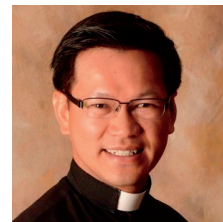

## WELCOME TO THE DEACON'S CORNER...



The word "virtue" is used as a synonym for goodness. The Church uses the term in a much more precise way. Virtues are special graces given by God to the soul for the accomplishment of particular objectives. The Church

distinguishes between two general categories of virtues: theological and moral.

Faith, hope, and charity are called theological virtues because they are the most important characteristic in a Christian's life. Moral virtues are so called because they help us live within the moral parameters described in the gospels. Chief among them are prudence, justice, temperance and fortitude. Living a virtuous life is the habit of choosing what is good and right, despite our own inclinations and disordered passions.

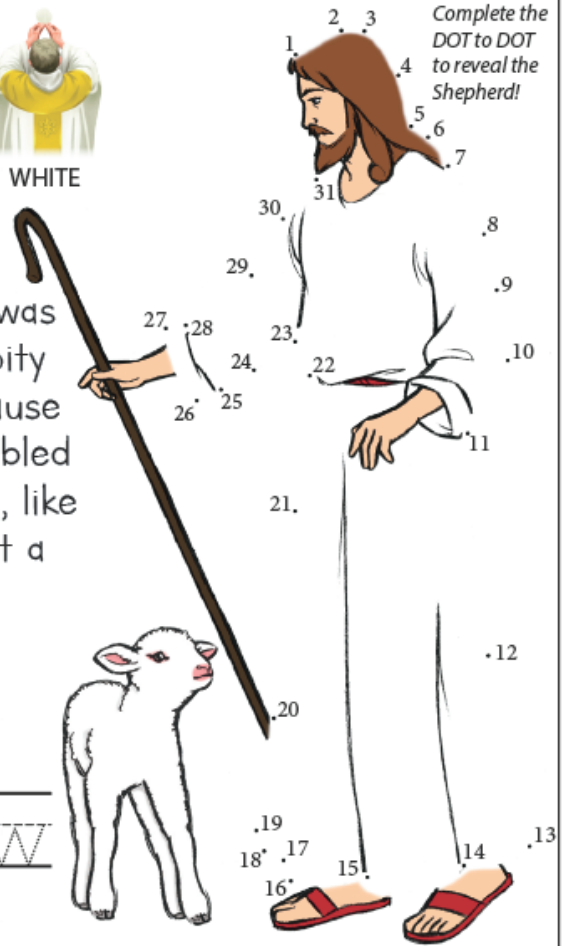

## GETTING YOUR MARRIAGE CONVALIDATED IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH



For various reasons, Catholics may find themselves in a civil marriage but never married by the Catholic Church, in a marriage that took place before a non-Catholic minister without the permission of the Catholic Church, or in a common-law marriage. It is important to have your marriage acknowledged by the Catholic Church in a ceremony that constitutes a true sacramental union. This ceremony is called a "convalidation." A convalidation involves the willingness of both husband and wife to make a new act of the will to enter into a valid Catholic marriage. If this applies to you, contact Deacon Randy at **346-773-3437** for more information and guidance.
