

Prayer in the Presence of the Blessed Sacrament

Our Community at Prayer continues the tradition of keeping vigil until the LORD returns by visiting the Blessed Sacrament. Our prayer extends the blessings of the Mass, especially promoting Saint Peter Julian Eymard's methodology of the "four ends": adoration, forgiveness, thanksgiving and petition. The church and chapel are open for prayer from 7:00am to 7:00pm daily. The liturgical rite of the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament occurs with special prayer events, such as Taizé Eucharist Holy Hours, the Saint Ann Triduum and the Saint Peter Julian Eymard Triduum.

SAINTS THIS WEEK: On Tuesday, we will enjoy Saint Benedict, and he reminds us of our need to have a balanced life between work and prayer: ora et labora. This phrase has guided many a person in developing in their spirituality. Thursday, we have Henry and his wife Cunegunda who helped the poor and were oblates (like a third order of the Benedictines). His leadership truly guided a generation. Friday, we focus on Kateri Tekakwitha, who is buried near Montreal and is the first Native American saint. Reading her heroic story and attending the Native American National Museum in Washington, D.C. helps remind us why our baseball team needed to reform its name - and we pray for those still who have a challenge with change for the betterment of others. We end the week, Saturday, with Bonaventure, who makes us all want to be smarter and learn more as we age. Hopefully, these saints will mean something for our reflection this week in our call to holiness and growth.

FR. MIKE'S SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

In this weekend's Scriptures, especially in the Gospel passage from Matthew, we are given an insight into our discipleship. We heard Jesus talking (praying) to the Father. He humbles Himself and acknowledges the Father's role in His life and His mission. He encourages His first disciples to imitate Him and go to God frequently in prayer: thanking God for what He is doing in their lives and asking for the help they need. Sometimes, I think we are "too adult." We tend to try and take care of everything ourselves. Only when we are about to be "crushed" do we think about going to God. Jesus said, "learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart." To go to God or anyone requires humility. Think of the "little ones," children who go to their parents with everything, whether it is important or not. Jesus promised His first disciples, and us, that He will help us whether it is important or not.

Paul, in writing to the community of Rome, reminded them about their Baptisms and how in that ritual the Spirit was given to them and dwells in them. That Spirit gives them life – not just the promise of eternal life, but new life right now.

In the passage from Zechariah, the prophet told the Jewish

believers that they would experience peace, and that the one who would lead them to this peace would be "meek riding on an ass," not a strong and powerful warrior as many of them thought.

The nightly news emphasizes the need for God's peace in our world. Peace between warring factions, the violence on our city streets, even the violence in families. Maybe we have not been touched personally by these incidents, but as Christ's disciples in our world today, are we not called to be concerned? How often do we think about bringing these issues to God?

Each Eucharist offers us the opportunity to bring our joys, our concerns, and ourselves to God. Do we take advantage of this opportunity?
