Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament (a liturgical act) occurs Thursdays from 9:30 am until 8:00 pm with special exposition time throughout the year (i.e., Taizé Eucharistic Holy Hours, Saint Ann Triduum, Saint Peter Julian Eymard Triduum, etc.). See inside the bulletin for details.

The church is always open for prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle ("adoration"). Please make a visit to pray, as Saint Peter Julian Eymard would say, the "4-ends" of adoration, forgiveness, thanksgiving and petition. When the church is locked, see the pastor for the special parking area and code to enter the church to pray throughout the night in the tradition of nocturnal prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament.

A LETTER FROM FR. LANE



20th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: Do you have family members that you are not in agreement with on the typical topics? Have you felt like Jeremiah where you are “thrown into a cistern?” From Jeremiah, to Christ, we are in good company of people not wanting to hear God’s word and live by it. It is so helpful to remember as the Letter to the Hebrews reminds us: we are among a great cloud of witnesses; these are the saints and prophets of old who were tested, punished and killed for their faith. Doing God’s will, living our faith are all “hazards.” However, we know that we are in good company and that as the Body of Christ, we must fulfill that which needs to build up the Body of Christ. And when stressed, pray with the psalmist: “Lord, come to my aid!”

HELPING THE PARISH: We have been so blessed by generous wills that we have received as a parish to support our ongoing operational budget or special maintenance projects over the last few years, but especially last month with a \$130,000.00 donation to the general operations fund. In our stewardship reflections, it is helpful to know that this month is “**National Make A Will Month.**” Jesus responds to a question about inheritance with a call to be “rich toward God,” reminding us of the spiritual importance of how we plan and give. (see Luke 12) Today, as we face the largest wealth transfer in history, parishes have both an opportunity and a responsibility to equip their communities to live and give with eternal purpose. Thanks for considering placing us in your will, so that your legacy, gift and parish may grow in the future due to your generosity and kindness to the next generation of churchgoers here at SPB. While you are with us now, we are so appreciative of your thoughtfulness, generosity and support toward the ministries of our parish and also to the Capital Campaign, especially as you see the work being completed before our eyes.

WEEKDAY MASSES AND HOLY COMMUNION: More of our congregation is receiving the Precious Blood at our weekday Masses. We have added an additional chalice minister to share the Precious Blood; please come to the inner rim of ministers if you are sitting in the outer rim.

PICTURES THIS BULLETIN: What a great treat for Daniela and Robert to receive their First Communion on August 2, the day of Saint Peter Julian Eymard. Let’s recall that Father Eymard advocated for First Communion of children – even to the point of wishing that the age would be lowered. In 1910, Pope Pius X heeded the wishes of this great saint and other bishops, theologians and liturgists, as well as the Eastern Rites of the Church and the Orthodox; to allow the Eucharist to be more accessible to the young and truly be the food that nourishes, sustains and helps us grow in faith. “Lord, come to my aid!” also, in the section of information, note the picture of most of our men at Regina, whereby our SSS community here supports our SSS community there with a meal once a month and gathering of fun. Our men there always appreciate your cards, gifts and presence! Visit them anytime by giving them a call or attending the Mass at 11:00 AM each day (but Saturday).



UPDATE ON THE FAMILY LIFE CENTER: Perhaps as you read this bulletin, the interior work of the Eymard Room in the Family Life Center is beginning its renovation, or maybe in the coming days. It depends on the signature of the contracts, approved by the diocese. **CONTACT YOUR GROUP LEADER and WATCH YOUR EMAILS for all the updates this fall as to the location of where you will meet** as we adjust with two major space areas being renovated. We finalized the colors and updates for the Eymard Room of the Family Life Center. The weather has not cooperated on the roof when we needed it to, and as many of you know, some flooding, some delays and challenges and other annoyances. Construction and reconstruction always has its snags in our homes, right? So why would the church family be any different? We appreciate the hard work of our roofers and continue to pray for their safety. Hopefully, just after Labor Day, the remodel will begin and we will be completed by the November Craft Show. That’s the hope – and pray for it!



BECOMING CATHOLIC

The three Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism – Confirmation – First Communion – are inseparable once a person reaches the age of reason, that is 7 years of age. All three sacraments are placed together and celebrated by the pastor of a parish at the Easter Vigil each year. The Church’s law (Canon Law) requires certain qualifications, rituals and actions in order for this to be celebrated appropriately, especially in line with the National Statutes of the Catechumenate (USA Canon Law). Here is an outline of the session, rituals and steps along the process to become a Catholic Christian if you are 7 years of age (the canonical “age of reason”) or older. **PLACE THESE DATES ON YOUR CALENDAR – MANY ARE MANDATORY** and need special permission from the bishop to miss or make up.


NOTE: Our PSR and Day School students attend their regular religion classes and come to the Sunday Masses and dismissals for the special formation time each week.

- **Thursday, September 4, 7:00 PM** Opening Session (for adults only): The Secrets of the Church with Father Lane, SSS, and the other team members.
BACK BY POPULAR DEMAND!
 - You will also have an overview of the liturgical calendar
 - Held in the Parish Office Parlor (90 minutes with questions from the group)
- **Beginning Sunday, September 14 through April 3:** Sunday Dismissals after the homily and Sunday readings for faith-sharing and information about the faith from the team leaders – at the 10:30 AM Mass each week (except during the three weeks of Lent when noted below)
 - **Both adults and those 7-17 participate** (parents are welcome)
- Sessions for the adults: Following Thursdays 7:00-8:30 PM **from September 4-May 21** (with breaks for the holidays)

- **Sunday, November 23, 10:30 AM** Mass – Rite of Entrance into the Catechumenate (with your godparent/sponsor) – Mandatory – **PRACTICE** at 10:00 AM beforehand
- **Sunday, February 22, 10:30 AM** – Rite of Sending at Saint Paschal Baylon
 - Followed by lunch, a tour of the Cathedral of Saint John the Evangelist, Downtown Cleveland
 - Rite of Election with **Bishop Malesic** at Public Hall – Time to be determined
 - Home by 5:00 pm. It’s a day for your godparents/sponsors and you to be together for these special rituals
- **A special ritual for those already baptized – “Rite of Penance”:** Sunday, March 1, 10:30 AM Mass

DURING LENT – YOU WILL BE WITH THE PEOPLE AT THE DIFFERENT MASS TIMES – so that they may pray for and with you, renewing their own covenant:

- **First Scrutiny:** 4:30 PM Mass on **Saturday, March 7**
- **Second Scrutiny:** 8:30 AM Mass on **Sunday, March 15**
- **Third Scrutiny:** 6:30 AM Mass on **Sunday, March 22**



PALM SUNDAY: Sunday, March 29. Attend the 10:30 AM Mass – followed by lunch provided by the parish’s Welcome Committee

- Followed by a 12:30 PM Rehearsal for the Easter Vigil

One will be chosen to go to the Chrism Mass (all welcome to retrieve the oil for your baptism!)

- **Tuesday, March 31, 7:00 PM** Cathedral of Saint John

THE SACRED TRIDUUM

- **Holy Thursday:** Agape Meal at 5:30 PM on **Thursday, April 2**, followed by 7:00 PM service
- **Good Friday:** **Friday, April 3, 7:00 PM** service – and there is a dismissal, but no reflection – you go home to prepare for the next day
- **Easter Vigil: Saturday, April 4, 8:00 PM** – You are at church at 7:30 PM to set up your towel and clothes that you will be changing into after you are baptized (yes, you get wet!); you will also be anointed with oil and receive First Communion. Students will also be then able to receive Holy Communion going forward, but especially to be part of the large group celebration on **Sunday, May 3, 2026 at 1:00 PM.**
- **Sunday, May 17, 2026, after the 10:30 AM Mass:** All join a special end-of-the-year picnic – Welcome to candidates for the next season of initiation.




