Our Community @ Prayer ministry continues the tradition of keeping vigil until the Lord Jesus Christ returns in glory. Our prayer extends the blessings of the Mass where we share in the Risen Christ's Body and Blood.

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament (a liturgical act) occurs Thursdays from 9:30 am until 8:00 pm with special exposition time throughout the year (i.e., Taizé Eucharistic Holy Hours, Saint Ann Triduum, Saint Peter Julian Eymard Triduum, etc.). See inside the bulletin for details.

The church is always open for prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle ("adoration"). Please make a visit to pray, as Saint Peter Julian Eymard would say, the "4-ends" of adoration, forgiveness, thanksgiving and petition. When the church is locked, see the pastor for the special parking area and code to enter the church to pray throughout the night in the tradition of nocturnal prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament.

REFLECTION FROM FR. ARKINS

Once again, this weekend the Scripture texts have been chosen to encourage us to do a yearend inventory as our liturgical year draws to a close.

In our passage from Thessalonians, we were reminded that Paul's community (like us) are awaiting the coming of the Lord. They expect Him soon. Paul encourages them to be ready, "awake and sober,"

The parable Jesus told in Matthew's Gospel was aimed at the Jewish religious leadership. They had been entrusted with the "faith," but they were too afraid to take the risk of letting it grow and develop. Matthew saw the parable as a story about Christ, the Master's departure, His Ascension, and Paul's belief that Christ would return for the final judgement. For us, it is a call to make good use of whatever "talents" God has given us, but specifically how we are using the gifts we have been given to build up Christ's Kingdom.

I think that if we think about the issues in our world today, many of us are at a loss as to what we can do personally. The passage from the Book of Proverbs gave us an example of what one individual, with her "gifts/talents," was able to do in "her little world" and how using her personal gifts affected her world.

The parable challenges us to think of the personal talents/gifts God has "gifted us with," and are we using these for ourselves, or to build Christ's Kingdom?

I am Brother James J. Owens, and I joined the staff on August 16, 2023. I oversee the public school religious education program. The PSR program began on September 11th and continues over the course of the next eight months. We strive to form the students' spiritually in a manner of a joyful proclamation of the Gospel. Richly meaningful religious devotions are at the center of our catechesis. 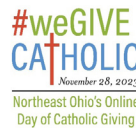

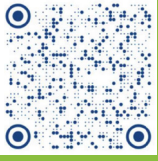
