## A LETTER FROM FR. LANE



**SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT:** *Due to the holiday, we write this column and edit the bulletin on February 13.*

In ancient times and lands, mountains were the pinnacle places for experiencing God. We have the Mark version of the Transfiguration today reminding us of the presence of God on Mount Tabor. Similarly, Abraham brings his son Isaac to a mountain, for a sacrificial moment that turns into a great faith moment. In our faith

moments, lack of trust moments, or other challenging moments, we hear in the letter to the Hebrews, God is with us! "If God is with us, who can be against us?" We do not have to go up a mountain to experience God and deepen our trust – we have our mountain here in our holy tent and sanctuary! We go up to the altar of God at each Mass to experience the joy, belief and knowledge that God is here, and it is "oh so good!" May this week of Lent deepen your trust, knowledge and belief that God's glory is always with us and surrounds us in the Eucharistic mystery.

**CATHOLIC CHARITIES:** Have you made your commitment to the 2024 Catholic Charities Appeal, "Transformed by Your Love" yet? On behalf of the folks in need who you will sacrifice a "coffee" or meal for, thank you! The work our Catholic Church does to support people is amazing: thanks for being a faithful steward of God's blessings in your life. Thank you!

Join us as we take this moment in the Year of Eucharistic Revival to renew our covenant with God.

The Steering Committee met the architects to finalize concept drawings before going to the next steps. They identified key points that we heard and want to see:

- Dedicated band space
- Renovated bathrooms by OBH and a Family Restroom
- Renovated/expanded OBH kitchen
- Expansion of storage in OBH and Eymard
- Refresh of Eymard after the roof is replaced
- Renovated/expansion of Eymard kitchen; enclosing a new storage space in the bay that was never used for trash containers.

(Please park in the Wilson Mills Horseshoe parking lot and enter through either of the entrances for the Parish Office or the accessible Saint Ann Shrine entrance outside, down the ramp.) **Carlo Acutis** (May 3, 1991-October 12, 2006) was an English-born Italian Catholic youth and website designer, who documented the Eucharistic miracles and catalogued them onto a website, <http://www.miracolieucaristici.org/en/Liste/list.html>, which he created before his death from leukemia. He was known for his cheerfulness, computer skills, and deep devotion to the Eucharist, which became a center theme of his life. He was beatified by the Catholic Church on October 10, 2020, two days before the 14th anniversary of his death. He was inspired to create an online website dedicated to cataloging each reported Eucharistic miracle in the world, as a new way to share about faith with the younger generation." - **NEXT WEEK IS THE TETÉLESTAI PASSION PLAY/ MUSICAL LIVE IN OUR CHURCH: Friday-Sunday, March 1-3.** Back by popular demand, and for the entire family, enjoy the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Christ. "Tetélestai" comes from a Greek work that translates to the last words of Christ on the cross: "It is finished." The message of Christ's life is never finished, so invite folks to come to the three performances – one or all! If you would like to be an usher, please let me know! **Please note that the stage will be built around the altar and sanctuary like in the past.** We appreciate you adjusting for this weekend and taking the cue of our liturgical ministers. **Friday & Saturday night performances are at 8:00 PM. Sunday's performance in church is at 2:00 PM.**



Also, please note, as in previous years, our Catechumens and Candidates will now attend other Mass times during Lent so that you may meet them and witness their rituals that support them in their process (culminating at the Easter Vigil on **Saturday, March 30, 8:00 PM.**)

Let's continue to pray for each other! Thank you so much for your love, care, kindness and concerns!

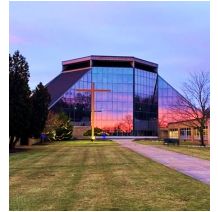

**Our Family. Our Home. Our Future:** Beginning in 2016, the parish, through its advancement office (having been closed due to the pandemic financial struggles), identified 13 major improvements that were needed for the campus through a year-long study. Since 2022, the parish Pastoral Council, Finance Council, School Advisory Council, Faculty and Parish Staff (especially facilities and maintenance staff) have been helping plan a course that will ensure a bright future here at Saint Paschal Baylon Parish. Our focus is on people first and the ministry and service our parish provides. The planning process has been assisted by Studio Techne which conducted over 50 interviews at Town Hall meetings. Through this work, we have identified major repairs and updates that are needed for both O'Brien Hall (the original church) and the Eymard Room of the Family Life Center. These improvements are estimated to cost \$2-\$3 million. Our response to these goals will help meet the needs of a vibrant parish community as well as advance our call to grow in faith. As with any set of buildings that are in use on a daily basis, there is a need for our facilities to be periodically repaired and updated so that they can continue to serve as the center of our Catholic life. Due to the passing of time and our ever-changing weather, two of the most used spaces on our campus, O'Brien Hall, and the Eymard Room of the Family Life Center, need upgrades. Making the necessary improvements and updates to our parish will allow us to continue the work started here so many years ago, while also building on the foundation laid by those good and faithful parishioners, many of whom have now gone before us.

**Our Projects:** This campaign will exclusively fund needs and priorities here at Saint Paschal Baylon, and the funds raised will remain in the parish. We realize that we cannot walk away from the challenges we face at this time: a dollar spent wisely today could save five dollars in the future. Our campaign goal is \$2,000,000, which would allow us to address the following:
