



Hy sinh bao giờ cũng có hương thơm của hạnh phúc. Từ bỏ bao giờ cũng cho tâm hồn nét thanh cao. Hy sinh và từ bỏ là chuẩn bị luống cày cho hạt giống mọc lên. Có thể được chấp nhận hay bị từ khước. Có thể "được cả" mà cũng có thể "ngã về không". Chính cái bắp bênh trong tình yêu, trong chon lưa, mới làm bừng sáng nét cao đẹp của hy sinh, từ bỏ.

REFLECTIONS

Faith or Works?

Sometimes we think the argument of faith vs. works started with the Reformation. But the second reading shows that it was already being debated in New Testament times. The simplified version of the debate has the Reformers saying that faith alone is all we need to be saved, while the Catholic side says we have to do good to be saved. Actually, they are both right.

The idea of works being necessary for salvation probably goes back to the Old Covenant emphasis on the law and the commandments. The Jews believed that keeping the law showed their holiness. They avoided anything or anyone that was unclean. They believed that their religious practices set them apart from the pagans around them.

Then Jesus came to show that only God is Holy. Our holiness comes from loving God and loving others. Because Jesus is the Son of God, he is the best way to know God. So believing in Jesus is not just believing that he exists, (like those who believe in Santa Claus or UFO's.) It means we believe in Love, the love Jesus showed by his life and death. We believe in a Person who loves us and showed us that God is not our boss or judge; he is our Father. He gives us life and protects us; he supports us and also lets us learn from our mistakes. Then he forgives us, showing that he loves us even when we turn away from him.

So if we truly believe in Jesus we believe in what he said and did. We follow his commandment of love, not because we want to avoid evil, but because we love him so much we want to be just like him. We help others, not to make us look good, but to show them how good God is. So you cannot truly believe in Jesus without wanting to help others to know and love him too. Jesus' way of saying that in today's gospel was to take up our cross and follow him. That is truly a work of faith. Tom Schmidt

Các con bảo Thầy là ai?...

Người ta bảo Thầy là ai? Qua câu hỏi này, phải chẳng Chúa Giêsu đã khởi sư quan tâm tới dư luân của quần chúng về Ngài? Hay Ngài muốn làm một cuộc thăm dò ý kiến về kết quả công việc Ngài đã làm? Không phải là như vậy. Ở đây, Chúa Giêsu muốn chuẩn bị các môn đệ của Ngài đón nhân những điều Ngài sắp nói với các ông về điểm then chốt của sứ mang Ngài và cũng là điểm khó nuốt đối với mọi người. Dư luận, như các môn đệ ghi nhận được, tuy chưa rõ đích xác Ngài là ai nhưng cũng tỏ ra đã thấy được những điểm khác người trong giáo huấn và trong hành động của Ngài. Tuy nhiên điều Chúa Giêsu muốn nhắm tới ở đây chính là việc các môn để bày tỏ ý kiến của mình về Ngài. Do dó mà Ngài mới đạt thêm câu hỏi thứ hai: Còn các con, các con bảo Thầy là ai?

Tin không phải là lặp lại ý kiến, lập trường của kẻ khác mà là biểu lô chính ý kiến, chính lập trường của mình. Phêrô đã trả lời đúng câu hỏi Chúa Giêsu đã đặt ra: Thầy là Đức Kitô. Qua câu trả lời, Phêrô đã tuyên xưng lòng tin của ông nơi Thầy mình. Ông đã nhân ra được Thầy mình là ai.

Nhưng sư việc diễn ra sau đó lai chứng tỏ cho chúng ta thấy rằng lòng tin của Phêrô chưa tron ven. Ông mới chỉ có những hiểu biết đúng về Thầy. Thực ra, như chính Chúa Giêsu đã khẳng định, chẳng phải tư ông đã biết được Ngài là Đức Kitô, mà là do Chúa Cha mà ông biết được điều đó. Lòng tin ấy, sư hiểu biết ấy chỉ tron ven khi ông chấp nhân đi con đường Chúa Giêsu đang chuẩn bi đi tức là con đường cứu đô, con đường thập giá.

Và ở điểm này, Phêrô đã vấp ngã thất năng nề, bởi vì ông đã đi vào chương trình cứu đô của Thiên Chúa, không phải bằng cái nhìn của Thiên Chúa, hay đúng hơn, theo như Ngài hoach đinh, mà là bằng chính cái nhìn của ông, theo cách tính toán của ông. Lời can ngăn của Phêrô đã trở thành việc cản trở chương trình cứu đô

As new energy and activity begin to pick up at the parish in September let us be on the lookout for newcomers to the parish. Welcoming newcomers to your parish is not just the job of the pastoral staff, ushers, ministers of hospitality or greeters. It is everyone's responsibility. Here are ten things you can do to provide better hospitality toward those who are new to the parish.

- 1. Cultivate the virtue of hospitality at Mass. Many Mass attendees tend to gather into little cliques and ignore those who are not members of their particular clique. They are not really inhospitable, just heedless to the needs of good hospitality. Make hospitality a new habit when you go to Mass.
- 2. Come early, leave late. Instead of rushing to Mass to be there on time, and then rushing out at its conclusion, make time to come a little early and linger just a bit later. Make room in your busy life to greet and spend time with others at Mass.
- 3. "The Mass has ended," now go and greet someone! Seek out someone you've not met before. Introduce

yourself, and take a few moments to welcome them to your parish home, God's home.

Do You Welcome Visitors to Your Parish?

- 4. Welcome everyone. Not only do visitors need your warm welcome, regular Mass attendees also need a friendly greeting. Develop a good habit of greeting everyone with some enthusiasm. You are Christ's ambassador and greeting others in his name.
- **5. Help newcomers connect.** While you are getting to know visitors, introduce them to other parishioners as the opportunity presents itself. Feel free to invite newcomers to sit next to you.
- 6. Say goodbye with genuine warmth. After Mass, bid farewell to visitors, inviting them to return next week. Introduce them to the pastor if the opportunity arises.
- 7. Avoid Parish business. Avoid conducting parish business with others immediately before or after Mass. Focus on newcomers and visitors.
- 8. Give visitors information about **the parish.** Ensure that a visitor has a bulletin and other information about the parish before they leave. If there



is a social gathering after Mass, invite them to join you.

- 9. Be part of a greeting ministry or **hospitality team.** Parishes are always in need of greeters to serve regularly, and provide ongoing formation to new greeters. Help out, be a greeter. If your parish doesn't have greeters, now is a good time to start!
- 10. Greet those who already minister in the area of hospitality. It isn't necessary to neglect the people who are already ministers of hospitality in order to make newcomers feel at home. A simple wave and a smile go a long way.
