OUR PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE



21st SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME:

Having just celebrated the Assumption on Monday, we remembered Mary's devotion to living a life of presence in her whole being. She always was attuned to God and proclaimed her life for God. This same devotion comes in another part of Luke's Gospel, today's reading! We hear how the community Luke is addressing needs

to keep connected, known by the Master and not strangers. We have to know the master and the master needs to know us. As Isaiah says, we need to have our works and thoughts in sync, participating in God's life and service. It's a good chance for us to review this. We cannot save ourselves – God is the one who leads us to salvation through this Eucharistic mystery.

STATISTICS FOR ANOTHER YEAR: Each year, from July 1 – June 30 we provide the diocese with a report on our parish and its sacramental life. Of course, you see in the bulletin our Pastoral Staff, that has remained the same now since the reconfiguration in May 2020 and the reduction in payroll that was necessary by \$225K. We are blessed for their care and devotion of our current staff and the sacrifices and attention they give with us. It is truly their vocation to be with us. Here are some other notes we provide the diocese and universal church in our annual survey:

- 2,232 households (we were 2,250 the year before)
- 6,126 parishioners (we were 6,216 the year before)
- 4 Weekend Masses with an average attendance of 700 a weekend
- 1 Parish Weekday Mass, average attendance is 35
- 1 Saint Ann Shrine Weekday Mass, average attendance 18
- 180 average views on our YouTube Channel each week
- 34 Baptisms (0-6), 3 adult Baptisms (7 and older is considered an adult in Canon Law)
- 59 First Penance
- 71 eighth grade confirmation, 2 adult confirmations with Bishop Amos
- 1 brought into full communion through the RCIA
- 13 marriages (we have Prepare/Enrich, couple to couple ministry)
- 350 use their envelopes weekly, 75 monthly, 10 annually
- 68 deaths (God slowed down in receiving folks to the banquet table this year! We were almost 100 last year)
- 200 in-person Monday PSR students, 25 home school PSR program
- 33 in Youth Group
- 270 students in our Catholic school K-8, 67 in Preschool. (We will share the current enrollment once school begins August 24.)

LAST WEEK'S FINANCIALS: If you did not get a copy of last week's bulletin with our financial report from the previous year, please review our website. Tom Mohorcic thomasmohorcic@gmail.com or I are happy to address your questions and concerns. One question I received I now share the answer: The \$300K PPP loan/grant assisted us financially to get us back on

our feet last year. These funds helped us to cover the deficit of the school that was almost \$225K. The revenue surplus was unusually high last year because of this PPP loan/grant. Sadly, we do not have any grants available for this year. We are grateful for your undying support of our award-winning Catholic school and count on your support to assist with the \$250K budget deficit in this year's school budget.



NEW SSS LEADERSHIP: We had a wonderful 26th Provincial Chapter here at our HQ for the USA SSS. Thank you for your prayers and support. There were some surprises! I was elected the Provincial Superior of our religious brothers, Deacon Joe, and priests. Fr. John Kamas, SSS (front left – pastor Saint Jean Baptiste, New York, NY) was elected our new treasurer, Fr. Bill Fickel, SSS (front right – pastor Saint Vincent de Paul, Holiday, FL) and Fr. Thomas Smithson, SSS (my right – pastor Corpus Christi, Houston, TX) consultants. Fr. Bill (our 4th pastor) will serve as our Vicar Provincial (second in command/service to the province.)

We will all be staying in our pastorates; we are needed for this ministry where we serve. We need your help in cultivating vocations to find our replacements! So, pray for us as we all wear 2 hats in service to you and the SSS. Don't most of you carry two hats, too?

Just a note about having the 2nd hat as Provincial Superior. When I was Vocation Director and came back to Saint Paschal's in 2009, I had these two hats for several years, whereby I traveled once a month for this vocation ministry. I'll be having this "travel" responsibility return occasionally, visiting our other four parishes, as part of my combined ministry now. I will keep my calendar organized between SPB and SSS events, I promise! I am grateful to Fr. Choy, Fr. Roger and Fr. Mike Arkins for their continued support and leadership for our parish. If you ever feel that there is a need for a change in the administration here at SPB, please let me know. If there are ever concerns with me that you do not feel comfortable addressing with me, please do not hesitate to let Fr. Fickel, Provincial Vicar, know. This is our SSS checks and balances. Fr. TRIP TO THE HOLY LAND WITH FR. FICKEL: Speaking of Fr. Bill Fickel, presently pastor in Holiday, FL, he is opening up a 12-day pilgrimage to the Holy Land and Jordan for folks here to participate in. The days are March 6 – 17, 2023 and the cost starts at \$3,999.00 per person from Orlando, Florida airport. (The trip from here to Orlando would be extra. ANOTHER BIT ABOUT OUR EUCCHARISTIC REVIVAL: Pope Francis encourages pastors to get out into the community, even bringing Mass to the those who have not been to church or who cannot get to church regularly. Remember the home Masses for the block that we used to have in the 1970s and 1980s when we had more priests? I am concerned about our weekend attendance only being 700 at all the Masses combined. That used to be two Masses of our attendance four years ago. Let's think about how we may reach out, even have a Mass in a neighborhood, to encourage participation in the Eucharist. We miss our folks who are not attending Mass, the Eucharist. What can we do to have them receive God's love?

PARISH PICNIC: Special thanks to the Knights of our area, the Gilmour Council, for helping us return to having our parish picnic. We did not have it at Highland Heights Park this year due to the park being rented. We will enjoy our own Green Knight Field for Mass (weather permitting) and then a picnic in the Eymard Room, playground games with the Youth Group, snow cones and popcorn. Let's celebrate the beginning of another academic year and pray that the Holy Spirit will guide and encourage our teachers and students. Thank you Knights, Evamarie and Youth Group!!

GREEN KNIGHT TO REMEMBER: Each year at our annual fall gala for our award-winning Catholic school, Green Knight to Remember (GK2R), we honor two people/families who serve our community and support our Green Knights. They are people of great character and embody what it means to be a Green Knight of service and self-giving to our community. This year, we honor Bob Mastrangelo and his wife Gail for their long-time dedication to SPB through religious education, coaching, leadership and, of course, dedication to Spring Fling for almost 10 years. 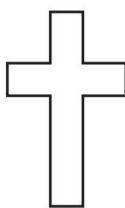
