


# The Roman Catholic Community of **SAINT PASCHAL BAYLON**

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament (a liturgical act) occurs Thursdays from 9:30 am until 8:00 pm with special exposition time throughout the year (i.e., Taizé Eucharistic Holy Hours, Saint Ann Triduum, Saint Peter Julian Eymard Triduum, etc.). See inside the bulletin for details.

The church is always open for prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle ("adoration"). Please make a visit to pray, as Saint Peter Julian Eymard would say, the "4-ends" of adoration, forgiveness, thanksgiving and petition. When the church is locked, see the pastor for the special parking area and code to enter the church to pray throughout the night in the tradition of nocturnal prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament.

A LETTER FROM FR. LANE



**THE FEAST OF THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS:** It has been nine years since we last celebrated this feast day on a Sunday. The Gospel for today is not about the crucifixion as one may think it would be. Rather, Jesus, in talking with Nicodemus, reminds us why he was brought into the world: so, we might know love. Many of us, perhaps, think of the cross as something we do to begin a ritual, like a prayer before a meal or a Sacrament. We wear crosses to identify that we are a (Catholic) Christian. We live a cross in our lives when we have a heavy burden, the Christ and Simon of Cyrene are there to walk with us. All in love! Most importantly, our Lord turned the symbol of capital punishment into a sign of salvation and love for all redeemed by Christ’s blood. Each day, we take up the cross to follow the Lord and bring that salvation of love to others. However, we live the cross, may we not forget how this powerful symbol lifts us up to the glory of God.

**PICTURES THIS WEEK:** Every now and then, I am asked how tall the cross is outside the church: It is 35 feet and has been painted four times in its history, most recently in 2014. The color it is painted is “jute brown” to flow from the color of the buildings around it, like the cross flows through each of us and keeps us together. We welcomed Carmella into the faith a few days ago: it is for these children that we share our faith and build the church of the future for them!

**QUARTERLY FINANCE UPDATE ON THE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN:** Every September, parishes across the country highlight **stewardship**, how we may improve our time, talent and treasure and better our parishes. **Each fiscal quarter**, we highlight for you where we are financially with the Capital Campaign for the renovation of the Family Life Center (FLC) and O’Brien Hall (OBH). With the diocese approval of our last year’s finance report and the budget for this current fiscal year, we are able over the next three weeks to share our report. Today, I will focus on the Capital Campaign figures – a separate budget area for the parish: if you donate in the envelopes, this is for the parish’s operation (i.e., insurance, salaries for our staff, snowplow and salt, mega etc.). If you earmark a donation to FLC or OBH, we honor this – and have been, making this campaign successful in moving along, doing the projects as we receive the funds. Going forward, we will keep our stewardship section a regular report.

**HOW WILL YOU HONOR FATHER O'BRIEN AND THE BLESSED SACRAMENT TODAY?** Won't you contribute to the Capital Campaign to expand the kitchen and replace the 54-year-old equipment? Would you help with our elder SSS in their health care? How about helping replace the 70-year-old bathrooms in the Early Childhood Wing? These needs will help our facilities grow for the next 72 years! **The architects have given us cost of this part of the renovation for \$700,000!**

**THANK YOU FOR YOUR YEARLY DONATIONS TO THE MAINTENANCE FUND, AND NOW CAPITAL CAMPAIGN, TO KEEP IMPROVING** this great campus, but especially the current projects of the Eymard Room of the FLC and OBH. And we thank God for our continued growth and stewardship of time, talent and treasure to serve the needs of the parish and the outreach to the community.

**ANNUAL OPERATION REPORT:** We were also able, through the bulletin sponsors (which I know you thank regularly) and our excellent bulletin editor and business manager, to get the statement of church revenue and expenses also in the bulletin. You will notice how we had a great year, due in part to the income from the Capital Campaign that flows through the operations and into the special account held in trust. We have not yet paid for many expenses for the roof in the last operational year. (You see above the current year-to-date.) We had some wonderful donations in our fundraising! Please note – these figures do not take into account the accounts that different parish groups have, individual and supporting their specific ministries, but whereby they donate to the parish’s life. PTO, for instance, is so generous in giving technology to each student as they being 5th grade. Our school income and expenses have changed dramatically with the EdChoice scholarship program. This is only the 3rd time in the school’s history where the parish has not had to assume the expenses of the school. Now, the rest of the parish’s budget, funded through tithing, needs that extra support to maintain the support of our other ministries – and not the Capital Campaign. Confused? Just ask and we will support your concerns by answering your questions.

**RESPECT LIFE SUNDAY:** We end the Season of Creation with a special time of prayer, with a new Holy Hour requested first by Pope Francis before he died but not promulgated also by Pope Leo XIV where we have “stations of creation” around our campus, praying for life and specifically God’s creation. Here’s our schedule on **Sunday, October 5:**

- **Pet Blessing: 12 Noon** around the Mary statue in front of the Fickel Narthex (center)
- **Stations of Creation:** Immediately following the blessing of pets, we will process from stop-to-stop (or in Catholic terms – station!) and have specific prayer for creation
- **Rally for Life: 1:00-2:00 PM** on Wilson Mills Road. Our annual announcement to the world that we respect all human life from conception to a natural death with members across the country.

According to legend, Saint Helena, mother of Emperor Constantine the Great, discovered the True Cross while on a pilgrimage to Jerusalem in the year 326. The Church of the Holy Sepulcher was built by Constantine on the site of discovery, and this September 14 marks the date of that church's dedication.

The Cross, of course, preceded Christian times and was the feared instrument of brutal Roman punishment. In his first letter to the Corinthians, Saint Paul famously spoke of the Cross as a "stumbling block to the Jews and an absurdity to the Gentiles." It was love that transformed that instrument of tortuous death into the way of our salvation.

We are confronted daily with the cross, in whatever form it takes in our personal lives. What gives that cross value, what turns it around, is our response to it. We take our cue on how to respond from today's First Reading: We acknowledge our sinfulness, we resolve to change, and we look to the Cross in humble obedience to God's will.


