A LETTER FROM FR. LANE



6th WEEK IN ORDINARY TIME: This is a big weekend before Lent. We have our scripture reading that reminds us the following from Paul's letter: "Brothers and sisters, whether you eat

or drink, or whatever you do, do

everything for the glory of God. Avoid giving offense, whether to the Jews or Greeks or the church of God, just as I try to please everyone in every way, not seeking my own benefit but that of the many, that they may be saved. Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ." Being imitators of Christ is a great theme for us to follow as we strive for a great Lent, strive to support our parish through supporting our 55+ ministries in the parish, and strive to support our CHATHOLIC CHARITIES throughout the Diocese (for we are 8-counties with so many ministries, including the Athletic Association!) What can you do to be an imitator of Christ and improve your stewardship of time, talent and treasure?

O'BRIEN HALL & EYMARD ROOM UPDATE: Our fundraising firm, John Kearns and Associates, is in the process of doing a suitability study and needs your support in a survey and interview. Please contact, even anonymously, Michelle Mazza (mmazza@saintpaschal.com) for time with Jack Kearns on our future capital campaign. Please be interviewed! Please share your joys of SPB, improvements to SPB and your ideas about the dreams to renovate these two important spaces on our campus. You may do this anonymously through the company we have hired. There will also be in-pew surveys March 2-3, 9-10, with our *Paschal Life* email, *SPB Family Newsletter* in the school and with you just writing Michelle and Jack.



We appreciate your questions, concerns, suggestions and comments, to staff, council members, suggestion box and ombudsman. We do take them seriously and analyze! Here are some since the end of January:

QUESTION TO FINANCE COUNCIL AND ME: Why do we do a capital campaign when we have a loan (debt)? ANSWER: Just as you have a reasonable mortgage and rate, and make capital improvements to your home (sometimes refinancing to do so), so does our parish. We actually have enough money in savings to support repaying our loan. However, we use the Maintenance and Repayment fund for emergencies, such as during December when the HVAC system (original to the Family Life Center) needed to be replaced immediately on December 14 and 15. We had the funds in this account you support and were able to remit over \$186,000 to replace all 6 of the units.

As you have in your home, things pop up that are unexpected! Our maintenance and facilities team, with the Finance Council, always plans for the unexpected. The funds are being separately raised and engaged for this campaign, that was the number-one priority identified in 2016 when we began a process to improve our campus. Just to recall, Bishop Perez demanded we replace our driveways and parking lots first, due to liability issues, before renovating existing space. We are now at that point! Lastly, the interest on our loan is 3% with no penalty if we pay it off early or add more than the monthly payment amount. We regularly pay more than the \$4,000.00 to assist in the paying down the loan – thank you so much for your generosity!

QUESTION ABOUT EDCHOICE: How many applied and received these funds? **ANSWER:** 271 applied 269 awarded EdChoice from the state; 52% of these families receive the full amount. Families averaged \$4,301.00. We are encouraged by this and hope that next year this will be just as successful.

QUESTION HOW MANY CONTRIBUTED TO THE ANGEL SCHOLARHIP FOR NEXT YEAR? We had more than 101 donors for an amount of \$80,000.00. This is a 30% increase. We are so grateful to you for allowing this rebate to go to our Catholic school and to George Zagar for being our ambassador for this important scholarship program.

What a joy to have so many families and parents attending! What great questions and what wonderful stories we heard from Sister of Notre Dame Angela Salazar, SND, Blessed Sacrament Father JK Nguyen, Blessed Sacrament Brother Joe Tuan Vu, Blessed Sacrament Postulant Matthew Vlastelica and our super PSR

volunteer office team of our newly married Kailey and Baily. I'm sure you will all continue to support **ALL vocations**, share your story with young people and affirm and support them in their vocation. The other photo is explained below.

CELEBRATE BRO GARY'S 60th: Congratulations Bro Gary and thank you for your presence and service to our community. Bro Gary was on our parish pastoral staff from 1975 to 1995. He continues to serve us with his annual outdoor manger, gardening and as the SSS House Manager. Thanks to him, we have so many wonderful architectural and campus realities. We are grateful for his ministry and service and look forward to the next 60 years!

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD: Soon we hope to have two more catechists at 10:30_{AM} Sunday Masses to assist our children in learning about God's word and our faith. Please know we are always in need of more volunteers, and we will train you with materials.

TODAY'S MINISTRY FAIR: Our parish is known for its activity over these 71 years. Let's continue to support and make it thrive. What is God calling you to serve? How about trying something for Lent?

CATHOLIC CHARITIES APPEAL: There is so much to the life of the parish – for we are part of the Diocese and the Church of Cleveland. This year's appeal is "Transformed by your love." In John 13:35, we hear "By this, everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." Let us love, serve and support the 400,000 folks who come to our Catholic Charities agencies across our 8-county diocese and make our annual commitment to these important services.

Carlo Acutis (May 3, 1991-October 12, 2006) was an Englishborn Italian Catholic youth and website designer, who documented the Eucharistic miracles and catalogued them onto a website, http://www.miracolieucaristici.org/en/Liste/list.html, which he created before his death from leukemia. He was known for his cheerfulness, computer skills, and deep devotion to the Eucharist, which became a center theme of his life. He was beatified by the Catholic Church on October 10, 2020, two days before the 14th anniversary of his death. He was inspired to create an online website dedicated to cataloging each reported Eucharistic miracle in the world, as a new way to share about faith with the younger (https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Carlo Acutis) For more information on Blessed Carlo Acutis, visit http://www. carloacutis.com/. 
LADIES GUILD NEWS


