



#### MAY 3: 33 DAYS TO MORNING GLORY BEGINS



Gospel: John 20:19-31


Adults: What could you do this week to help strengthen the faith of someone who is faltering?


# SPIRITUAL DIRECTION STRENGTHENING OUR PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD


