

Prayer in the Presence of the Blessed Sacrament

Our Community at Prayer continues the tradition of keeping vigil until the LORD returns by visiting the Blessed Sacrament. Our prayer extends the blessings of the Mass, especially promoting Saint Peter Julian Eymard's methodology of the "four ends": adoration, forgiveness, thanksgiving and petition. The church and chapel are open for prayer from 7:00am to 7:00pm daily. The liturgical rite of the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament occurs with special prayer events, such as Taizé Eucharist Holy Hours, the Saint Ann Triduum and the Saint Peter Julian Eymard Triduum.

A LETTER FROM FATHER LANE



16th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME & OUR COLUMN PICTURES: This week's pictures remind us of the great aspects that make us the SPB community: our parish festival Spring Fling, our Masses and our special events (such as the Saint Ann Triduum and our Eucharistic Congress this year). Thank you for joining in these events to grow as a parish, and in your own spirituality and devotions.

This Sunday also holds a special new tradition that Pope Francis added to our liturgical calendar (due to the proximity of Saints Ann & Joachim). We wish our grandparents a very happy and special day, especially calling upon those of heaven to guide us still.

SAINTS THIS WEEK: A special feature this summer while I have written this column ahead of my vacation. I have been focusing on the great "summer" saints. The church gives them to us at this time of the year when we need them. During the Saint Ann Triduum, we have four great saints for our focus. First, we enjoy the Lebanese Sharbel Makhluf, who taught us the value of poverty, self-sacrifice and prayer. Tuesday, we focus on James who went to the "ends of the earth," (well, Spain at least as we call it now) to be struck down as the first apostle to be martyred. Wednesday, we celebrate the grandparents of Jesus, Joachim and Ann. Bring your grandparents to church this week for this special Triduum of grace. Bring the children and think of their needs by having them blessed on Monday, the sick who will be cared for on Tuesday and evangelizing with the Eucharist on Wednesday. Lastly, Saturday's saints have been added! We used to just remember Martha on this day, but in 2021, Pope Francis "upgraded" the celebrations to an obligatory memorial for both her sister and brother, Mary and Lazarus. Nice to remember the three siblings and their role in caring for Christ. May we do the same with our siblings as we give them special prayers on Saturday.

BECOMING CATHOLIC: A few days ago, we had our pizza party, in which everyone at the 4:30 PM Mass was invited to participate. As we remember Mary Magdalene on Saturday, it's a good chance for us to remember our role now as evangelists, sharing our faith, our



FR. MIKE'S SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

The Scriptures this weekend, especially the Gospel, invite us to reflect on our growth as disciples. The passage from Wisdom reminded us that God is just, yet patient and forgiving. He allows good and evil to co-exist, but He will take care of it.

In the Gospel passage from Matthew, Jesus told three parables about the kingdom, and all of them dealt with the concept of growth as disciples. The story about the weeds and the wheat acknowledges that the kingdom is not yet perfect. The story about the mustard seed reminds us that great things can come from the littlest seed. The story about yeast points out that things are not always as they appear. Yeast is relatively insignificant; yet, think about what it has the potential to do. The seed and the yeast of the kingdom have been implanted in each of us, and us as a parish community.

In the Gospel, the disciples approach Jesus and ask for an explanation of the parables, of what was happening. We, too, need to approach Jesus and ask for explanations. Sometimes, we are

shy about doing this.

Paul, in writing to the Romans, told them (and us) not to be afraid, that the Spirit within us knows what to say and how to ask.

Reflecting on these parables reminds me of a poem by Archbishop Oscar Romero that I would like to share with you:

We accomplish in our lifetime only a tiny fraction of the magnificent enterprise that is God's work. Nothing we do is complete, which is a way of saying that the kingdom always lies beyond us.

This is what we are about. We plant the seed that one day will sprout. We water seeds already planted, knowing that they hold future promise.

We lay foundations that will need further development. We provide yeast that produces far beyond our capabilities.

We cannot do everything, and there is a sense of liberation in realizing that. This enables us to do something, and to do it very well. It may be incomplete, but it is a beginning, a step along the way, an opportunity for the Lord's grace to enter and do the rest. We may never see the end results, but that is the difference between the master builder and the worker. We are workers, not master builders, ministers, not messiahs. We are prophets of a future not our own. AMEN.
