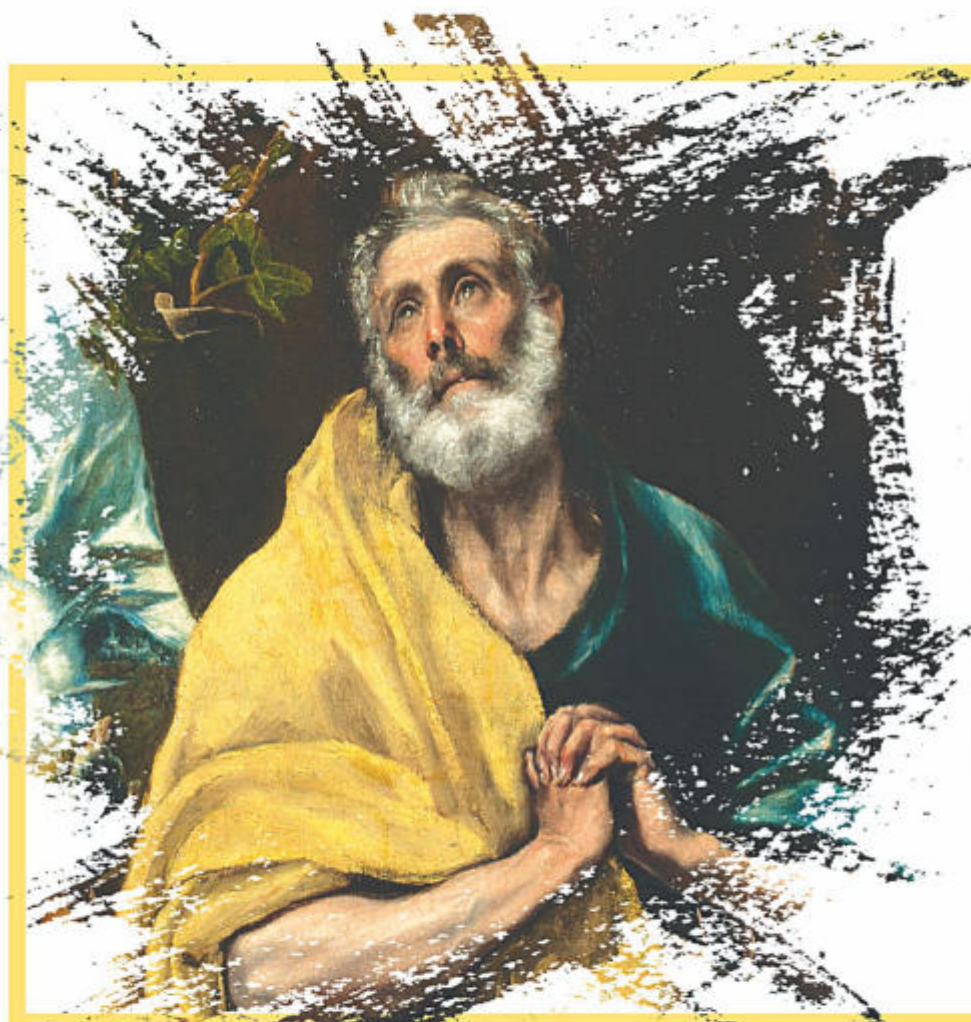

Pasta Sauce, Canned Peas, Flour**

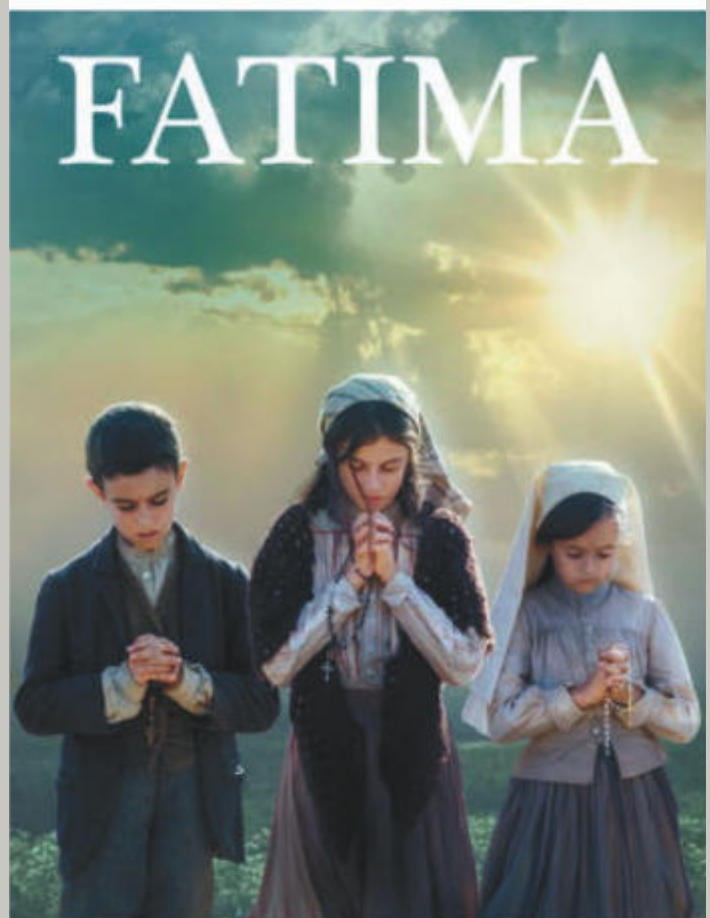

Why don't we follow them

The three children lived in Fatima, Portugal. Francisco Marto was 8 and his sister Jacinta was 6 and their cousin Lucia dos Santos was 9.

Their village is made of houses built of stucco with red tile roofs and cobblestone streets.

Do you see the sheep? That means they live in a farming community. While taking care of sheep the children play games, sing songs, and spend some time praying.

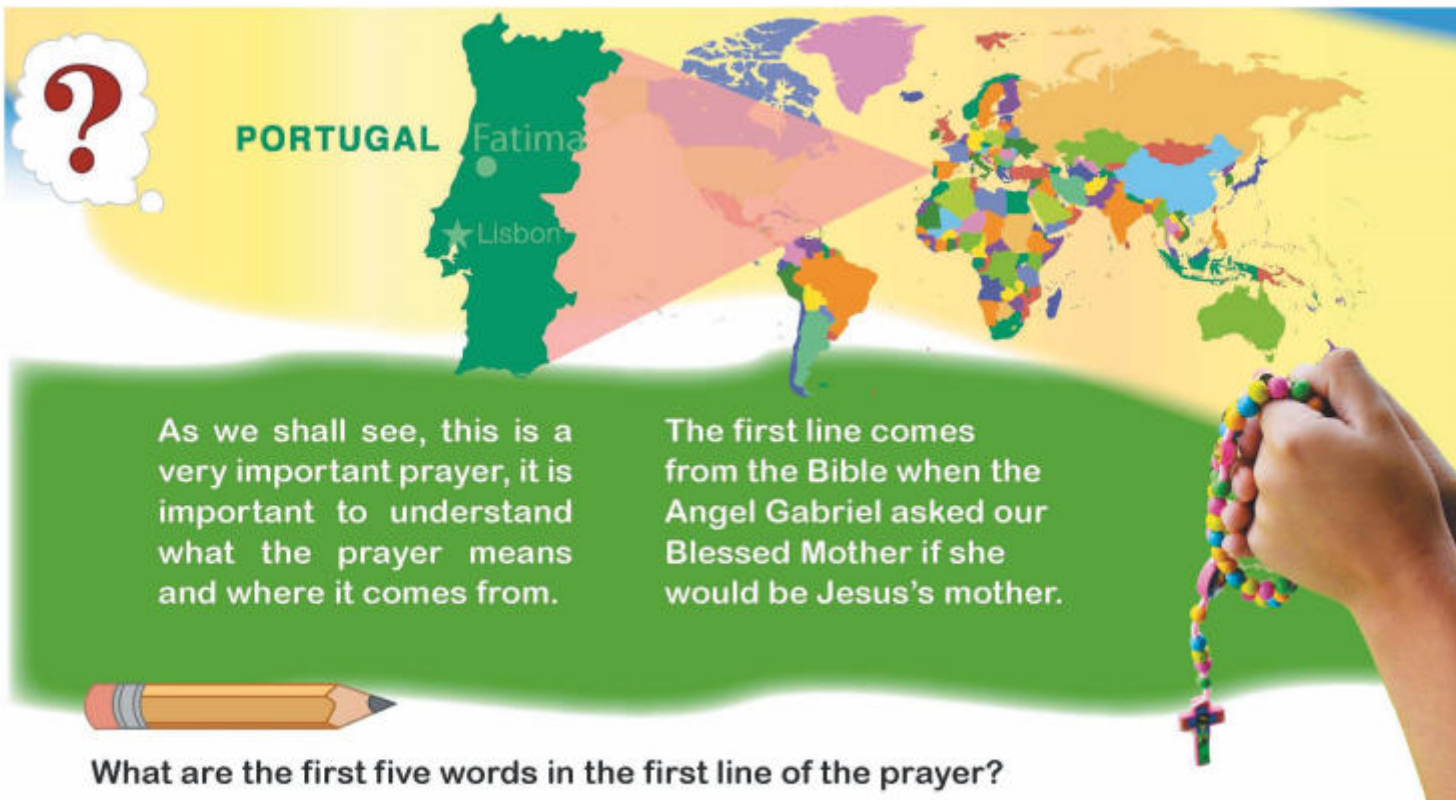

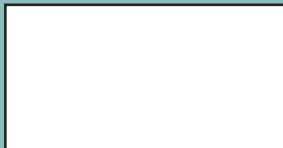
