

A NOTE FROM FATHER ANDREW

This weekend we hear proclaimed in the first reading at Mass an exhortation from Joshua to the People of God: "If it does not please you to serve the LORD, decide today whom you will serve, the gods your fathers served beyond the River or the gods of the Amorites in whose country you are now dwelling. As for me and my household, we will serve the LORD" (Joshua 24:15). God's people had a choice: to be faithful or unfaithful. This is a choice every believer must make for themselves each day. However, Joshua speaks on behalf of not only himself but his whole household: "As for me and my household, we will serve the LORD" (Joshua 24:15). An important truth is contained in Joshua's statement. We are not alone in our journey with God. Our personal faith is always in relationship with the larger whole. The larger Body of Christ is made up of smaller communities and households. In essence, the whole Church, like each parish, is a community of communities, as Pope Francis has affirmed. We are not alone. We are our brother's keeper. We are truly "in this together." But being in a community is not easy. We each bring unique gifts, but we also challenge one another in our opinions and actions. We are held together by a common faith, but we may disagree when it comes to matters of prudential judgment. In our disagreements, we are still called to exhibit charity and strive for unity and peace. The lack of unity in the Church is a great scandal to the world. The Evil One relishes division. Thanks be to God there is hope. If we address the division in our own hearts (such as the battle for faithfulness), then we can address the divisions in our homes. The world begins with me. We each have the responsibility for peace and unity in the world. Since we have all been wounded by division, we also all have a share in the healing our homes, community, and world need. My prayer for our parish is that we take our wounds of division seriously and call on the Holy Spirit from the bottom of our hearts to guide us in our work of healing and peace. Come Holy Spirit!




