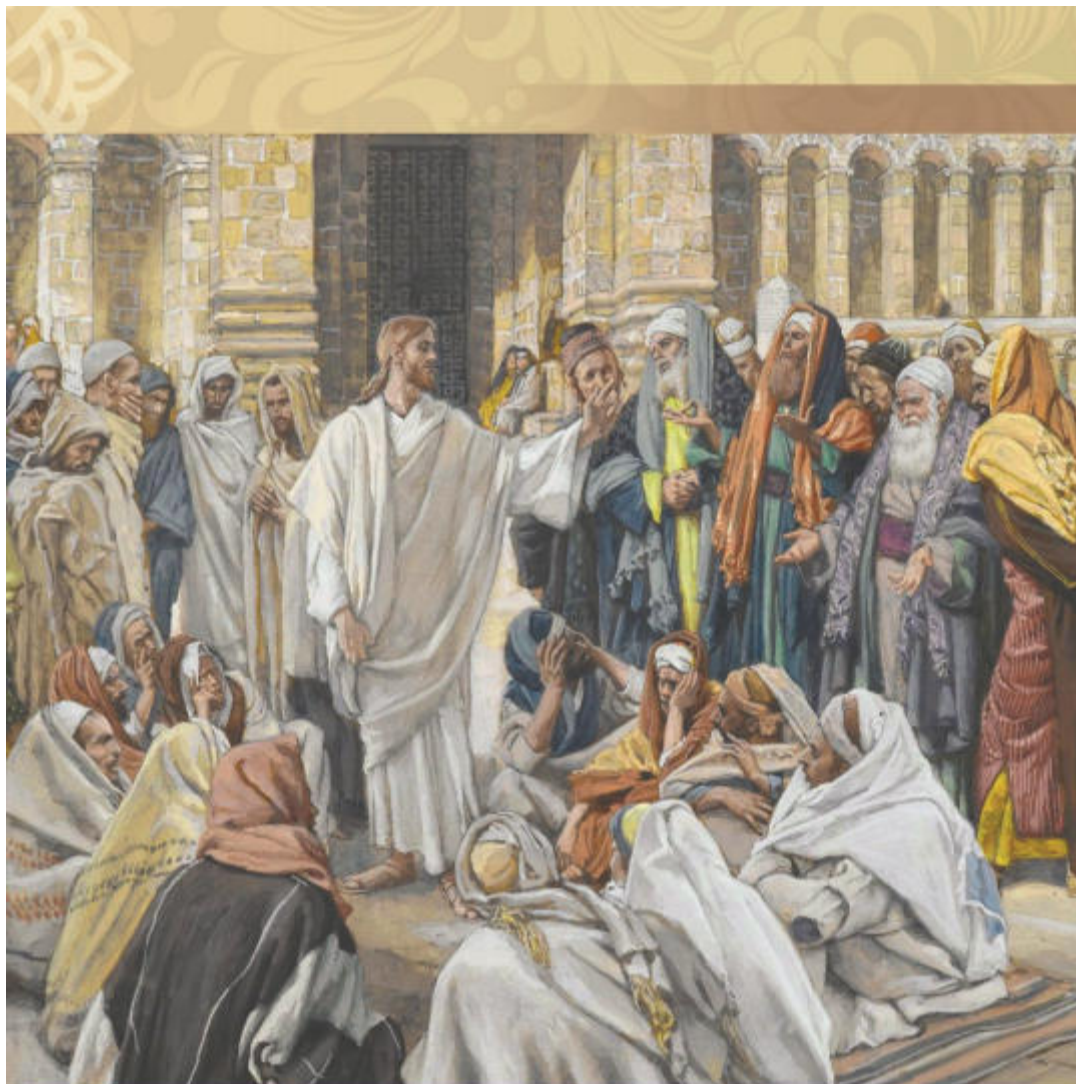

WHAT IS CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD?

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is an approach to the religious formation of children starting at age 3. Children gather in an "atrium", a special room prepared for them, which contains simple, yet beautiful materials they use to discover the richness and fullness of our Catholic faith. What makes CGS different from most traditional programs is that the primary goal of the catechist is not to simply pass on information but to encourage a response from the child.

WHAT IS SCHOOL OF RELIGION?

School of Religion is religious education for public school and home-schooled children in 1st-8th grade. Classes are Wednesday from 4:30 PM –5:45 PM or 6:30 PM –7:45 PM.

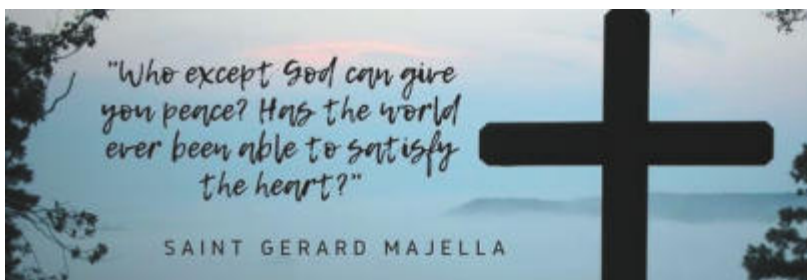

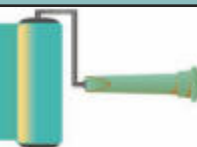

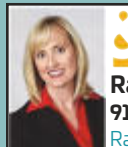
