Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament (a liturgical act) occurs Thursdays from 9:30 am until 8:00 pm with special exposition time throughout the year (i.e., Taizé Eucharistic Holy Hours, Saint Ann Triduum, Saint Peter Julian Eymard Triduum, etc.). See inside the bulletin for details.

The church is always open for prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle ("adoration"). Please make a visit to pray, as Saint Peter Julian Eymard would say, the "4-ends" of adoration, forgiveness, thanksgiving and petition. When the church is locked, see the pastor for the special parking area and code to enter the church to pray throughout the night in the tradition of nocturnal prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament.

OUR PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE



SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT: Isaiah and John the Baptist bookend our reflection this weekend as we hear how we are to bring comfort, kindness and care to those in need. The Baptist gives us the courage to realize we have “missioned,” or have been set on fire, to bring the Good News. We begin the Gospel of Mark this Sunday with this important statement. Furthermore, we are called to live this “good news,” making highways smooth

with this gift of who we are in our kindness and care. I’m sure you have heard the promotions for “Kindland” and our own Helping Hands ministry has assisted in promoting this around town, especially as they bring kindness to the houseless. Perhaps this week, besides sharing a kind word or two, we, too, can think of a way that we can bring that peace and serenity that exudes God’s care of another. Our vocation includes this grand gesture of smothering others with God’s kindness through our ways of concern.

WELCOME HOME: Our parish family really encourages one another to invite members to return to church for the holidays and worship. Our parish boasts such a friendly and welcoming environment and includes everyone in God’s family. As we prepare, especially for the Christmas Masses, please reach out to invite and welcome folks. Also, in your pew at Sunday Mass, please take a moment to say hello, not just at the Sign of Peace, as new folks join our parish and others return to celebrate these special holy days.

ENJOYING ADVENT & CHRISTMAS TIME: Our Advent Wreath this year reminds us that just as like your Advent wreath at your dining table, we have our Advent wreath around our “dining table.” God’s never-ending love always circles us at this table. The altar is Christ, the light and life for us. We journey to Bethlehem and the stable where we are fed by God’s presence and love. God is with us – Emmanuel! May the altar and your home table be a place of nourishment and renewal for this special new liturgical year. **What will you do this Advent to grow in your Eucharistic spirituality?**

Please note in the Calendar Highlights, our upcoming schedule: especially for Christmas where we gathered your feedback from the last several years (voted in January 2023) and proposed this year as scheduled. **And bring your Nativity’s Baby Jesus to next Sunday’s weekend Masses** for our annual special blessing – Bambinelli. This charming blessing has been a custom since 1969, given to the whole church by Pope Saint Paul VI.

Take advantage of the grace of special moments, **the Sacrament of Reconciliation**, either during the day with our school students, anytime during office hours, or the special evening communal celebration.

WHAT IS "BAMBINELLI SUNDAY?"

Throughout the weekend of December 16th and 17th, a Baminelli Blessing will be held during all of the Masses. "Baminelli," refers to the "Baby Jesus" in the Nativity Scene. Originated by Pope Paul VI in 1969, the blessing takes place each year in Rome on the Third Sunday of Advent. Since then, Roman Catholic churches from around the world, and now ours, have adopted this tradition. Every family is invited to bring their "Baby Jesus" from their Nativity Scene to the Mass they attend on the Third Sunday of Advent and receive a blessing. The Baminelli Blessing will incite us to experience God's true joy and love that comes to us from the Infant Jesus, which reinforces the true meaning of Christmas: the birth of Jesus Christ. Come and rejoice in God's love for you in this Advent celebration with your parish family.

ADVENT: A TIME OF PREPARING WITH DR. GEORGE MATEJKA! For Christians, the season of Advent should be a time of reflection, of waiting and watching for our Savior's miraculous birth. But the secular world is full of distractions, with Christmas displays appearing in early fall. Secular celebrations and commercialism often whip us into a frenzy of shopping, decorating, baking, and scheduling encounters with Santa. SCHOOL NEWS

SAINT PASCHAL BAYLON CATHOLIC SCHOOL NEWS

I want to express my sincere appreciation to our parents, parishioners, faculty/staff, alumni, and friends of Saint Paschal Baylon Catholic School who donated to our We Give Catholic campaign on Giving Tuesday, November 28. We had 96 donors contribute, and we raised an amazing \$17,612.00 dollars (which includes \$1,000.00 in prize money). The funds raised from this campaign, along with profits from the gala earlier this month), will be used to update our camera system throughout the school and Church.

I must especially thank Carol and Jim Jansky who provided a matching grant of \$500.00 along with two other couples who are parishioners wishing to remain anonymous, who offered matching grants of \$700.00 and \$5,000.00 respectively. The matching grants that we had this year and the past two years certainly encouraged others to give, to have double the impact. I continue to be amazed and touched by the generosity and love you show for our students and faculty and staff. 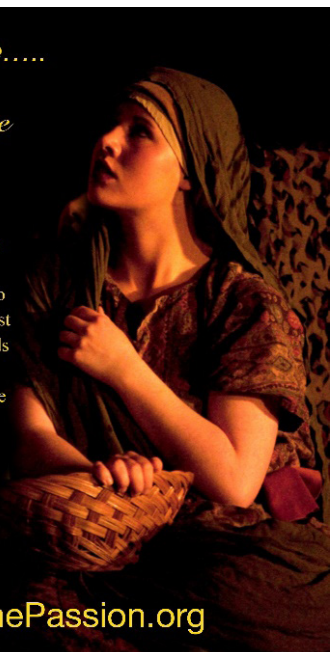

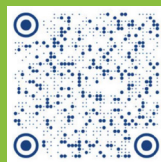
