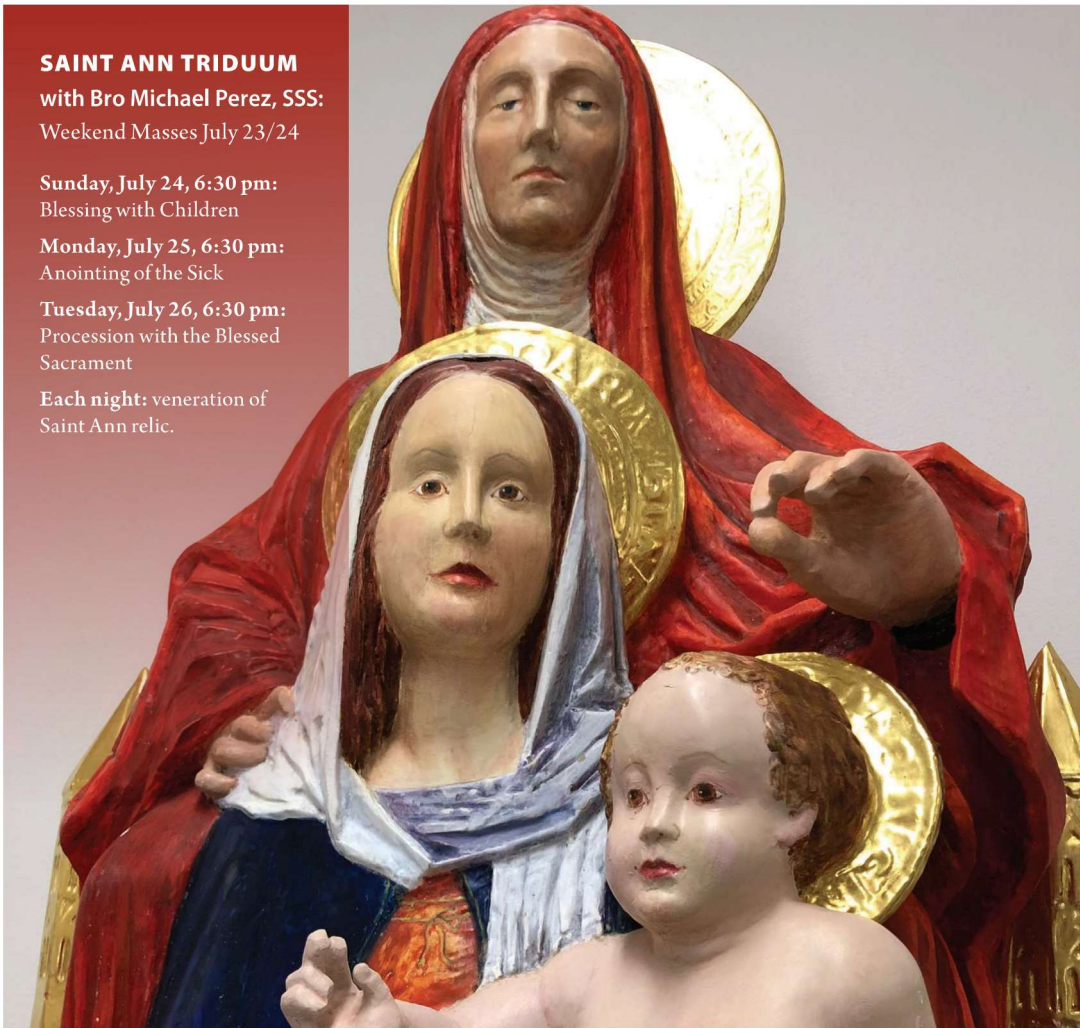

OUR PARISH LIFE

As we journey through the Gospel of Luke this year, at least the last three weeks have focused on discipleship. This week's passage almost seems to be an aside, telling us about Jesus' visit to the home of Martha and Mary. Yet, if we reflect on it a little, we can become aware that Luke is trying to teach his community about discipleship.

Begun in 2021, Ohio General Assembly established a new program whereby Ohioans can receive a 100% tax credit against Ohio income tax liability for cash contributions to certified organizations that grant scholarships to students, including those attending Catholic schools. The maximum credit amount is currently \$750 (\$1,500 if married filing jointly).

Who will benefit from this Scholarship Tax-Credit Program?

The program will benefit Ohio Catholic schools and students by prioritizing scholarships for low-income families that seek higher-quality education opportunities for their children. It will also offer taxpayers the ability to reduce their Ohio state tax liability by making a contribution to Scholarship Granting Organizations such as the Scholarship Granting Organization of the Catholic Community Foundation ("Angel Scholarship Fund"). This is a dollar-for-dollar tax credit against your tax liability, or the tax you owe to the State of Ohio.

What is the Angel Scholarship Fund?

The Catholic Community Foundation has established The Angel Scholarship Fund as a Scholarship Granting Organization to support our Catholic Schools and students in the Diocese of Cleveland. Begun in 2021, it is possible to "turn tax dollars into tuition" by making a charitable contribution to the Angel Scholarship Fund that is eligible for a 100% tax credit on the donor's 2022 State of Ohio income tax return. The maximum credit amount is currently \$750 (\$1,500 if married filing jointly).

Can my contribution be directed to the school of my choice?

While low-income families will be prioritized, the intent of the Angel Scholarship Fund is to offer donors the option of making:

- An undesignated contribution that supports schools and students across the Diocese of Cleveland based on financial need; or,
- A contribution that is designated to benefit students at a specific Catholic school.

May I designate my payment to a specific student?

As a 501(c)(3) organization, the Angel Scholarship Fund does not accept contributions that are designated for specific students. However, you may direct your contribution to students of one or more Catholic schools in the Diocese of Cleveland. You can find a list of schools at www.dioceseofcleveland.org/schools.

Who can contribute to the Angel Scholarship Fund?

Any Ohio taxpayer, single or married, with an Ohio tax liability.

Is the amount I claim a tax deduction?

Angel Scholarship Fund donors will receive a dollar-for-dollar state tax credit up to \$750, which is different from a tax deduction. Tax deductions reduce your taxable income. A tax credit is a dollar-for-dollar credit against the taxes paid to the State of Ohio. The funds are directed to the Angel Scholarship Fund rather than to the state.

Mary & Martha

Have you ever had a day in which nothing you did was right? That seems to be how Martha felt in today's Gospel. For the modern audience, everything Martha does in the story seems correct. And the ancient audience would have agreed. Martha welcomes Jesus into her house and does exactly what a woman in ancient Palestine would have done; she waits on him and offers appropriate hospitality. In many parts of the Greco-Roman Empire this was standard procedure. Men in the household would visit with the guests, but women not as commonly. So, based on the standards of her own culture, Martha is justified in being angry at her sister, Mary. After all, this is her house. Martha's plea to Jesus as a religious teacher suggests that she expects him to agree with her and conventional wisdom.

But, as is the case many times in his ministry, Jesus surprises everyone. Instead of affirming Martha's concern and conventional gender roles of the time, Jesus admonishes Martha for her anxiety over such matters and affirms Mary for her attentive listening and courage. Mary has risked disapproval in order to listen to the teacher; she has positioned herself so as to focus on him and learn. Jesus is not condemning Martha as much as he is trying to teach her, pointing out that being "anxious and worried" (Lk 10:41) is blocking her – not only from listening, but perhaps also from performing heartfelt service. He hopes for Martha to recognize the lesson that Mary already has learned; the presence of God's Kingdom trumps daily concerns and conventional wisdom. *Sourcebook for Pastoral Liturgy @ 2022.*

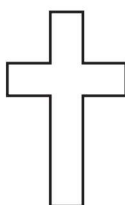
