The church is always open for prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle ("adoration"). Please make a visit to pray, as Saint Peter Julian Eymard would say, the "4-ends" of adoration, forgiveness, thanksgiving and petition. When the church is locked, see the pastor for the special parking area and code to enter the church to pray throughout the night in the tradition of nocturnal prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament.

A LETTER FROM FR. LANE

17TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: THE GIFT OF SELF -



A GRATEFUL FAREWELL FROM FR. CHOY, SSS: After seven years and six months of serving as priest here at Saint Paschal Baylon Parish, I now find myself in a sacred moment of reflection, gratitude, and letting go. A chapter is closing, and another is about to begin. But before I move forward, I want to pause and honor this place, this community, spiritual home that has meant so much to me.

When I first stepped foot

into this parish, I was a stranger to many, but that changed quickly. Your warm smiles, open hearts, and deep faith welcomed me as one of your own. What began as an assignment became a home. What began as a ministry became relationship. And what began as service became a shared journey of love, prayer, and healing.

Throughout these years, I have tried – though imperfectly – to live out the call of the Eucharist; to give of myself, as Christ gave of Himself. The Eucharist teaches us that love is not just spoken but given. That presence matters. That showing up, day after day, in joy and in sorrow, is how we build communion. And I saw that truth lived out not just in the liturgy, but in all of you parishioners who quietly give, forgive, serve, and pray without expecting recognition.

From Baptisms and weddings to funerals and healing prayers, from parish fiestas to quiet visits to the sick, I have been graced to walk with you. And I will miss you all deeply.

As I now prepare to begin my new assignment at **Saint Matthias Catholic Church in Somerset**, **New Jersey**, I carry you in my heart and in my prayers. I ask you humbly: **please pray for me**, as I will continue to pray for you. A priest is never alone in his mission; he carries the people he is served wherever he goes.

Even though I leave, physically, we remain united in the Eucharist. Every Mass I celebrate; I will remember the faces and stories that shaped my priesthood here at Saint Paschal. Our bond is not broken; it is simply stretched across new distances.

And so, I say: **Thank you**. Thank you for allowing me to be your associate "shepherd," your companion in faith, your friend. Thank you for your patience, prayers, and your presence.

Let us continue to live Eucharistic lives, offering ourselves for one another, wherever God sends us.

2025-2026 CALENDAR FOR SESSIONS AND RITUALS IN THE **ORDER FOR CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (THOSE 7 YEARS AND OLDER):** We print here and share the information that we share with our families thinking about Becoming Catholic each year. Here is this year's calendar with the special dates so that you may share them with everyone and also attend them yourself in person. The three Sacraments of Initiation - Baptism - Confirmation - First Communion are inseparable once a person reaches the age of reason, that is seven years of age. All three sacraments are placed together and celebrated by the pastor of a parish at the Easter Vigil each year. The Church's law (Canon Law) requires certain qualifications, rituals and actions in order for this to be celebrated appropriately, especially in line with the National Statues of the Catechumenate (USA Canon Law). Here is an outline of the session, rituals and steps along the process to become a Catholic Christian if you are seven years of age (the canonical "age of reason") or older.

PLACE THESE DATES ON YOUR CALENDAR – MANY ARE MANDATORY and need special permission from the bishop to miss or make up. NOTE: Our PSR and Day School students attend their regular religion classes and come to the Sunday Masses and dismissals for the special formation time each week.

- Thursday, September 4, 7:00 PM Opening Session (for adults only): The Secrets of the Church with Father Lane, SSS and the other team members BACK BY POPULAR DEMAND!
 - You will also have an overview to the liturgical calendar
 - o **Held** in the Parish Office parlor (90 minutes with questions from the group)
- Beginning Sunday, September 14, through April 3: Sunday Dismissals after the homily and Sunday readings for faith sharing and information about the faith from the team leaders at the 10:30 AM Mass each week (except during the three weeks of Lent when noted below).
 - o **Both adults and those 7-17 participate** (parents are welcome)
- Sessions for the adults: Following Thursdays, 7:00-8:30 PM from **September 4-May 21** (with breaks for the holidays)
- Sunday, November 23, 10:30 AM Mass Rite of Entrance into the Catechumenate (with your godparent/sponsor) – Mandatory – PRACTICE at 10:00 AM beforehand.
- Sunday, February 22, 10:30 AM Rite of Sending at Saint Paschal Baylon
 - Followed by lunch, a tour of the Cathedral of Saint John the Evangelist, Downtown Cleveland
 - Rite of Election with Bishop Malesic at Public Hall Time to be determined
 - Home by 5:00 PM. It's a day for your godparents/ sponsors and you to be together for these special rituals
- A special ritual for those already baptized "Rite of Penance:" Sunday, March 1, 10:30 AM Mass

DURING LENT – YOU WILL BE WITH THE PEOPLE AT THE DIFFERENT MASS TIMES so that they may pray for and with you, renewing their own covenant:

- First Scrutiny: 4:30 PM Mass on Saturday, March 7
- Second Scrutiny: 8:30 AM Mass on Sunday, March 15
- Third Scrutiny: 6:30 PM Mass on Sunday, March 22

PALM SUNDAY: Sunday, March 29. Attend the 10:30 AM Mass – followed by lunch provided by the parish's Welcome Committee.

• Followed by a 12:30 PM Rehearsal for the Easter Vigil

One will be chosen to go to the Chrism Mass (all welcome) to retrieve the oil for your Baptism!

• Tuesday, March 31, 7:00 рм Cathedral of Saint John

THE SACRED TRIDUUM:

- Holy Thursday: Agape Meal at 5:30 PM on Thursday, April 2, followed by 7:00 PM service
- Good Friday: Friday, April 3, 7:00 PM service and there is a dismissal but no reflection you go home to prepare for the next day.
- Easter Vigil: Saturday, April 4, 8:00 PM you are at church at 7:30 PM to set up your towel and clothes that you will be changing into after you are baptized (yes, you get wet!); you will also be anointed with oil and receive First Communion. Students will also then be able to receive Holy Communion going forward but especially be part of the large group celebration on Sunday, May 3, 2026, at 1:00 PM.
- Sunday, May 17, 2026, after the 10:30 AM Mass: All join a special end-of-the-year picnic welcome to candidates for the next season of initiation.


