The church is always open for prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle ("adoration"). Please make a visit to pray, as Saint Peter Julian Eymard would say, the "4-ends" of adoration, forgiveness, thanksgiving and petition. When the church is locked, see the pastor for the special parking area and code to enter the church to pray throughout the night in the tradition of nocturnal prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament.

A LETTER FROM FR. LANE



25th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: The Prophet Amos and the parable of Jesus remind us of the way God has a heart for the poor and those cheated in society. Even Psalm 113, that we have for today, echoes the support that God gives those who have been thrown down a “dunghill.” If we have ever experienced hard times and have appreciated the generosity and kindness of either family or strangers, we know how it transforms us and makes us want to always help others in need for the rest of our lives. We are called to reflect on our stewardship; and during the month of September, our parish reflects, and we personally commit to reviewing how we are good stewards for God and the Body of Christ. In the New Testament, Jesus discusses money and possessions frequently. Approximately 16 of the 38 parables focus on how to handle money and possessions. Additionally, it’s estimated that about one in every ten verses in the Gospels (around 288 verses) deal directly with the topic of money. Jesus used money-related teachings to illustrate broader spiritual lessons about values, priorities, and trust in God. May we continue to trust and build the Body of Christ, especially by our stewardship of our great parish.



PICTURES THIS WEEK:

We had such a great August here at SPB with our Eymard Triduum, 125th Anniversary Celebration of the SSS in the USA with Bishop Malesic, and the premiere of a new icon of Saint Peter Julian Eymard. especially gifted to our order for the 125th anniversary. We are so grateful for her talent and generosity; we now get to enjoy it behind the presider’s chair. And, above, we see the Pekos during their opening presentation for PSR. And we remember the great Bible Camp, which was a foreshadowing for Father Martin, who came and visited for the events to learn about the parish’s life.

PSR BEGAN but it is not too late to return and start the sessions for the coming year. **Contact Anna Peko: apeko@saintpaschal.com.** The picture in the “Calendar Highlights” area comes from our All Saints Day Mass when our PSR students dressed as a saint.

CONTINUED IMPROVEMENTS – FLC HANDICAP DOORS: It has taken a long time, but we finally were able to install special doors for the entrance to the Family Life Center, especially for those who use wheelchairs. We are so grateful to our anonymous donor for this improvement. And now that the roof project is nearing its completion, we are able to finalize the last of our landscaping upgrade that you have seen at other parts of the campus, starting with the family wishing for the Eymard Patio. We love our special donations to improve our campus! They are so special in making significant improvements; these are separate from our tithing to our parish operations and weekly support. Even more separate is our Capital Campaign for the improvements of our halls. Read below for those details.

QUARTERLY FINANCE UPDATE ON THE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN: Every September, parishes across the country highlight stewardship, how we may improve our time, talent and treasure and better our parishes. Each fiscal quarter, we highlight, for you, where we are financially with the Capital Campaign for the renovation of the Family Life Center (FLC) and O’Brien Hall (OBH). With the diocese’s approval of our last year finance report and the budget for this current fiscal year, we are able, over the next three weeks, to share our report. Today, I will focus on the Capital Campaign figures – a separate budget area for the parish: if you donate in the envelopes, this is for the parish’s operation (i.e., insurance, salaries for our staff, snowplow and salt, mega etc.). If you earmark a donation to FLC or OBH, we honor this – and have been, making this campaign successful in moving along, doing the projects as we receive the funds. Going forward, we will keep our stewardship section a regular report.

Here we are as of August 30, 2025:

- **TOTAL COLLECTED FROM PLEDGES:** \$1,231,489.67
- *Pledge balance yet to be paid by our parishioners:* **\$673,435.36**

 - Original Anonymous Donation to start the project (in 11/23): \$100,000.00
 - Capital Campaign donations 2024: \$718,682.99
 - Capital Campaign donations 2025: \$394,245.02
 - Anonymous OBH pledge/ donation Christmas 2025: \$600,000.00**\$1,812,928.01**
- **EXPENSES:**
 - Fundraising Company, postage & printing: \$117,540.31
 - StudioTechne Architects \$36,528.27
 - Capital Campaign Dinners (most donated) \$93.91
 - Warren Roofing (FLC) – *there will be one more final invoice* \$500,220.00**\$654,382.49**



HOW WILL YOU HONOR FATHER O'BRIEN AND THE BLESSED SACRAMENT TODAY? Won't you contribute to the Capital Campaign to expand the kitchen and replace the 54-year-old equipment? Would you help with our elder SSS in their health care? How about helping replace the 70-year-old bathrooms in the Early Childhood Wing? These needs will help our facilities grow for the next 72 years! **The architects have given us cost of this part of the renovation for \$700,000!**

THANK YOU FOR YOUR YEARLY DONATIONS TO THE MAINTENANCE FUND, AND NOW CAPITAL CAMPAIGN, TO KEEP IMPROVING this great campus, but especially the current projects of the Eymard Room of the FLC and OBH. And we thank God for our continued growth and stewardship of time, talent and treasure to serve the needs of the parish and the outreach to the community.

ANNUAL OPERATION REPORT: We were also able, through the bulletin sponsors (which I know you thank regularly) and our excellent bulletin editor and business manager to get the statement of church revenue and expenses also in the bulletin. You will notice how we had a great year, due in part of the income from the Capital Campaign that flows through the operations and into the special account held in trust. We have not yet paid for many expenses with the roof in the last operational year. (You see above the current, year-to-date. We had some wonderful donations in our fundraising! Please note – these figures do not take into account the accounts that different parish groups have individual and supporting their specific ministries, but whereby they donate to the parish's life. PTO, for instance, is so generous in giving technology to each student as they being 5th grade. Our school income and expenses have changed dramatically with the EdChoice scholarship program. This is only the 3rd time in the school's history where the parish has not had to assume the expenses of the school. Now, the rest of the parish's budget, funded through tithing, needs that extra support to maintain the support of our other ministries – and not the Capital Campaign. Confused? Just ask and we will support your concerns by answering your questions.

GET TO KNOW (SAINT) SISTER DOROTHY KAZEL, OSU: We will have a special Eucharistic Holy Hour on Tuesday, **September 30** at 7:00 PM in church with a special reflection by a fellow Ursuline Sister and Scripture reflections on the acting with God's justice in our world. This will be hosted by the Social Action Commission.

RESPECT LIFE SUNDAY: We end the Season of Creation with a special time of prayer, with a new Holy Hour requested first by Pope Francis before he died but not promulgated also by Pope Leo XIV where we have "stations of creation" around our campus, praying for life and specifically God's creation. Here's our schedule on Sunday, **October 5:**

- **Pet Blessing: 12:00 Noon** around the **Mary statue in front of the Fickel Narthex (center)**
- **Stations of Creation:** Immediately following the blessing of pets, we will process from stop to stop (or in Catholic terms – station!) and have specific prayer for creation
- **Rally for Life: 1:00-2:00 PM** on Wilson Mills Road. Our annual announcement to the world that we respect all human life from conception to a natural death with members across the country.

VOCATION COMMITTEE: Our tri-annual meeting to organize our vocation events is coming up **Monday, October 6, 2:45 PM in the Arkins Room.** We always need people of hospitality for our panel guests and folks to help us lead tours. We brainstorm about those we need to share their vocation story, and more! Help us promote religious life vocations, the single life as a disciple of Christ and marriage.

Thanks for all you do for SPB! So grateful for your stewardship and care! Special prayers to our students, teachers and families as they begin another great year together as "pilgrims of hope!"


