





GETTING YOUR MARRIAGE CONVALIDATED IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH



For various reasons, Catholics may find themselves in a civil marriage but never married by the Catholic Church, in a marriage that took place before a non-Catholic minister without the permission of the Catholic Church, or in a common-law marriage. It is important to have your marriage acknowledged by the Catholic Church in a ceremony that constitutes a true sacramental union. This ceremony is called a "convalidation." A convalidation involves the willingness of both husband and wife to make a new act of the will to enter into a valid Catholic marriage. If this applies to you, contact Deacon Randy at **346-773-3437** for more information and guidance.

Were you married and subsequently divorced?

Have you had the marriage nullified by receiving a Declaration of Nullity (annulment)? If not, and you have questions, contact Deacon Randy for more information.




