REFLECTION

Caution: Spirit at Work

If Pentecost celebrates the gifts of the Spirit, it can tempt us to separate the Spirit from the Father and Jesus. Sometimes we think of the Father as the God of the Old Testament, Jesus as center of New Testament, and the Spirit as God of the present age, almost as if the Father and Jesus were enjoying their retirement. Actually, all three persons share one God-life. Instead of three gods debating the fate of the universe, we have one God who is over all and in all.

The Spirit has been active in all ages. The prophets were empowered by the Spirit to proclaim God's word to Israel. Jesus was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit led Jesus into the desert at the beginning of his ministry. (Search the word "spirit" in the four gospels and it appears 75 times.) Jesus was filled with the Spirit as he preached and worked miracles. Then at Pentecost the disciples were filled with the Spirit.

So what about Pentecost? It is really about using our gifts and sharing the good news. The Spirit gives us the power, courage, and energy to do this. The Spirit's gifts are meant to be shared. The prophets could not help proclaim God's message. Jesus shared all he knew with his disciples. The disciples went out to the world to spread the news of Jesus' death and resurrection. So we, too, are given gifts to be shared.

The greatest gift we have been given is the news of our salvation. This feast reminds us to share that with others. We may do that by example, as when we worship together, forgive others, give to the poor or help someone in need. We can also share that news by teaching our children about God and his love for them, teaching them to pray, or sharing our faith with other adults. As we come to realize how much God has done for us and how close he is to us, we will want to share that with others. Obviously, we can't make everyone believe in Jesus. But how sad would it be if someone we know was looking for the truth and we neglected to offer it?

Hơi thở của Thiên Chúa ...

Không phải ngẫu nhiên mà Gioan liên kết biến cố Phục sinh của Đức Giêsu với việc trao ban Thần Khí. Trong Kinh Tin Kính, chúng ta quả quyết rằng, Thánh Thần là "Thiên Chúa, là Đấng ban sự sống". Việc trao ban sự sống này, trước hết chính Đức Giêsu đã đón nhận: khi lôi kéo Đức Giêsu ra khỏi quyền lực của tử thần, Thần Khí của Thiên Chúa đã đạt thành tích của bậc thầy!

Trong con người thụ tạo của ta, vì không phải là thần linh, nên mang tính hữu hạn, thì "tinh thần" và "thần xác" liên kết với nhau trong mọi tình huống. Nhưng dù mạnh đến đâu, tinh thần trong ta cũng nhận ra một suy sụp cuối cùng, không cho phép nó cầm giữ lại thần xác của mình: "con người" cũng có nghĩa là phải chết! Nhưng trước vũ trụ thụ tạo hay chết đó, Đức Kitô không những được trang bị những năng lực hữu hạn của tinh thần con người, nhưng Người còn nhận được những năng lực vô biên dành riêng cho Thiên Chúa.

Đức Kitô mang trong mình một Thần Khí hoàn toàn khác với tinh thần của con người, nên không sử dụng Thánh Thần, là Đức Chúa và là Đấng ban sự sống? Đức Giêsu phá bỏ mọi thứ rào cản sự kiện Ngài đột nhiên xuất hiện giữa các môn đệ đang bị nhốt kín, chứng tỏ rằng Người không để cho bất cứ một chướng ngại vật nào có khả năng cầm giữ được Người đến "đứng giữa các người thuộc về mình. Người đã nhận một luồng sinh khí đặc biệt mới mẻ, biến Người trở thành một "thần thể thiêng liêng", một thần thể được sống sự sống của Thánh Thần tác động (1 Cr 15: 44).

Cuộc sáng tạo cuối cùng: "Hãy thổi vào các bộ xương chết khô này, để chúng được sống" (Ed 37:9).

Có một cuộc sáng tạo trong quá khứ đó là sự phát sinh sức sống đầu tiên lúc khởi sự thời gian. Cũng sẽ có một cuộc sáng tạo trong tương lai, đó là sự sống lại sau cùng, vào ngày tận thế. Nhưng luôn có một cuộc sáng tạo hiện hành: đó là "Hơi thở" của Thiên Chúa đang hoạt động. Tôi tin Thánh Thần là Thiên Chúa, và là Đấng ban sự sống!

Đó là hơi thở mang sức sống! Thế nên, chính chúng ta cũng đang hô hấp hơi thở của Thiên Chúa. "Hơi thở" của Thiên Chúa chính là Chúa Thánh Thần. Chúa Thánh Thần là nguyên lý tạo dựng. Thiên Chúa tái tạo lại con người, cũng bằng "hơi thở" là Chúa Thánh Thần. Chúa Thánh Thần cũng là nguyên lý của sự tái tạo.

Đó là hình ảnh cảm kích về Thiên Chúa duy nhất, Đấng làm cho tất cả chúng ta sống động! Khi đàm đạo với ông Nicôđêmo, Đức Giêsu đã dùng chính hình ảnh đơn sơ về gió trên đây: "Gió muốn thổi đâu thì thổi. Gió làm cho sống động" (Ga 3:6-8). Lễ Ngũ Tuần kín đáo và thân tình này mà Tin Mừng Gioan giữ lại, chỉ là khúc dạo đầu của Lễ Ngũ Tuần ngoạn mục, ở đó tác động Thần Khí sẽ biến đổi ngay tức khắc các môn đệ. Tuy nhiên, khi đặt biến cố Vượt Qua và biến cố Ngũ Tuần một cách nào đó bên cạnh nhau, thánh Gioan nhấn mạnh sự duy nhất sâu xa của hai biến cố này, thánh Gioan khẳng định sự bền vững của chúng trong viên cảnh mới.

DID YOU KNOW

The timing and origin of Pentecost

- **Pentecost** always occurs 50 days after the death and resurrection of Jesus, and 10 days after his ascension into heaven.
- The name of the day itself is derived from the Greek word "**pentecoste**," meaning **50th**.
- It is one of the most important feast days of the liturgical year, concluding the Easter season and celebrating **the beginning of the Church on earth**.
- Pentecost is the **Church's birthday** - and because you are part of the Body of Christ, it is your second birthday as well. So, Happy Birthday!
