Please make a visit to pray, as Saint Peter Julian Eymard would say, the "4-ends" of adoration, forgiveness, thanksgiving and petition. When the church is locked, see the pastor for the special parking area and code to enter the church to pray throughout the night in the tradition of nocturnal prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament.

A LETTER FROM FR. LANE



16TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: The theme that runs through the scripture readings today highlights the genuine and generous hospitality expressed through the joyous gift of self. This is manifested through the welcoming spirit of Abraham and Sarah in the first reading, through Saint Paul's attitude and disposition to share Jesus Christ in the second reading and at last through the figures of Martha and Mary in the Gospel passage. The hospitality portrays God's visitation through His messengers and those with a welcoming virtue showing kindness and generosity. It does not only consist of a state of doing, caring or welcoming others, the strangers, but rather more to have a disposition of the heart. It's a state of being and mind based on the love of God for humanity, an openness to God's creation with absolute respect, humility, reverence, and joy. Hospitality does not act for self-recognition or self-reputation but on one's devotion to God's message of love, mercy and compassion. The author of the letter to the Hebrews helps us to be aware of the outcome of the hospitality: *"Do not neglect hospitality, for through it some have unknowingly entertained angels."* (Heb.13:2)

The figures of Martha and Mary in the Gospel passage brings about a shift of understanding with regard to a generous hospitality. It engages our spiritual, human and moral interpersonal relationship. These are the two dimensions of the spirituality of hospitality: active and passive (contemplative). It is active when met with the sacrificial suffering, the joyous gift of self in serving with absolute abnegation catering for the needs of the visitors, providing shelter, food, and water. And it is contemplative when we provide with our whole being through our presence, listening, patience, acceptance. This theme does not leave us indifferent but rather challenges us to be God's messengers who bring His promises in sharing Jesus Christ making known the riches of the glory. However, the emergency is to work on the balance between the two extremes: Martha and Mary. For we are the combination of both for the betterment of our families, societies, communities and Parish family under the benedictine motto "Ora et labora" meaning "pray and work." In this way we will reunite prayer and work through works of genuine devotion to the Lord's plan of salvation in and through our contemplation of Him in the

Eucharist and making Him accessible to all by our generous and unconditional hospitality that can be instrumental in transforming the face of the earth.

2025-2026 CALENDAR FOR SESSIONS AND RITUALS IN THE ORDER FOR CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (THOSE 7 YEARS AND OLDER): We print here and share the information that we share with our families thinking about Becoming Catholic each year. Here is this year's calendar with the special dates so that you may share them with everyone and also attend them yourself in person. The three Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism – Confirmation – First Communion are inseparable once a person reaches the age of reason, that is seven years of age. All three sacraments are placed together and celebrated by the pastor of a parish at the Easter Vigil each year. The church's law (Canon Law) requires certain qualifications, rituals and actions in order for this to be celebrated appropriately, especially in line with the National Statutes of the Catechumenate (USA Canon Law). Here is an outline of the session, rituals and steps along the process to become a Catholic Christian if you are seven years of age (the canonical "age of reason") or older.

PLACE THESE DATES ON YOUR CALENDAR – MANY ARE MANDATORY and need special permission from the bishop to miss or make up. **NOTE:** Our PSR and Day School students attend their regular religion classes and come to the Sunday Masses and dismissals for the special formation time each week.

- **Thursday, September 4, 7:00 PM Opening Session** (for adults only): The Secrets of the Church with Father Lane, SSS and the other team members **BACK BY POPULAR DEMAND!**
 - **You will also have an overview to the liturgical calendar**
 - **Held in the Parish Office parlor** (90 minutes with questions from the group)
- **Beginning Sunday, September 14, through April 3:** Sunday Dismissals after the homily and Sunday readings for faith sharing and information about the faith from the team leaders – at the 10:30 AM Mass each week (except during the three weeks of Lent when noted below).
 - **Both adults and those 7-17 participate** (parents are welcome)
- Sessions for the adults: Following Thursdays, 7:00- 8:30 PM from **September 4-May 21** (with breaks for the holidays)
- **Sunday November 23, 10:30 AM Mass – Rite of Entrance into the Catechumenate (with your godparent/sponsor) – Mandatory – PRACTICE at 10:00 AM beforehand.**
- **Sunday, February 22, 10:30 AM – Rite of Sending at Saint Paschal Baylon**
 - Followed by lunch, a tour of the Cathedral of Saint John the Evangelist, Downtown Cleveland

- Rite of Election with **Bishop Malesic** at Public Hall – Time to be determined
- Home by 5:00 PM. It's a day for your godparents/sponsors and you to be together for these special rituals
- **A special ritual for those already baptized – "Rite of Penance:" Sunday, March 1, 10:30 AM Mass**

DURING LENT – YOU WILL BE WITH THE PEOPLE AT THE DIFFERENT MASS TIMES – so that they may pray for and with you, renewing their own covenant:

- **First Scrutiny:** 4:30 PM Mass on Saturday, **March 7**
- **Second Scrutiny:** 8:30 AM Mass on Sunday, **March 15**
- **Third Scrutiny:** 6:30 PM Mass on Sunday, **March 22**

PALM SUNDAY: Sunday, March 29, Attend the 10:30 AM Mass – followed by lunch provided by the parish's Welcome Committee.

- followed by a 12:30 PM Rehearsal for the Easter Vigil

One will be chosen to go to the Chrism Mass (all welcome) to retrieve the oil for your Baptism!)

- **Tuesday, March 31, 7:00 PM Cathedral of Saint John**

THE SACRED TRIDUUM:

- **Holy Thursday:** Agape Meal at 5:30 PM on **Thursday, April 2**, followed by 7:00 PM service
- **Good Friday:** **Friday, April 3, 7:00 PM** service – and there is a dismissal but no reflection – you go home to prepare for the next day.
- **Easter Vigil: Saturday, April 4, 8:00 PM** – you are at church at 7:30 PM to set up your towel and clothes that you will be changing into after you are baptized (yes, you get wet!); you will also be anointed with oil and receive First Communion. Students will also then be able to receive Holy Communion going forward but especially be part of the large group celebration on **Sunday, May 3, 2026**, at 1:00 PM.
- **Sunday, May 17, 2026**, after the 10:30 AM Mass: All join a special end-of-the-year picnic – welcome to candidates for the next season on initiation.






