



Thấy được và đi theo Người...

Con người có các giác quan để thông tri với thế giới bên ngoài. Bất cứ một khuyết tật nào trong thân thể cũng làm cho con người bị khổ đau. Có nhiều thắc mắc chúng ta khó trả lời. Hỏi rằng: Tai sao Chúa lai để cho người này mù lòa, người kia câm điếc hay bất toại? Nếu chỉ nhìn vào cuộc sống tự nhiên, chúng ta không tìm được câu trả lời thích đáng. Chính vì thế, nhiều người cảm thấy bất hạnh. Chúa Giêsu đã đến như một nguồn ánh sáng làm cho chúng ta nhận biết được giá trị của những bất toàn trong đời sống.

Tin Mừng hôm nay tả cảnh Chúa chữa lành cho người mù ăn xin vê đường. Anh mù đến van xin Chúa rằng: Lạy Thầy, xin cho tôi được thấy. Chúa Giêsu đáp: Được, đức tin của anh đã chữa anh. Anh đã được thấy và thấy rõ hơn cả những người nghĩ mình có mắt sáng. Có một điều rất đáng chú ý là khi anh kêu to lên: "Lay ông Giê-su, Con vua Đa-vít, xin dủ lòng thương tôi!" thì liền bị đám người Pha-ri-sêu quát nạt, bảo anh ta im đi.

Ho sơ Đức Giê-su có thêm cơ hội làm phép la khiến Người nổi tiếng và có ảnh hưởng trên dân chúng nhiều hơn. Ho muốn độc quyền chiếm lĩnh cảm tình của cộng đồng. Hành động đó nào có khác chi nòi rắn độc!

Trước những con rắn độc ấy, đáng lẽ anh mù phải sợ, vì họ có quyền thế về tôn giáo. Họ có thể khiến anh bị cô lập giữa những người đồng đạo và đời anh đã khốn khổ sẽ càng thêm khốn khổ. Nhưng anh đã không sợ hãi và càng kêu lớn tiếng hơn: "Lạy Con vua Đa-vít, xin dủ lòng thương tôi!" Sự can đảm ấy

REFLECTIONS

Man of Many Talents

When you think of Jesus, what do you think was his job? Healer of the sick, the lame and the blind, as in today's gospel? Preacher? Teacher? Leader of men? Messiah? The second reading from Hebrews reminds us of his main duty: Priest. It calls him a High Priest, referring to the Jewish priesthood in which one priest was chosen each year to offer the most important sacrifices and so appeal to God for forgiveness of the peoples' sins. Now this may sound like primitive religion, but it actually lets us understand Jesus even better.

The high priest offered sacrifice for his own sins, as well as the peoples'. While Jesus did not sin, he experienced temptations just as we do and so can intercede for us as one who knows what it is like to be tempted. He also knows suffering, from his passion and death on the cross. If you ever wonder if you deserve to be forgiven, remember that Jesus died for all sinners, deserving or not. The High Priest was the one to bring the Israelites prayers to God and God's blessings to the people. Jesus also brings our prayers to his Father and shows us the Father's love.

Our baptism gives us a share in that priesthood. You don't have to be ordained to pray for your friends and family. You don't have to be a bishop to bring God's love to those around you. When you listen to a friend who is hurting, or forgive someone who hurts you, you are blessing them with God's love. When you encourage them to have faith and trust in the Lord, you are bringing them to God. You are sharing in the priesthood of Christ. Tom Schmidt
