Funerals: Please contact the Pastor before final arrangements are made.

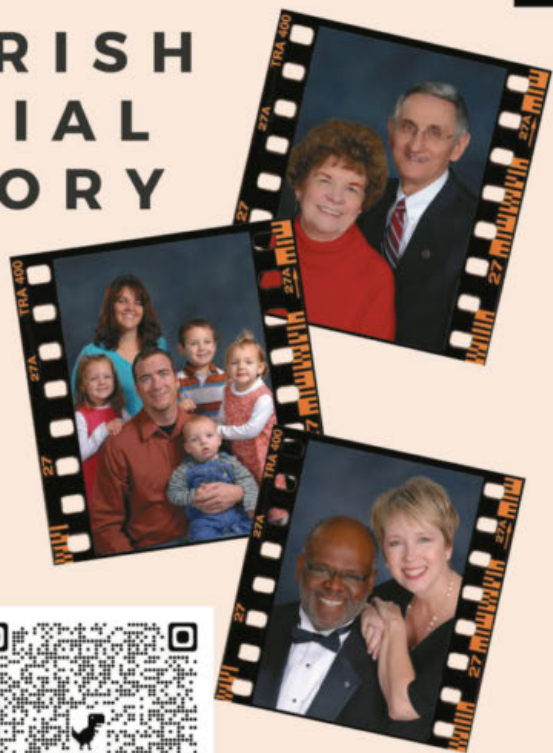

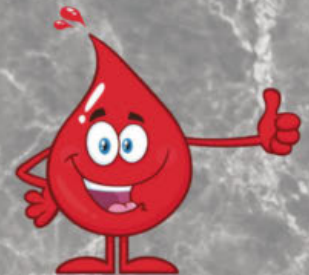

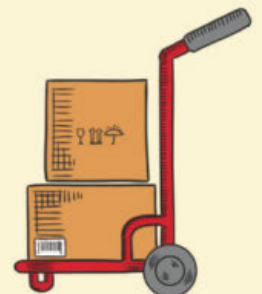
Afghan Asylum Assistance

We are looking for attorneys, paralegals, or law students that could volunteer. Volunteers will assist with completing immigration legal documents and supporting clients in writing their story/need for asylum. Our long term goal is to also have attorneys and DOJ reps volunteer to be an Afghan Asylum Advocate that would represent the client at USCIS.
