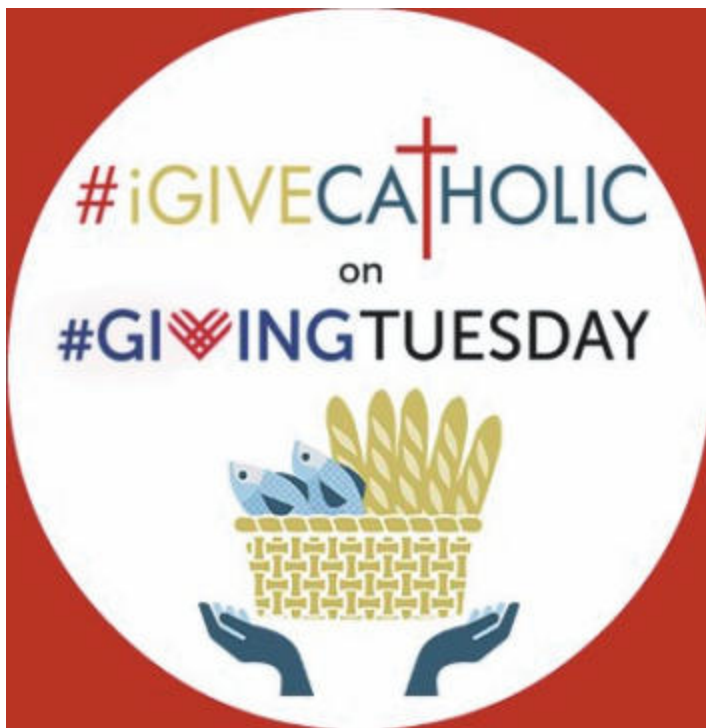

Jesus is inviting you into a deeper relationship with him in the Adoration Chapel. What better way to prepare your heart than through EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION.

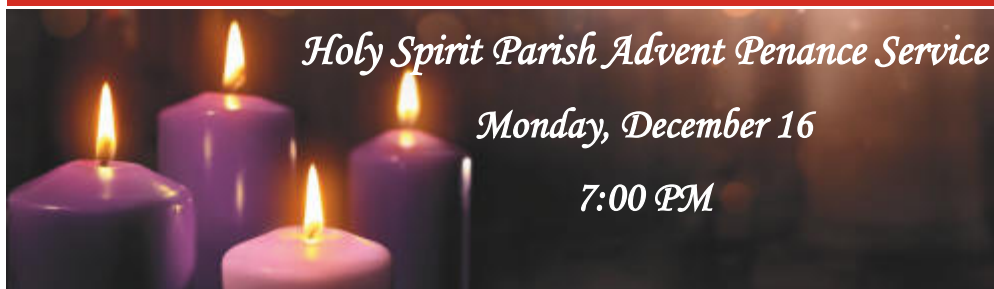
