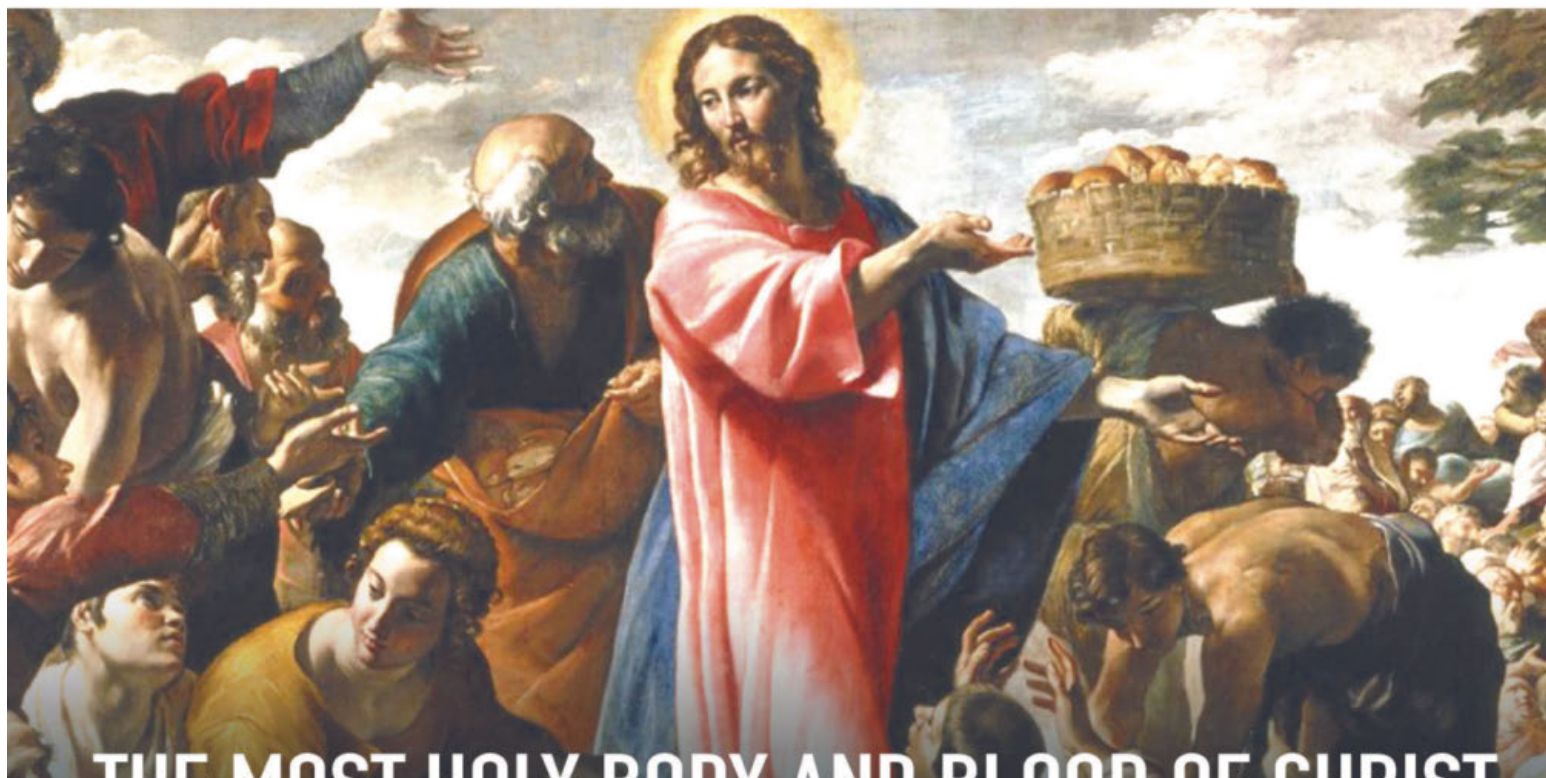

Dear Friends, with hearts full of gratitude, we want to thank you for your ongoing support of Wyandotte and Olathe Pregnancy Clinics with our most recent 2022 Baby Bottle Boomerang. We will be collecting filled bottles this weekend and next weekend at parishes. Watch in the near future for you parish totals. A couple weeks ago a young girl walked into our clinic seeking an abortion. She was determined. An advocate spoke with her, shared her desire for her safety and wellbeing, gave her abortion information and told her that no matter what she decided we are here for her. The young woman took her card and left and we prayed. A week later she called for an ultrasound. She asked if the baby was fully formed. Staff explained all the organs were present, only needed time to grow. When she saw the sonogram, she was surprised to see hands and feet, even toes fully formed. As is so often the case, after seeing her little one on ultrasound, she chose life for her baby and is incredibly grateful she took the time to get all the information. Together we are making a difference in our world, one life, one family at a time.

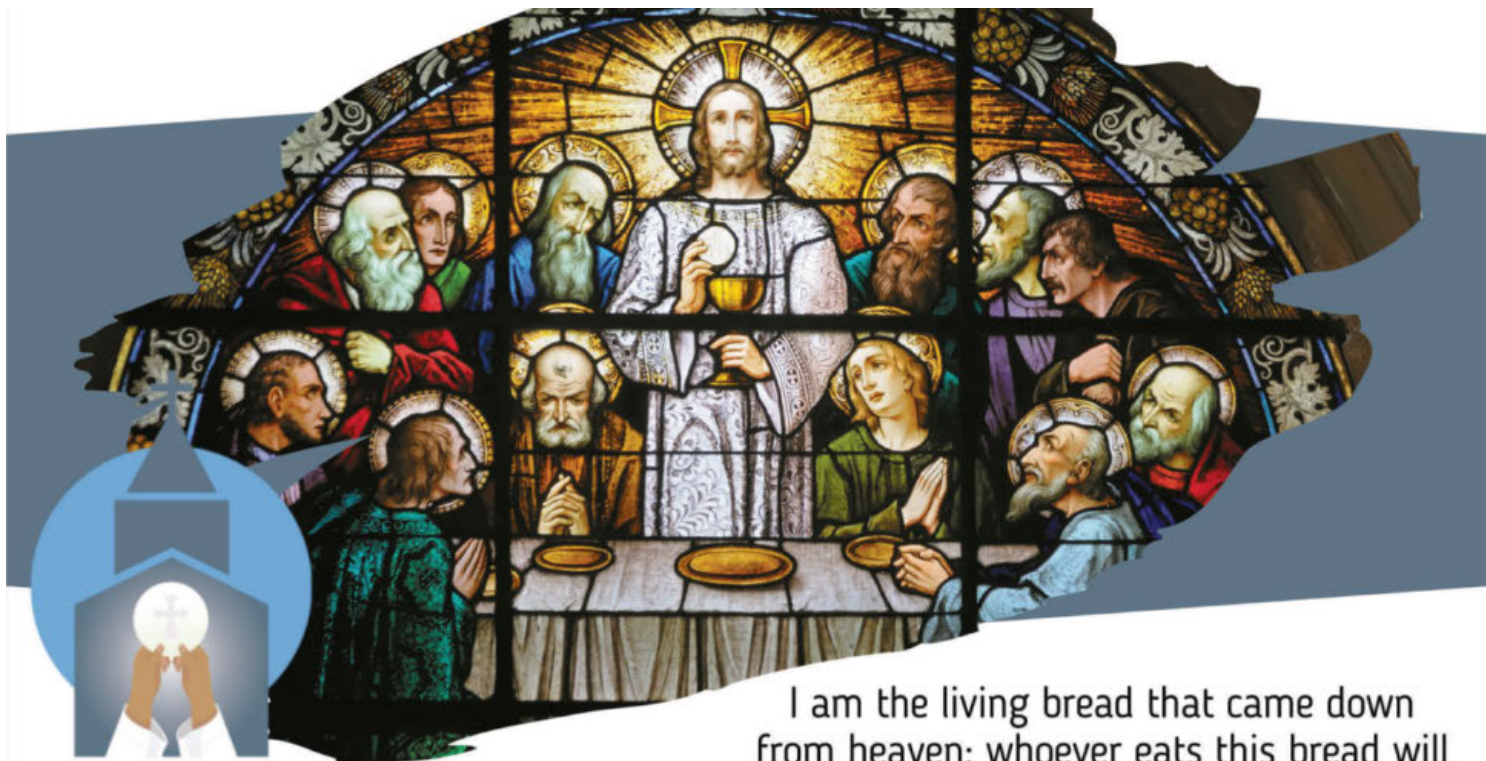

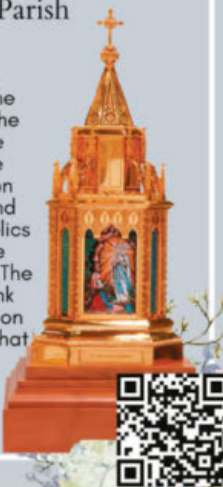

### Why do we venerate relics?

At the heart of the veneration of the relics of the saints, we find the Catholic faith, in particular the dogma of the resurrection of the flesh and the confidence in the power of intercession of the saints. The relics are not worshipped (veneration must be clearly distinguished from adoration and worship, which are due to God alone), but the relics of the martyrs are venerated to adore the One whose martyrs, that is to say witnesses, they are. 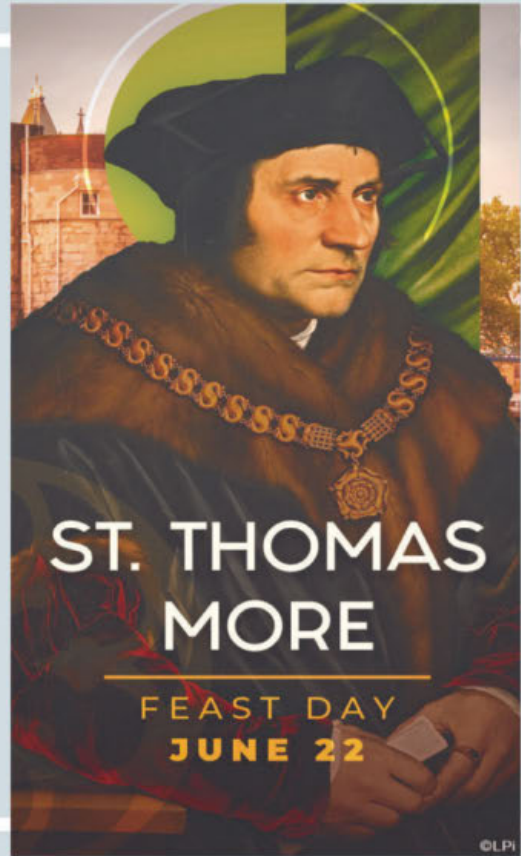

### Saint of the Week

Sir Thomas More was a humanist and statesman in Tudor England. He is still widely known today as the author of Utopia. More was a prolific writer and theologian. A true martyr of the Church, he was beatified by Pope Leo XIII in 1886, and canonized by Pope Pius XI on May 19, 1935. More was born in London in 1478, the son of Sir John More, a lawyer and judge. He attended Oxford where he studied Latin and Greek, as well as formal logic. He left Oxford in 1494 to train as a lawyer in London. After attaining the Bar, he spent time discerning a call to the priesthood. Though attracted to the Franciscan order More remained a lay Christian, continuing to fast, pray, and wear a hair shirt. He was married twice, the loving father of three daughters, a stepdaughter by his second marriage, and one son. More wrote many letters to his children when he was away on business and his daughters were known for their academic abilities, as they received the same education as his son, an anomaly at the time.

More rose to the Privy Council in 1514. He became the good friend and advisor to Henry VIII, and in 1521 he was knighted. In 1529 he was made Lord Chancellor of England. However, this appointment was the beginning of the end for the saint. He could not support the break with the Church in Rome when Henry failed to receive from the Pope the annulment of his first marriage to Katherine of Aragon to wed Anne Boleyn. More resigned as Lord Chancellor and continued to refuse to accept Henry as the head of the Church in England. Eventually he was imprisoned, tried, and sentenced to a traitor's death, to be hanged, drawn, and quartered. Henry commuted the sentence of his former friend to the more humane beheading. More was executed at Tower Hill, on July 6, 1535, before his death he famously proclaimed that he was "the king's good servant, but God's first."
