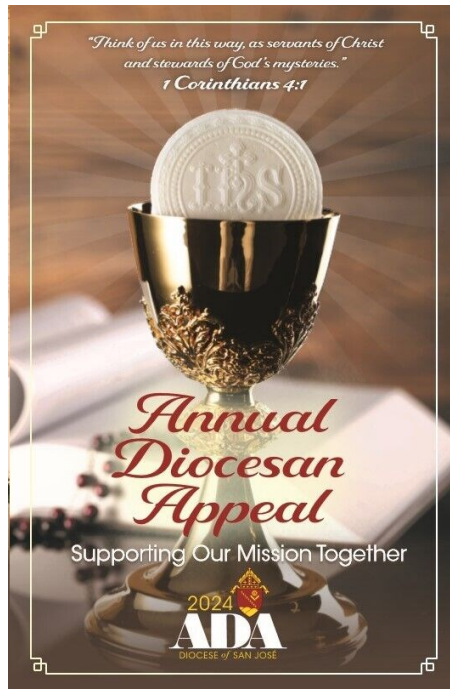

Any money over the parish goal will be rebate back to St. Martin Parish for use in repairs especially for termite treatment for the church which is most needed at this time.

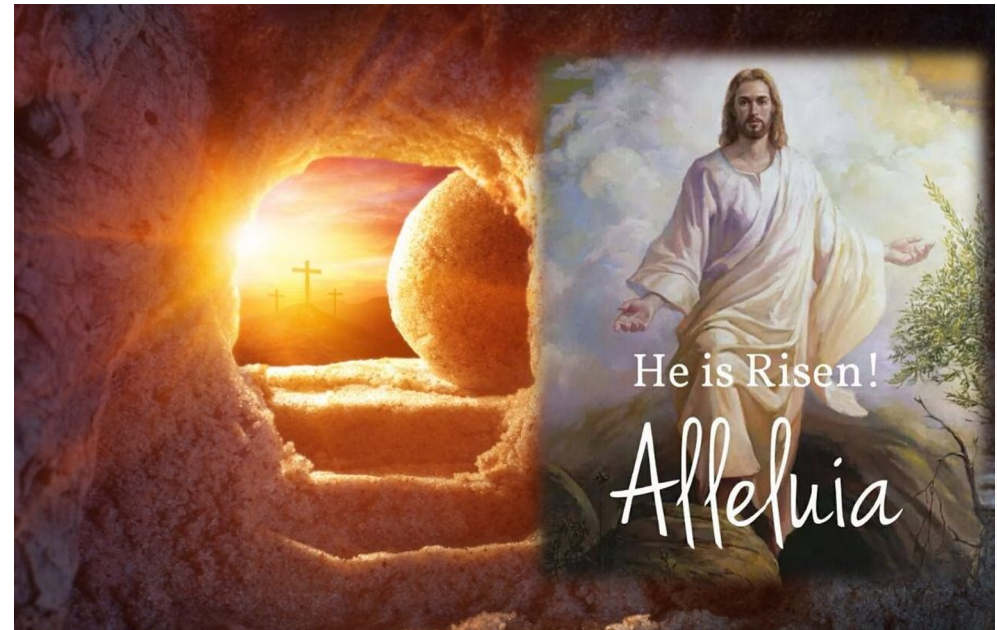

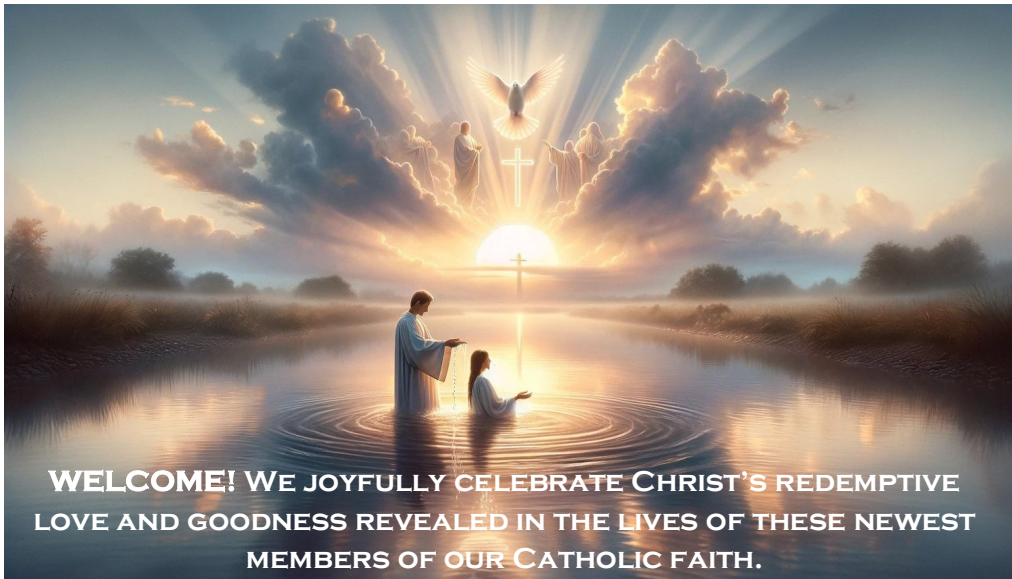
ROMANS 6:4 (NIV)

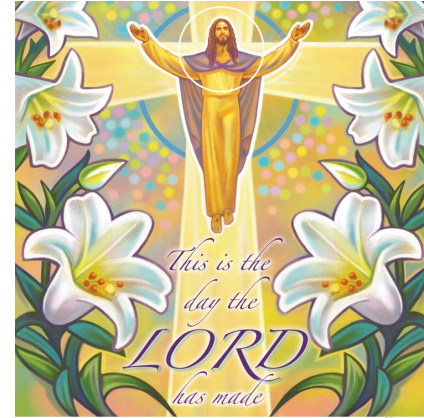

Sáng sớm ngày thứ nhất đầu tuần mới, tảng đá lấp cửa mồ đã mở toang. Năm mồ lạnh lẽo, chật hẹp, tối tăm đã mở tung ra như đầy sức sống và bình an. Tảng đá lấp mộ làm sao giữ được Đấng Phục Sinh! Năm mồ chỉ là giai đoạn chuyển tiếp. Nó giống như lối đi ngầm dưới mặt đất, sẽ mở lên tầng trời vinh quang. Tảng đá đam mê dục vọng...Ai sẽ giúp chúng ta lăn những tảng đó ra?

Xin thưa là chính Chúa Giêsu Phục Sinh. Ngài sẽ giúp ta lăn tảng đá đó ra khỏi đời mình và làm cho tâm hồn ta được phục sinh để sống bình an. Đấng Phục Sinh đã bật tung tảng đá niêm phong, từ cõi chết, Người sống lại vinh quang, mở lối vào sự sống mới. Chúa Giêsu sống lại, chân lý đã chiến thắng, tình yêu vượt trên hận thù và sự sống mạnh hơn sự chết. Phục Sinh là niềm tin và hy vọng cho người Kitô hữu vào sự sống mai sau: "Nếu chúng ta đã chết với Đức Kitô, chúng ta sẽ cùng sống với Người: đó là niềm tin của chúng ta" (Rm 6,8).

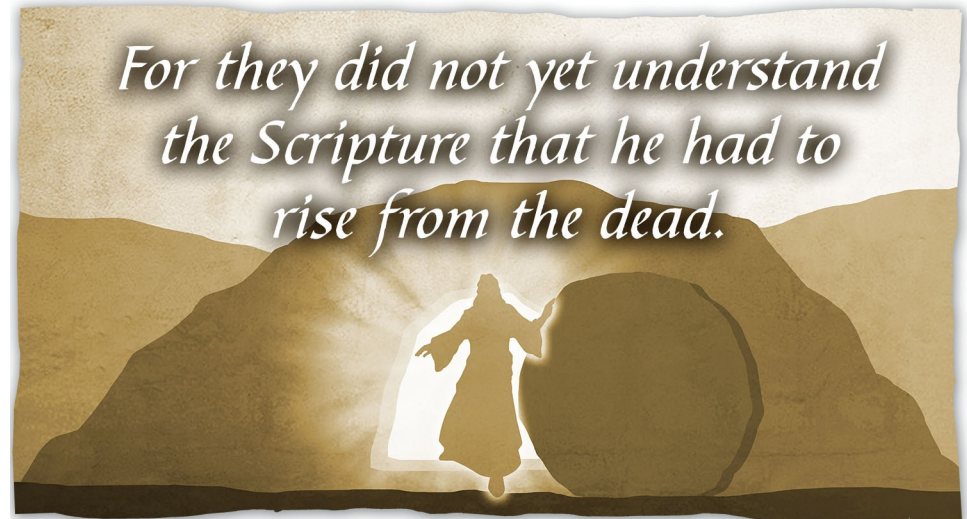

The gospel reading according to John

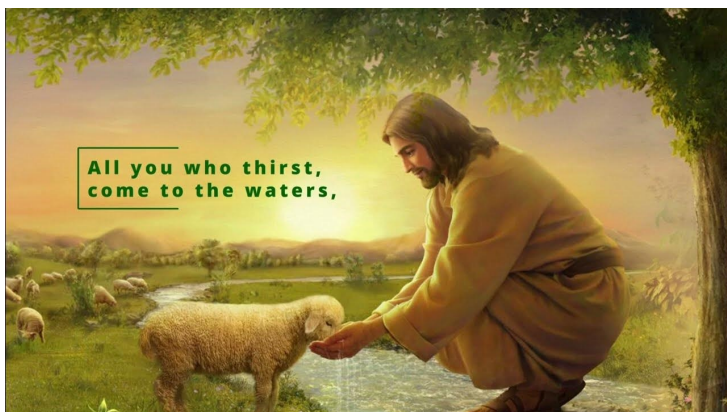
On the first day of the week,
