FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Monday of this week is a day for celebration. On that day, Bishop Kagan will ordain two of our seminarians to the priesthood: Deacons Dominic Bouck and Jarad Wolf. As all young Catholic men should, these men listened for God's call. Most men are called to marriage. A few to religious life. And some, yes, to the priesthood. That is the calling these two men have discerned. They are to become priests of Jesus Christ, in the Diocese of Bismarck. They will spend the rest of their lives bringing people into the Church at baptism, teaching people about God and his Church, forgiving sins in Confession, and bringing the Real Presence of Jesus into our churches...and into *us* at Holy Communion. As priests of the Diocese of Bismarck, specifically, these men will likely spend the rest of their lives here, in western North Dakota, serving our communities. We thank God for the gift of these new priests, and we ought to pray for them, that they be holy.

As a priest, I enjoy attending ordinations for several reasons. They remind me of my own ordination day, back in 2011. But even more importantly, ordinations are days on which us priests gain new brothers. So often people

focus on what a young man must give up to answer a call to the priesthood: marriage and family, for example. And that is a great sacrifice, as marriage and family are great goods! But we must not forget that a priest's life also includes the blessing of priestly fraternity. United in service of the Lord, in our diocese, we priests share a great bond of friendship. We will be coworkers and priestly brothers all of our days. And let us not forget, priests do have, in a sense, *huge* families... all of you. It is a great blessing for us priests to serve you, and get to know you.

What a great blessing God gives us in the priesthood! May more young men be open to that vocation, should God call them to it! Please pray for these new priests, and for all priests!


