FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER MAY 7, 2023

A LETTER FROM FR. LANE



FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER: How do you find directions to where you are going? Which map service do you use? Waze, Garmin, Map quest "the original way finder," Siri or do you just have a knack for getting lost and asking for help?

Today's Gospel reading from John reminds us of the directions and place that Christ has for us; Christ provides the way, the truth and the life. The

Eucharist continues to be our compass that guides the church and each one of us when we take the time to use this fabulous gift from God. When we are lost, where must we go? To whom shall we go, asked the apostles! We know that whether at Mass or in the Liturgy of the Hours or in our personal prayer time in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament in the church chapel, we have times and worship available for us to awaken the guide: Christ - the way the truth and the life for ourselves. Perhaps we might be frustrated, like Thomas and not patient to wait or figure out the directions for our life. God will patiently bring us along and help us "recalculate" where we are meant to go. Let us trust and mediate on this for the week ahead, especially as we celebrate our large group of First Communions this week for our young people.

PASTORAL PLAN UPDATE: Speaking of our pastoral plan, we began our new plan on the Baptism of the Lord 2020. And then a few things happened along the way! Would you be so kind to be one of my advisor/consultants? Please contact me for the guidelines and job description to see if this will be a gift of yourself you will be able to give to improve our parish's life.

LOOKING MORE AT OBH: Please join our planning team meeting on Tuesday on the parish deck outside my office at 6:30 PM to continue the process of dreaming for the future of Father O'Brien Hall. Park in the horseshoe lot on Wilson Mills Road, walk along the parish offices and then cross the alley (southbound to the outside cross of the church) to see where we are at! Time to enjoy the outside again and time for us to make some good decisions for the next steps of our process.

KEEPING THE FAITH INITIATIVE & LOOKING AT EDCHOICE: Dr. Frank O'Linn, the Diocese of Cleveland Superintendent for Catholic Schools, is coming to our campus on Tuesday, May 16 at 6:30 PM to reflect with our Finance, Pastoral and School Advisory Council about the recent decisions in the state house about EdChoice and the possibilities it has for Catholic schools, specifically our Catholic School. You are welcome to join us to learn more about this state program. He will also share about the "Keeping the Faith Initiative," the pastoral plan for Catholic education in the Diocese of Cleveland.

ANGEL SCHOLARSHIPS CONTINUE: Last year, many of you took advantage of the \$750 tax rebate for our Catholic school. Since we raised \$60K in scholarships for our Catholic school in 2022, we hope and pray you will participate again. Let's double our total for this next tax year. FOCUS ON SPRING FLING FESTIVAL 14: Now all eyes and attention are getting ready for our parish festival. 


