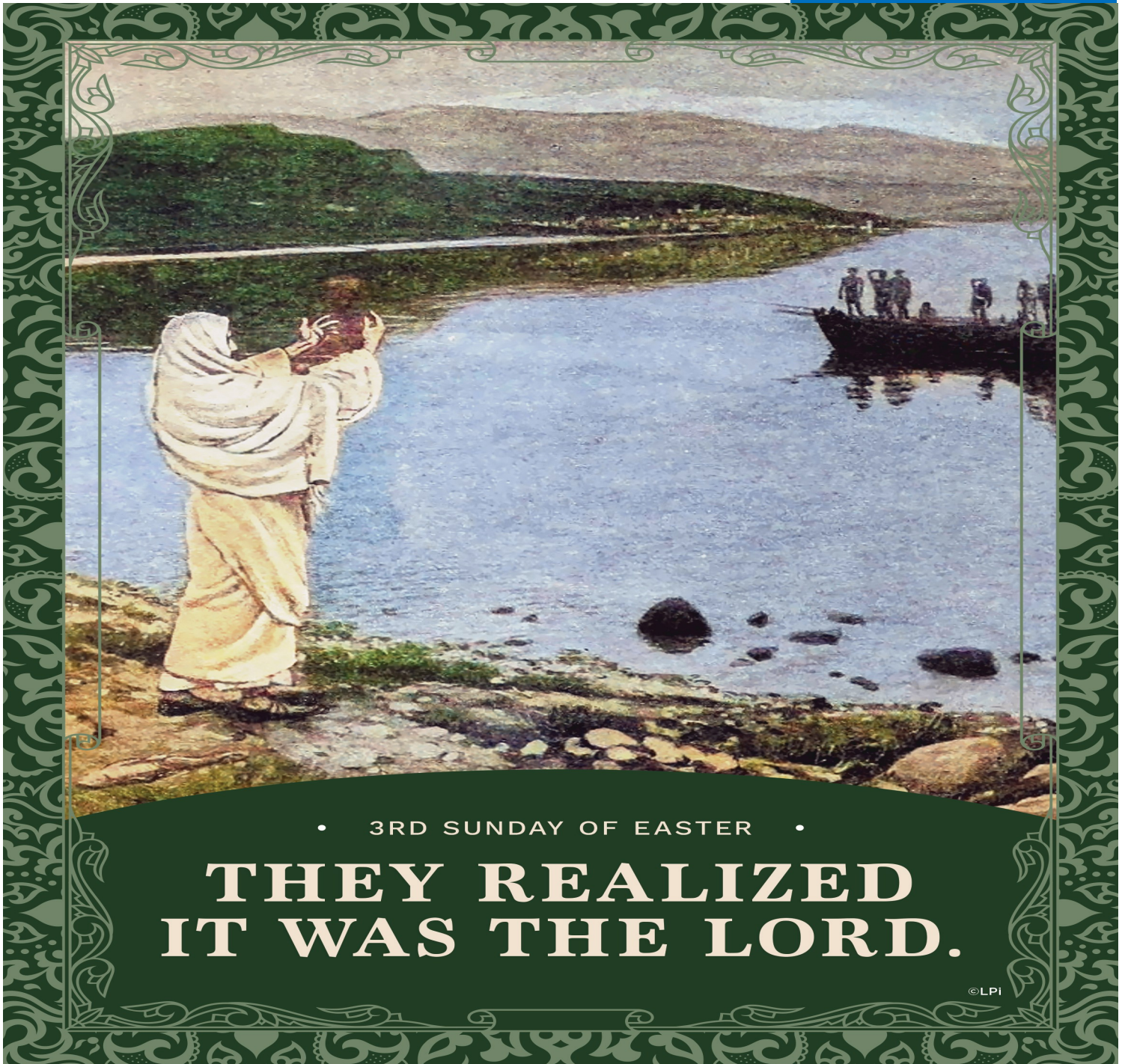

A MESSAGE FROM FR. DEPALMA

Well, the purple is put away for Lent, the gold and lilies are also now taken away from our sanctuary and here we find ourselves in May! May! The month of graduations and weddings and school semesters that come to an end. And, we are looking at the election of a new pope as we prepare to enter more deeply into this month, another change that's taking place, but overall as we still have plenty of time to celebrate, as we are still very much in the Season of Easter for the next several weeks, we have to remember a couple of things. First, and I mention this from time to time in the confessional as part of the advice that I give, but combine the discipline of Lent with the joy of Easter, and add the mercy of God as well that we celebrated just last week with Divine Mercy Sunday and what do we have? The ability to not miss a single blessing that comes to us from God despite whatever changes we have to face, whether that be changes in what we have to do or even the changing of months and seasons. Transitions in life can be many things. Some transitions are exciting and new: the birth of a child, taking a dream job, achieving a goal like graduating from high school or college. Other transitions can be very hard. We find ourselves in a good place, things humming along, and—WHAM!—change is thrust upon us: the death of a friend or relative, the loss of a relationship, the loss of a job. As we journey through change, however perceived, there are temptations that we must resist in order to discover Christ's love in our midst. Ultimately, we come to realize that regardless of the values that we assign to transitions in life, the Holy Spirit offer us a promise of life solidified in Christ and in the love of God the Father. As long as we allow the full presence of the Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit to be our anchor, to be the great foundation of our lives then no matter what it is that we have to face, we will not fall to pieces we will continue to be blessed to be uplifted by our God. Just keep in mind this wonderful quote from St. John Henry Newman: "To live is to change. To be perfect is to have changed often." Day by day, week by week, God is working with us to change us bit by bit. Sometimes it's a major change like the graduation of some of our collegians, but so very often it's our loving and merciful Lord working with us, changing us a little at a time, making sure that we are on that way of being perfect, of being a saint. So let us not freak out that May is here! Let us rejoice. It's still the Easter season, God is still with us and God still loves us so much that He is not content keeping us sitting still, we move, we follow, we change with Him day by day. And don't forget, May is the month of our Lady, the Blessed Virgin Mary. She has us covered as well!

encounter today.

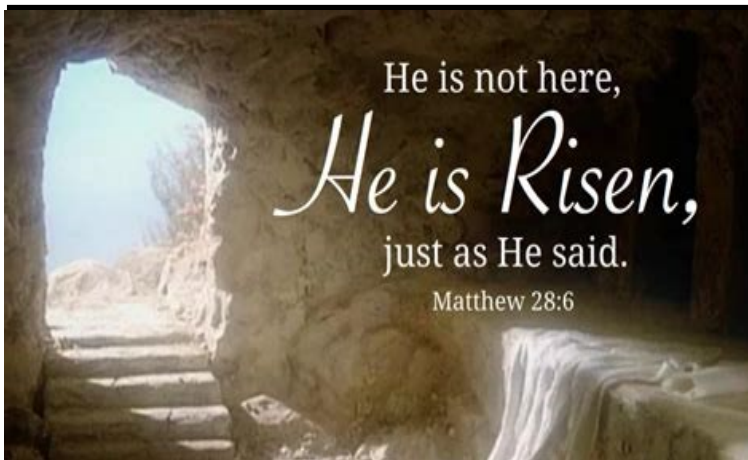
But you Lord, are aware of everything

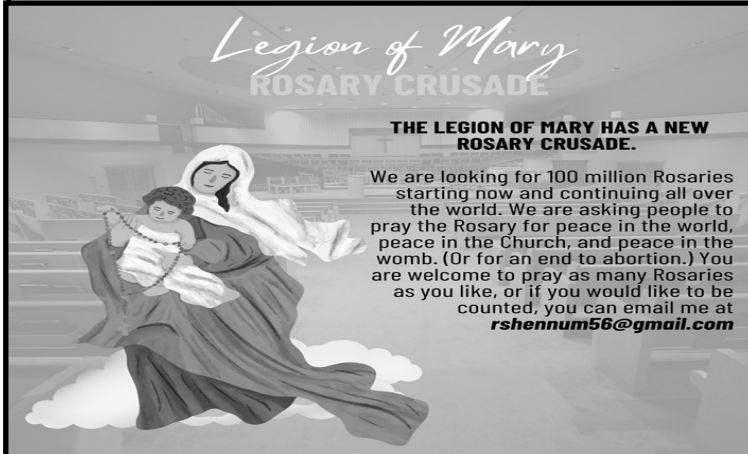
