

SACRAMENTAL CARE

Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism for infants and children under the age of seven is celebrated the 2nd Saturday of each month. Parents are to attend a 2 session preparation class which is held on the 3rd and 4th Monday of each month. Parents must attend both sessions before baptism of their child. It is recommended that the class be attended before the birth of the child. This will ensure minimal wait before their baby is baptized.

Sponsors are welcome but are not required to attend the class.

Children who have attained seven years of age are to be involved in their preparation for the sacraments. Contact the office for more information.

Anointing of the Sick: Any parishioner who is scheduled for serious surgery should receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to the hospitalization. Please contact the office to arrange for a time to celebrate the sacrament.

Parishioners in danger of death due to sickness or old age should be anointed and receive viaticum. Please contact the parish office or after-hours emergency number for the ministry of a priest.

Marriage: Couples desiring to marry in the church, please email

marriageprep@saintfaustinachurch.org at least six to nine months ahead of anticipated wedding date. Week day, evening and Saturday appointments are



available.



Part of the challenge of living as a child of God is not being able to see God, to know what God is like. Believing in God requires faith, the willingness to enter into a mystery that is timeless and yet timelyas true today as it has been throughout the ages. Placing our faith in Jesus does not require us to put rational thought behind.

Rather, in Jesus, we see God, the creator of all that is, including our intellect, the ability to understand our experience, and more. Jesus makes God visible, he is the image of the invisible God, the sign of God's determination that we not be separated from God, the one who shows us creation's ultimate purpose. When we wonder what God is like, what God desires, or how God acts, we need only look to Christ, who pours out his life in God's compassionate love.




