Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament (a liturgical act) occurs Thursdays from 9:30 am until 8:00 pm with special exposition time throughout the year (i.e., Taizé Eucharistic Holy Hours, Saint Ann Triduum, Saint Peter Julian Eymard Triduum, etc.). See inside the bulletin for details.

The church is always open for prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle ("adoration"). Please make a visit to pray, as Saint Peter Julian Eymard would say, the "4-ends" of adoration, forgiveness, thanksgiving and petition. When the church is locked, see the pastor for the special parking area and code to enter the church to pray throughout the night in the tradition of nocturnal prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament.

## A LETTER FROM FR. LANE



**27th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME:** The prophet Habakkuk introduces us to the themes of our Scriptures this weekend and words to end violence and promote God's vision. God's vision is one of integrity, faith and just living. Paul tells Timothy to use the gifts from his hands, his "ordination" and promote the gifts of the Holy Spirit within. Timothy and we are called to live the gifts of our faith and promote the goodness of God.

It is within this context that we begin Respect Life Month. If I may, I would like to quote here mostly from Benedictine Prioress Emerita and professor Emerita of Collegeville, Sister Ephrem Hollermann, who wrote an outstanding reflection on the respect for persons in *Give Us This Day*, October 2025 edition, that is so appropriate for our times:

*"If one considers the origins of the word "respect" it literally means to see again, as if to see for the first time. "Re-spect" is about seeing people afresh each and every day, "supporting with the greatest patience one another's weaknesses of body or behavior" (see the Rule of Saint Benedict 72.5 – hereafter RB). ... In Benedictine spirituality then, it is love that animates respect and builds community.*

*"Each human person holds the gift of goodness from the Spirit within and is called to "turn away from evil and do good" (RB 17). It is this gift of goodness that precludes any kind of disrespect shown toward other persons—be it vicious talk, deceit, injustice, lies, or slander (RB Prologue 17, 26-27). It is within these bookends of the Rule, ... that Benedict lays out a structure and builds the vision of a community of deep respect and love wherein the members see the face of Christ in each person they encounter.*

A community of respect and love is characterized by listening obedience, by taking counsel with one another when making decisions, by using the tools of good works, by esteeming silence, by practicing the steps of humility, by praying fervently in common and privately, by confessing faults, by daily service to one another, by caring for the sick, by following the daily *horarium*/schedule, by carrying out assigned daily work, and by hospitality to all guests.

Respect for all persons, regardless of class, background, or skill, runs like a golden thread throughout the entire *Rule of Saint Benedict*. Preeminent in the life and message of Jesus [Christ] in the Gospels, this value highlighted by [Saint] Benedict is, indeed, the call of each and every one of us.

May we see ourselves in the unborn child, in the person with a different political view, in the houseless, in the person on death row, in those in a nursing facility, in the one that society least loves or wants, and even wants in any one's country: may we see as God does and respect all of God's life!

**PICTURES THIS WEEK:** In my column pictures, I am at our SSS International HQ in Rome for a meeting of our International Mission Commission. We are charged with empowering and growing the mission of the SSS throughout the world. It is an honor to serve with these folks, who regularly meet on Zoom, and for the first time were able to meet in person for the Jubilee Year. We were there for a few days and pictured here on a break.

Your group leaders and *Paschal Life* will always try to reach you: help us do that by sharing your email and texting number.

**TWO MORE NEEDED – GOT IDEAS FOR THE PARISH?** Unfortunately, we begin our Pastoral Council year with two less folks on the council. Help the parish grow and get better! Please let me know if you can join us for our pastoral planning, once a month, and a chance for us to regularly evaluate and improve the parish's life. I also can share with you our Pastoral Council guidelines to help you decide if God is calling you to serve our parish in this way.

**VOCATION COMMITTEE:** Our tri-annual meeting to organize our vocation events is coming up **Monday, October 6, 2:45 PM in the Arkins Room**. We always need people of hospitality for our panel guests and folks to help us lead tours. We brainstorm about those we need to share their vocation story, and more! Help us promote religious life vocations, the single life as a disciple of Christ and marriage.

**ALTAR OF REMEMBRANCE – OCTOBER 29-NOVEMBER 23:** Last year, you may recall that for the first time we invited folks to bring photos of those who had died in the past year and others special to our lives. We will continue this practice again, for the "Altar of the Dead" by having a table in the place of honor in church. (This is where we place statues and sometimes crosses and the Advent wreath.) Bring your items to the piano area by **October 26** so that we may place them for you on this special table, beginning with the Holy Hour on **October 29**. This Eucharistic Holy Hour mentions ALL those who died in the past year and names are placed on the banners in the sanctuary.

Our second remembrance is at Masses of The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (formally called All Souls' Day) on **November 1** at the 4:30 PM Mass, and **November 2** (begins with Morning Prayer at 8:00 AM) Masses at 8:30 AM and 10:30 AM. These photos will be in place through November 23 (Christ the King). You may pick them up in the sacristy, November 24-26 (before Thanksgiving).







*Fun Fact:* October is known as the Month of the Holy Rosary because of its connection to the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary on October 7<sup>th</sup> and the significant Christian victory at the Battle of Lepanto on October 7, 1571. The Christian forces, facing a much larger and formidable Ottoman navy, were victorious in a battle that Pope St. Pius V attributed to the intercession of Mary and the prayers of the Rosary. To commemorate this victory, Pope St. Pius V instituted the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary on October 7<sup>th</sup>.

*Further,* Our Lady of Fatima emphasized the importance of the Rosary by identifying herself as "Our Lady of the Rosary" and instructing the visionaries to pray it daily for world peace, the end of wars, and the conversion of souls. She stated that the Rosary is a powerful defense against sin and heresy, fosters virtue and good works, and that perseverance in its recitation yields special grace.
