Sabías...

Hay tres rangos de celebraciones litúrgicas (Misas): Solemnidades, Fiestas y Memoriales. Las solemnidades, el rango más alto, son como los domingos, aunque la mayoría de solemnidades no son días de precepto. Se requieren el Gloria y el Credo. Las fiestas son el siguiente rango y consisten en celebrar a ciertos santos o a la mayoría de los Apóstoles. Se requiere el Gloria, pero no el Credo. Los memoriales son el rango más bajo y son simplemente las celebraciones de la mayoría de los santos. El Gloria y el Credo no son obligatorios. La mayoría de las veces, la misa diaria es un memorial.



Did you know...

There are three ranks of liturgical celebrations (Masses): Solemnities, Feasts, and Memorials. Solemnities, the highest rank, are like Sundays, although most Solemnities are not days of obligation. The Gloria and Creed are required. Feasts are the next rank down and consist of celebrating certain saints or most of the Apostles. The Gloria is required, but not the Creed. Memorials are the lowest rank and are simply the celebrations of most of the saints. The Gloria and Creed are not required. Most often daily mass is a memorial.

HOUSTON VOCATIONS: A LOOK INTO THE PRIESTHOOD



In 2023, 12 young men joined the seminary for the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston. Each man studies between 7-9 years before being ordained a transitional deacon and then, God willing, a priest. To the left is an image of St. Mary's Seminary, located on Memorial Drive.

Seminary is broken up into four stages: propaedeutic, discipleship, configuration, and vocational synthesis. The propaedeutic stage lasts about one year. The term comes from a Greek word meaning "before studies". Typically, a young man works at a parish while in this stage. The discipleship stage can last between 2-4 years. By the end of this stage, those who are sure of their calling from God to be a priest receive the installation as a candidate for Holy Orders. The configuration stage is about 3.5-4.5 years long. The focus of this stage is to live out their vocation to holiness during the last few years of seminary. At the end of this stage, seminarians graduate from seminary and are ordained transitional deacons. The last 6 months of formation is called the vocational synthesis stage. These men serve as deacons in parishes transitioning from seminary life to full-time ministry in the diocese.



Studies have shown that more than 70% of priests were former altar servers. This shows the importance of young men serving at the altar assisting the priest, being involved in one of the greatest moments on earth: the Mass.

What do you do at your parish and within your family to foster a culture of vocations? Have you ever considered asking a young person what mission God is calling them to rather than what they want to be when they grow up? Teaching the youth to listen and respond to God's voice will change the world. How do you do that? We suggest prayer and silence.

To the right are some of the men who entered seminary in June 2023. The Office of Vocations receives most applicants in the Spring, thoroughly reviews their application, set up interviews, then, pending the Cardinal's approval, are officially seminarians of the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston. Did you know you can go to seminary right after high school? Some of the young men who have not yet attended college go to Holy Trinity in Dallas for their first few years of seminary to earn their undergraduate degree in philosophy.

The Importance of Parental Reverence

"In 1959, in Houston, they had 100 seminarians (men studying to be priests). That's the most we've had since then even though the population of Catholics has increased by almost 500%. We now have 46 seminarians and 1.7 million Catholics.

There is no Eucharist without priests, so if you care at all about having the Eucharist in the future, something needs to change. I think the solution might be simpler than we think. I asked my dad once what he thought was the best thing parents could do to encourage vocations. He said parents should receive communion with reverence. He's right. If we receive communion like it's just a piece of bread, why would a young man give up his life for that? Why give up everything and be celibate for a piece of bread? But, if we receive the Eucharist with the reverence it deserves, as the True Body of Jesus, then a young man will see that too. I would especially challenge fathers. You will have the greatest spiritual influence on your children. Your sons need to see that the Eucharist is the most important thing in your life based on your example. Your sons need to know that the Eucharist will be worth giving their life for."

Get out of God's way. PRAYING FOR THE SOULS OF OUR LOVED ONES DURING THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER

Parishes have the custom of giving a place of honor to a book in which community members and visitors write the names of their beloved dead. The Book of the Names of Remembrance was inspired by the ancient practice of recording the dates of the deaths of loved ones in a necrology, a public record or registry of death. This practice provides the living with an opportunity for healing and consolation in the face of grief. The Book of the Names of the Dead will be displayed from the solemnity of All Saints until the beginning of Advent. It is left open for people to write the names of their deceased loved ones and for others to read the names, remember, and pray for the repose of their souls.

Remembering all of these men and women who have gone before us, "marked with the sign of faith," helps us better understand and appreciate our faith in the Christ our risen Lord, who conquers sin and death and brings new life to all.


