Sabías...

Si reconocemos la Presencia Real de Jesucristo en la Misa y en el Sagrado Tabernáculo, debemos demostrar orgullo y respeto por el Dios de toda la creación que está presente en nuestra vestimenta adecuada. Se anima a los fieles a vestir ropa modesta que sea apropiada para la Casa de Dios reconociendo la celebración solemne y sagrada de la Santa Misa. La siguiente pregunta entonces es: "¿Consideramos que la Misa es lo suficientemente importante como para anular lo que "sentimos" usar y usar lo que sea apropiado"? Cada uno de nosotros responde esa pregunta cada semana. La iglesia, por supuesto, siempre preferirá que alguien esté presente en la Misa en lugar de estar ausente debido a su vestimenta. Lo que se necesita es consideración y, sobre todo, un sentido de sacralidad.

Did you know...

The Catholic Church does not have a written dress code. I was recently asked, "Is wearing shorts to Mass a good or bad thing?" If we recognize the Real Presence of Jesus Christ at Mass and in the Sacred Tabernacle, we should demonstrate pride and respect for the God of all creation who is present by our proper attire. The faithful are encouraged to wear modest fashion that is befitting for the House of God recognizing the solemn and Sacred celebration of the Holy Mass. The next question then is, "Do we consider Mass important enough to override what we "feel" like wearing and wear what is appropriate"? Each of us answers that question every week.

The church, of course, will always prefer having someone be present at Mass rather than being absent because of their attire.

What is needed is thoughtfulness and above all a sense of sacredness.

PRAYING FOR THE SOULS OF OUR LOVED ONES DURING THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER

Parishes have the custom of giving a place of honor to a book in which community members and visitors write the names of their beloved dead. The Book of the Names of Remembrance was inspired by the ancient practice of recording the dates of the deaths of loved ones in a necrology, a public record or registry of death. This practice provides the living with an opportunity for healing and consolation in the face of grief. The Book of the Names of the Dead will be displayed from the solemnity of All Saints until the beginning of Advent. It is left open for people to write the names of their deceased loved ones and for others to read the names, remember, and pray for the repose of their souls.

Remembering all of these men and women who have gone before us, "marked with the sign of faith," helps us better understand and appreciate our faith in the Christ our risen Lord, who conquers sin and death and brings new life to all.

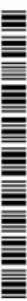

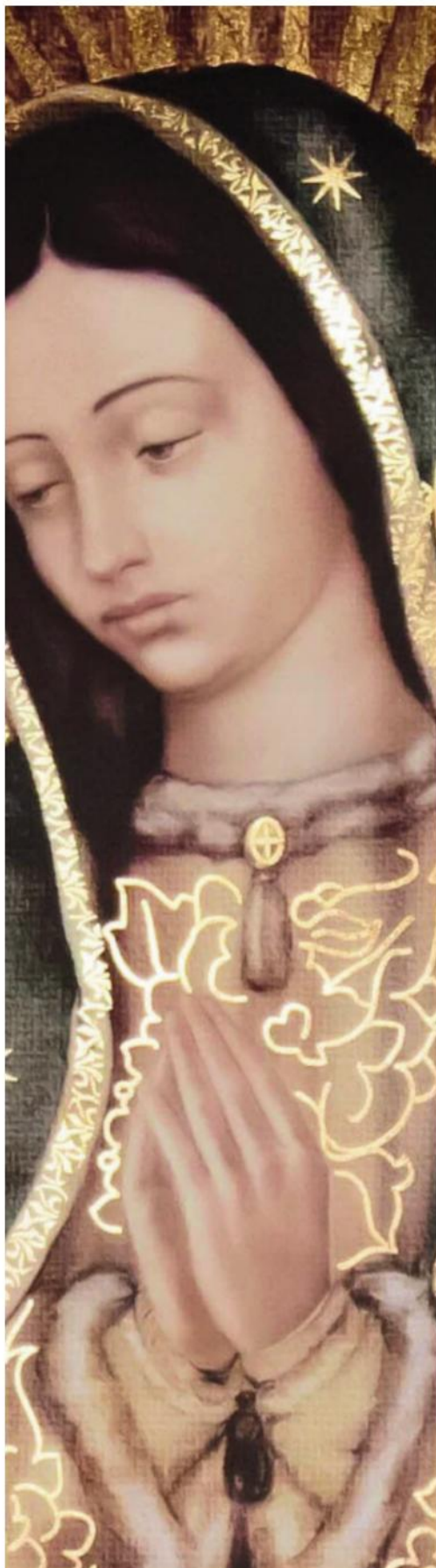
