**EDUCATION BILLS IN COLUMBUS:** Some of you may be following the statehouse bills trying to improve funding for education. Each day, there is a new bill, theory, funding amount, etc. It has been dizzying, and we do not know where it will end up. Our diocese, through the Keeping the Faith Catholic School initiative and our own parish Pastoral, Finance and School Advisory Councils, are keeping tabs and studying this issue. Once the dust settles in Columbus, and we actually have a governor-signed bill, we will see how this affects the administration of our parish's finances (and the opportunities we may have). Meanwhile, stay tuned, and let's hope that the bills proposed become a reality. Please also note, we will not change our strict admission policies and ensure that students who qualify for funding are a good fit for our school and our strict academic standards. Like we do now, we have screening and testing policies in place that each of you have participated in to measure if students qualify for our standards. This will continue no matter what Columbus decides.



**THANK YOU IN SERVICE:** It is time for a change of leadership in the altar server ministry. I am so grateful to Kathryn Mailer for leading this ministry for 6 years. What a blessing she has been for us and our youth ministers! We wish her well and also, Maddie, who is going off to high school now. Christine Verdone will now assume the leadership and scheduling, and we really appreciate her stepping forward to continue the great leadership for this ministry. **WHAT DOES "SSS" MEAN?** During the summer bulletin columns, I'm going to be answering some of the common questions I receive. Folks see or know "Blessed Sacrament Community" or "Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament," but they do not know why we use "SSS" after the phrase. These three letters stand for the three Latin words that mean "Blessed Sacrament Community" or "Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament." The three Latin words are "societas sanctissimi sacramenti," so from Latin into English literally: Society of the Most Holy Sacrament. When Canon Law was updated in 1983, we, the way a religious order observed the vow of poverty, determined whether it was a "society" or "congregation." So, we are nothing like the Society of Jesus, or Jesuits – on many levels – some of them humorous. This is why we are a "Congregation," for we share our resources, paycheck, in common.

**SO GRATEFUL:** Every single one of you is a valuable asset to our parish's life and especially our parish Catholic school. I am so grateful for how you contribute to our success, and we look forward to a safe, happy and healthy summer. God bless you for all you give to SPB and let's continue to pray for each other.

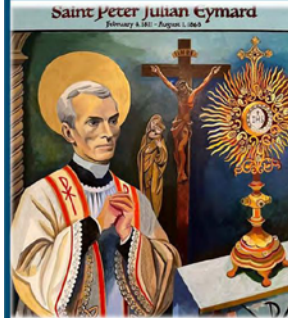

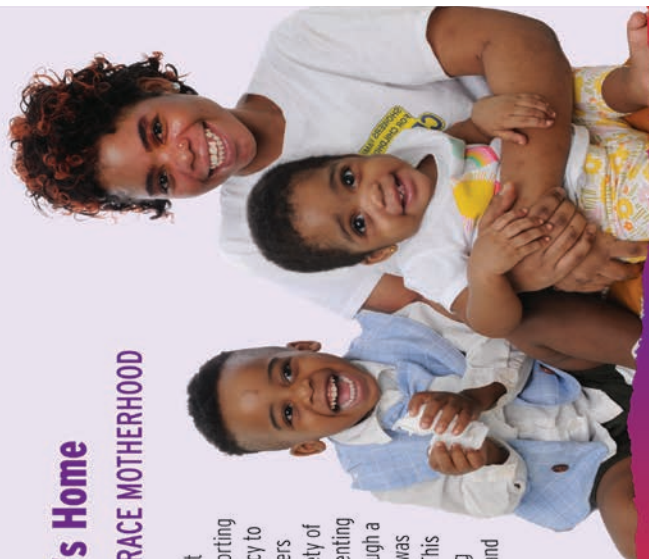
