Faltar intencionalmente a la Misa dominical (es decir, no tener ganas de ir, estar demasiado cansado, hacer muchas cosas, ir de compras, tener planes de cazar o pescar, tener invitados para el fin de semana, jugar golf, podría estar fuera de la ciudad) es un pecado mortal contra El tercer mandamiento: Acordaos de santificar el día de reposo. Nuestro Catecismo dice: (2180) El precepto de la Iglesia especifica con mayor precisión la ley del Señor: "Los domingos, los fieles están obligados a participar en la Misa". Asistir a Misa todos los domingos es una forma de adorar a Dios y honrar el Día del Señor. Los pecados mortales necesitan la absolución de un sacerdote en el Sacramento de la Reconciliación lo antes posible antes de recibir la Sagrada Comunión. ¿Tu agenda dominical está demasiado llena para misa? Siempre hay la Misa de Vigilia del Sábado y si estamos fuera de la ciudad, somos una iglesia universal y ofrecemos Misa en otras ciudades. Ver desde casa puede ser necesario en circunstancias extraordinarias pero no cumple con la obligación de asistir en persona. Sentirse obligado a asistir es en sí mismo una distracción. Deberíamos desear asistir para ser alimentados por Su santa palabra, Cuerpo y Sangre.



WELCOME TO THE DEACON'S CORNER




We all experience some level of suffering. Jesus made suffering a normal part of the Christian life. We don't suffer alone. Jesus shares our pain, sustains us, and comforts us. That's the message of the cross: God's only Son became a man in Christ. In his human nature, God himself

suffered rejection, humiliation, ridicule, abandonment, scourging, crucifixion, and death. He embraced suffering so that He could console us in our suffering. When we cry, so do His eyes fill with tears.-Deacon Randy.

Did you know...

Intentionally missing Sunday Mass (i.e. don't feel like going, too tired, to much going on, going shopping, have hunting or fishing plans, have guests for the weekend, playing golf, might be out of town) is a mortal sin against the Third Commandment, Remember to keep holy the Sabbath Day. Our Catechism says, (2180) The precept of the Church specifies the law of the Lord more precisely: "On Sundays, the faithful are bound to participate in the Mass." Attending Mass every Sunday is a way of worshiping God and honoring the Lord's Day. Mortal sins need absolution from a priest at the Sacrament of Reconciliation as soon as possible before receiving Holy Communion. Your Sunday schedule too full for Mass? There is always the Saturday Vigil Mass and if out of town, we're a universal church with Mass offered in other cities. Watching from home may be necessary under extraordinary circumstances but does not fulfill the obligation to attend in person. Feeling obligated to attend is in itself a distraction. We should desire to attend in order to be fed by His holy word and Body and Blood.



Adults: Which has deepened your faith more – being treated justly or being treated with love and care? Who needs you to treat them with care this week?



GETTING YOUR MARRIAGE CONVALIDATED IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

For various reasons, Catholics may find themselves in a civil marriage but never married by the Catholic Church, in a marriage that took place before a non-Catholic minister, or in a common-law marriage. It is important to have your marriage acknowledged by the Catholic Church in a ceremony called a "convalidation." Contact Deacon Randy at **346-773-3437** for more information & guidance.




