Vemos ramas de palma colgando como adornos en puertas, paredes y ventanas durante la temporada de Pascua. Esto se debe a que una rama de palma es el símbolo más significativo durante el Domingo de Ramos. Es interesante cómo de honrar a Jesús agitando ramas de palma cuando entraba en Jerusalén, los judíos una semana después se volvieron contra él e instaron a su crucifixión. Esto simplemente representa cómo nosotros, los humanos, fallamos todo el tiempo. Podemos estar tan decididos a seguir Su palabra en un momento determinado de nuestras vidas, decimos que lo amamos y confiamos en Él, luego, cuando las cosas no salen como las planeamos, comenzamos a

Sabías... Hay seis colores litúrgicos, blanco, rojo, verde, rosa, violeta y negro. La primera persona en sistematizar el esquema de colores católico romano fue el Papa Inocencio III, pontífice de 1198 a 1216, quien nombró a los primeros cuatro. Los dos últimos fueron codificados en 1570 con la promulgación del Misal Romano después del **SCAN ME** Concilio de Trento. El oro y la plata están permitidos en ocasiones especiales.

# WELCOME TO THE DEACON'S CORNER...



We see palm branches hanging as ornaments on doors, walls, and windows around the season of Easter. This is because a palm branch is the most significant symbol during Palm Sunday. It's interesting how from giving honor to Jesus by waving palm branches as he enters Jerusalem, the

Jews one week later turned against him and urged for his crucifixion. This simply represents how we, humans, fail all the time. We can be so resolute to follow His word at a certain time of our lives, we say we love and trust Him, then when things don't go the way we planned, we start to question God, doubt him, and even accuse Him. #### Did you know...

There are six liturgical colors, white, red, green, rose, violet, and black. The first person to systematize the Roman Catholic color scheme was Pope Innocent III, pontiff from 1198 to 1216, who named the first four. The last two were codified in 1570 with the promulgation of the Roman Missal after the Council of Trent. Gold and silver are allowed on special occasions.



#### MEMORIAL TO THE UNBORN STATUE

We are blessed to have a beautiful Memorial to the Unborn statue in honor of our Blessed Mother, the Virgin Mary, and in remembrance of all aborted and miscarried children.

Visit the statue on the west side of the parish learning center, depicting our Blessed Mother holding two undersized babies in her arms, glancing at them with a piercing mother's love. The Memorial was made possible through the generous support of our Knights of Columbus.








#### MARRIAGE PREPARATION


