—**tomorrow:** On June 13th-14th, about 30 bicyclists will be staying over at Holy Rosary Church on their way across the country from Seaside, OR, to Portland, ME.

The Fuller Center Bike Adventure is an ecumenical Christian ministry dedicated to eliminating poverty housing worldwide. Participating cyclists have raised funds to participate in the ride. In addition to bicycling an average of 70 miles a day, riders will be speaking to church groups, media, and civic organizations. They will also be putting their hands to work on Fuller Center construction projects across the country on "build days." On Monday, June 13th, the group will ride to Stanley from Williston. things that I want my parish to be.

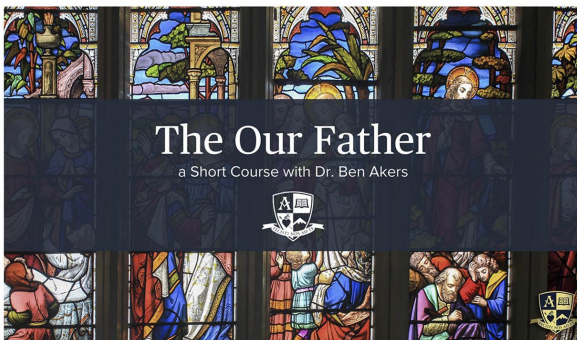
