### A MESSAGE FROM FR. DEPALMA

With about a week and a half to go before the start of Lent with Ash Wednesday, sometimes it pays to start a bit early to prepare for this great and sacred season. So preparation for Lent does not have to be all that involved but can be done guite nicely with these following suggestions. First, in a spirit of prayer, ask the Holy Spirit to help you take inventory of your life. Be very honest before our Lord and seek out the aspects of your life that either need changing, need adjustment or need a complete pruning away from your self. Like for example, maybe you are good at doing your prayers and devotions but you feel that you are lacking or that you are not totally being filled up. Well ask the Lord to show you what to change to receive the fullness of grace during your prayer time. It might be taking on a consecration or a novena or making a better effort to either attend or to watch Mass on a daily basis if you are not already doing that. And it would certainly involve going to confession. Or when it comes to an adjustment, an example of that would be for some that they periodically may do an examination of conscience. Well perhaps this Lent an examination can be done daily or perhaps at a time other than right before going to sleep when it might be difficult. But the main thing to work with the Holy Spirit when it comes to our preparation for Lent is to get ready to let the Holy Spirit start to prune, if not totally cut away the areas in our lives that we no longer need: our bitterness, our hard-headedness or hard-heartedness, our prejudice, our unforgiveness, our tendency to gossip or to fall into bickering or lust and everything else that is getting in the way of ourselves and the full presence of our Lord Jesus.

If you can work with the Holy Spirit in getting a list of the things that you need to let go of, then when Lent starts up in just a few more days, then you can hit the ground running to having not only a blessed and fruitful Lent, but you will be totally ready to receive a brand new life, a life ready to be filled with the blessings of the Resurrection come this Easter.

### WALKING WITH MOMS IN NEED: NEW RESOURCES POSTED!


