OUR PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

BACK FROM VACATION: Thank you for your prayers and well wishes while I was away in the Boston area (New England) with family and DC with friends, some even being former parishioners who now live there. Seeing the historical sites in both cities and remembering our history at the many museums in our nation's capital, reawakened in me a sense of the Christian journey and our struggles through the ages. I hope to bring some of these tidbits to my preaching in the coming weeks.

CELEBRATING EYMARD & HIS READINGS: This weekend, we pause the universal calendar to recognize our own parish calendar celebration. Last week, we remembered our beloved Saint Ann and this weekend, Saint Peter Julian Eymard. With a religious order presiding over the administration of this parish from the beginning, we are blessed each year, near the solemnity of the founder of that order (August 2), to celebrate the great saint, Peter Julian Eymard. Peter Julian's years are formative: 1811-1868. Think of our own country and what we were going through. Think of the world stage and the coming of age in new thoughts, *Les Miserable* and the social changes. There was upheaval in theology and tremendous movements of peoples to cities due to the need for new work: a movement from a rural culture to urban, religious to secular ways. These changes are still occurring in our society and therefore, during this weekend and Eymard Triduum, we remember that it is the Eucharist that is our compass to guide us through the difficult changes in life. We are having our SSS Associates Mary Muehle and Jim Brown reflect on Saint Peter Julian's life, this weekend, based on these readings:

- Acts 4:32-35 – They were of one mind and heart
- Psalm 34 – Taste and see the Goodness of the LORD
- 1 John 4:7-16 – God loved us first
- John 15:1-8 – The one who remains in me will bear much fruit.

Jim will preach Monday and Tuesday night and on the actual solemnity, Tuesday morning Mass at 9:00 AM. **May we grow in the oneness of the Eucharist to bear fruit!**

WHY IS OUR PARISH NAMED FOR A DIFFERENT SAINT? Each year on this solemnity of Saint Eymard the question arises, "Why didn't our parish get named after the founder of the Congregations of the Blessed Sacrament who serve this parish?" Before the Second Vatican Council (1962-1965), parishes could only be named after existing saints and not "blessed," or "servants of God," those in the process of becoming saints. The naming process relaxed and now it would be possible, with some new parishes choosing names for great Catholic witnesses like Dorothy Day, who is in the process now. Because Eymard was only "Blessed Peter Julian Eymard" in 1953, Saint Paschal Baylon, another saint of the Eucharist, was chosen.

For those who do not know the story, Brother Paschal Jette, who later became Father Donald Jette, our third pastor, suggested the name to the provincial and pastor, who later suggested it to the bishop who liked the name and connection to the Eucharist.



EUCCHARISTIC REVIVAL: Having time to focus on the "Apostle of the Eucharist," Saint Peter Julian Eymard and our other patron saint, our parish name, we realize how fortunate we are to have these two saints guiding our parish's life, our Eucharistic life. From the beginning of the parish's founding, we were to focus on Eucharistic living. That's why it is so sad that our nation is in the midst of having to have a Eucharistic revival – encouraging people to believe or reconnect with the Eucharistic mystery. From Mass attendance to prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, folks are not participating or believing in the Risen Presence of Christ in their midst. In 2019, the Pew Research Center reported that 32 percent of Catholics in the United States believe in the True Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. The study's findings sparked much debate in the church, including among the bishops of the United States. We had public rebukes of those who should not receive Holy Communion. This led to a clear focus last year from the US bishops: catechesis, celebration of Mass and prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. During its meeting last November, the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops voted 201 to 17 to approve a three-year Eucharistic revival. It will culminate in a National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis in 2024. For now, our parish will continue to be a great beacon of Eucharistic living – reviving our own spirit through worshipping together and praying around the clock with the presence of the Risen Christ to be the Body of Christ in a world of unbelievers. May we always be what we receive: the Body of Christ – Amen!

COMMUNION ON THE TONGUE? During the heart of the pandemic, the Office of Worship for the Diocese of Cleveland suspended the practice of reception of Holy Communion on the tongue. This was to make sure that possible moisture would not transmit to the Communion Minister and then transfer to other hosts. Recently, the practice of reception on the tongue returned. Some Communion Ministers are not comfortable in participating in distributing in this way; we ask for your respect of their wishes and kindly find the

line of the priest to share the Body of Christ in this way. We recommend that if you wish to receive on the tongue that you wait to be last in the section's line; this way the minister will not have to sanitize their hands before distributing to other members of the congregation. With cases continuing to fluctuate, we appreciate your kind assistance in keeping all healthy.

ASSISTANCE IN OUR BEREAVEMENT MINISTRY: Barb Curran from the Church of Saint Clare, one of the long-time leaders in our Bereavement Ministry, is moving. We are so grateful for her dedication and care for this ministry, being the co-leader in our cluster parish ministry. She is moving to be by grandchildren (well, and also her children ☺). We wish her and her husband, Mike, well in North Carolina. We are in need of a trained minister to assist in this special ministry to those who are grieving the loss of a loved one. If you have the background for this ministry, or are interested in walking with folks who have suffered the loss of a loved one, would you kindly consider assisting in this ministry? This ministry has met twice a year for 8 weeks of sessions, with others coming in to assist in their specific areas. We also lead a special Bereavement Mass together. Do you have a bit of background, but are in need of more training? We'll send you to the diocesan training session. Thanks for helping us continue this ministry!

SPECIAL SSS MEETINGS: From August 8-12, the Blessed Sacrament religious from around the country will be having our annual meeting to discern our future and elect new leadership. In previous times we would go to a retreat center elsewhere in the country. We are using our headquarters facilities here next to SPB. Our lay associates from around the country will also join us for a day. While Fr. Choy and Fr. Mike are away with me, we will have Father Leonard Cencula, a retired priest of the Diocese of Steubenville, serving. He will preside at the 9:00 AM Mass. Our lay associates will continue to lead Morning Prayer and Rosary as they do each day. Thanks again for praying for us!

CELEBRATING FATHER ROGER: Please reserve on your calendar a special Mass to celebrate Fr. Roger Bourgeois, SSS. He will be celebrating 70 years as a religious of the Blessed Sacrament and 65 years as an ordained priest. Fr. Roger has served our parish with three assignments over his 65 years, with this assignment since 1999. Fr. Roger serves as the chaplain to our Saint Ann Shrine and presides occasionally at our weekday and weekend Masses when not at nearby convents or nursing homes. He is such a blessing to us for all that he does to assist us in our faith. To honor him, we will have a special Mass on **Sunday, September 11 at 10:30** with a reception at the Ministry Fair. We thank the Ladies Guild in advance for their hosting of the reception during this time.

PARISH PICNIC NEWS: It is time for us to mark our calendars and finalize our parish picnic. Last year, we were able to have Mass on Green Knight Field and several

families brought baskets of food to eat on the lawn. This year, **Sunday, August 21**, we plan on Mass outside on Green Knight Field again, weather permitting at 10:30 AM. Then, gratefully, the Knights of Columbus from our parish and the other two parishes that make up the Gilmour Council (Saint Clare and Saint Francis), will be grilling hamburgers for us. The Youth Group, led by Evamarie, will have snow cones, popcorn, and children's games. Invite other family members and friends, neighbors and other SPB folks to join for this special coming home experience! This is part of our Eucharistic Revival and evangelization efforts to be who we say we are – the Body of Christ, a Eucharistic Community lived out here at SPB!

EXCITEMENT FOR THE FALL: We are planning a full Stewardship Campaign this September! Pray for your family and its time, talent, and treasure that it shares with us, the Body of Christ community here.

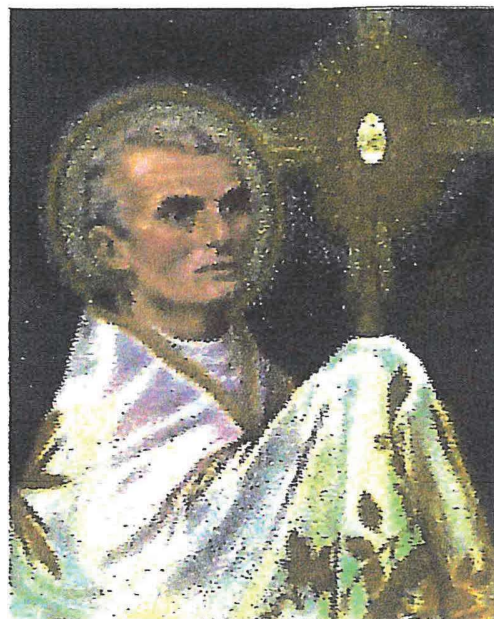

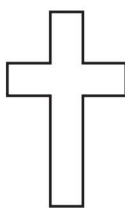
