Our Community @ Prayer ministry continues the tradition of keeping vigil until the Lord Jesus Christ returns in glory. Our prayer extends the blessings of the Mass where we share in the Risen Christ's Body and Blood.

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament (a liturgical act) occurs Thursdays from 9:30 am until 8:00 pm with special exposition time throughout the year (i.e., Taizé Eucharistic Holy Hours, Saint Ann Triduum, Saint Peter Julian Eymard Triduum, etc.). See inside the bulletin for details.

The church is always open for prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle ("adoration"). Please make a visit to pray, as Saint Peter Julian Eymard would say, the "4-ends" of adoration, forgiveness, thanksgiving and petition. When the church is locked, see the pastor for the special parking area and code to enter the church to pray throughout the night in the tradition of nocturnal prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament.

We recall David being anointed king, the paradise giver from the cross reminding the repentant thief that they will be in paradise, the thankfulness of having a Savior who redeemed us from the cross, the journey we are all making to go back to the house of the Lord. May Christ always rule in our lives, and may we reflect the One we follow, the ultimate ruler of everything on earth and in the heavens.

THANKSGIVING WEEK EVENTS: Here are some items to place on your calendar:

- **TODAY, November 23, 3:00 PM:** Hillcrest Interfaith Service at Messiah Lutheran in Lyndhurst, next to the famous dealership on Mayfield Road (and another vegetable store).
- **Tuesday, November 25, 9:00 AM** Mass with the Grandparents and Grandpals of our school.
- **Thursday, November 27, 8:00 AM** Morning Prayer, 8:25 AM Rosary, 9:00 AM Mass and for the Mass bring your canned food (NOT EXPIRED) items for our Helping Hands Pantry; receive a special loaf of bread from our family to your family during the Mass.



NEXT WEEK BEGINS ADVENT: Our theme is "Jesus Christ, Hope for the World," with our theme song for the event, the famous song we sing a lot of times at Communion **MAKE YOUR ADVENT COUNT!** Here are a few reminders:

If you can't find the colors of candles you wish for your Advent Wreath, do not fret. You can use white, with ribbons of different colors, or mix it up!

- For the Advent Wreath, we keep our tradition of needing folks to assist, or if you wish. If the Mass is for your family, please let the priest know, even a week ahead of time. Here's what we do:
 - Before Mass the priest and/or George Zagar or another sacristan will recruit a parish family to light the wreath.

- On the First week of Advent after the homily, the priest invites the family forward during the Creed to come into the sanctuary to light the candle.
- During the last prayer of the Universal Prayers, the "Blessing of the Advent Wreath" is recited.
- After the prayer, the family lights the candle and all sing "Rejoice, Rejoice..." from "O Come, O Come Emmanuel."
- On the next three Sundays, the family lights the candle during the Opening Procession and Song. The priest has the family go before him; they go to the Advent Wreath and light the candle while we are singing the Opening Song. The family comes down next to the priest and they bow together in reverence to the altar.
- A family can request to light the wreath, or one is chosen usually by a priest, and they process into the church with the priest and altar servers at the beginning of Mass. Those who volunteer ahead of time are listed on the bulletin board in the vesting sacristy.
- Please note – there is no *Gloria* during Advent, so don't be late for Mass and **and miss the beginning of the readings.**

- **ADVENT RETREAT KNIGHT:** A "Yes" That Brings Us Christmas. Tuesday, December 2, 6:00 PM in church with guest speaker Sr. Rita Schroeder, SND.
- **ADVENT GIVING TREE:** During this holy season of giving, we will have the Helping Hands Advent Giving Tree in the Fickel Narthex for your support of a houseless family or another family in one of the other residences across NE Ohio.
- **#weGiveCatholic on December 2:** It's our 24 hours of giving to our parish – and through our Catholic school we will get more tables for the cafeteria – O'Brien Hall. Each table costs \$2,150.00.
- **ADVENT LESSONS & CAROL:** Thanks to our Music & Liturgy Director, Roberta Modica, we will have this Advent custom return to SPB on **Wednesday, December 17, 7:00 PM** in church with all our musicians (singers and instrumentalists). **Thanks for placing this event on your calendar for some prayer, celebration and fun in the midst of Advent.**

EXPOSITION AND PRAYER IN THE PRESENCE OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT: Also, for Advent, we are adding times of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament beside Thursdays.

- **7:30-8:15 AM, Monday-Friday** with Morning Prayer
- **9:30-10:30 AM, Monday-Friday** after Mass
- You may come and pray in the chapel 24/7, just ask for the password.

ADDING MONDAY NIGHT CONFESSIONS – EVERY WEEK: PSR Parents have approached me on Monday nights to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation and Penance. The other priests and I will begin rotating each Monday night from 6:00-7:00 PM to offer the Sacrament in the Penance Chapel in church, next to the baptismal font. Come for this special time, or you may always make a visit to the Parish Office where we also have a reconciliation room.



THIS WEEK'S PICS: Our one Preschool Classroom wanted to thank me for being their pastor and give me a "hand of gratitude." How thoughtful! College students make a special point to visit Saint Ann Shrine. And we had a wonderful "Theology on Tap" at Collision Bend, on Babbit Road in Euclid. We had 50 folks join us, including a person who saw the ad online from Streetsboro. We plan to have another one this winter.

FROM OUR PASTORAL COUNCIL SUGGESTION BOX: More suggestions or questions from our Fickel Narthex box:

- **Fix the Blessed Mother Statue outside. Sad.** During the year, we regularly clean the statue due to the elements and birds.
- **Please raise the air conditioning – it's too cold! Thank you!** It's always set for 72 degrees, the industry standard and for heating, it's 68. You can see the thermometers throughout the church that measure the temperature. Knowing these settings, based on a building that is a "green house" and designed to hold 1,000 people, you can measure this with your home settings and square feet.
- **Cut way back on the incense.** What can we say, we have taught our servers, and they get into the ministry. Like any parent, you repeat the message over and over. P.S. We use hypoallergenic incense pebbles.
- **Do you have a box for eyeglasses?** Yes, the Lions still collect eyeglasses, it is located in the Fickel Narthex.
- **Although operational costs are very high and all should contribute to the extent they can, let us keep writing about finances in the bulletin to a minimum. This emphasis can be disturbing and takes the emphasis away from Jesus Christ and prayer.** It's nice to hear this minority view from time to time since the majority of folks want transparency here at SPB based on the feedback that we receive. And, as we saw from September through November, Jesus has many stories, parables and discussions about stewardship. It's what is necessary to have a great parish, centered in Christ.



6:30 PM SUNDAY: WE NEED YOUR HELP! This Mass has grown in participation: we need additional Communion Ministers, lectors and ushers. It's not that we want to rush, but it assists and facilitates things for the ritual and also allows for more folks to share their baptismal service. We also appreciate the youth coming forward to usher, too!

THE JUBILEE YEAR IS ENDING SOON – HAVE YOU MADE A VISIT TO SAINT ANN? We always enjoy the impromptu weekend visits of folks from other parishes or college students who want to make their jubilee pilgrimages to holy doors across the diocese, the nation and the world. These students came from all over the diocese to come to the Diocesan Shrine of Saint Ann, here on the north end of the property. **Have you made your visit?** You can also come, even after the Jubilee Year is over, however, it is important to note that **Sunday, December 28** is the last day. Sadly, our Jubilee Year banner is over as we move into Advent.

Have a blessed Thanksgiving! On behalf of the Blessed Sacrament Community, the Pastoral Staff and the Sisters of Notre Dame at the convent, may you have a healthy and happy week of gratitude. **We are grateful for your stewardship and care!** Let us continue to pray for each other and blessings to you as you begin Advent next Sunday.

ANGEL SCHOLARSHIP FUND: The Angel Scholarship Fund grew by \$8.1 million in 2024 which was a 27% increase from 2023. Saint Paschal Baylon had 109 parishioners donate to this fund while claiming a tax credit. The total amount from our parish donors was \$116,441.00; these dollars went to support families in 17 different schools in the Cleveland Diocese. **Your state taxes can benefit our Catholic schools.** Make a charitable donation to the Angel Scholarship Fund and “turn tax dollars into tuition” through an Ohio income **TAX CREDIT** of up to \$750.00 (\$1,500.00 if married filing jointly) against your 2025 state tax liability. Donations can be designated to benefit **Saint Paschal Baylon School** or another school in the Diocese of Cleveland.
