




St. Faustina is a community where the deep love and mercy of God is lived, experienced, and shared.



The key to aging well is planning your aging journey.


This free, three-session, two-hour per-session program will help you define your support network, aging in place or possibly making a move, healthcare decision making, getting your documents in order, and planning next steps.




