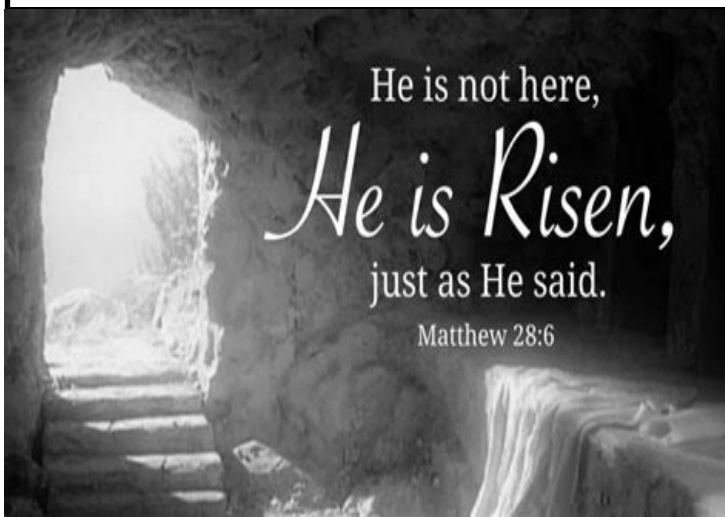

A MESSAGE FROM FR. DEPALMA

Well, since the word is out that I will be assigned to Our Lady of Fatima effective July 10th, please keep myself and Fr. Adrian in your prayers that the transition will go as smoothly as possible. Since I have only seven more Sundays with you all, over the next few weeks in the bulletin column I'll be giving you some reflections on my time here and how it's been quite the time of my life being with you all here at the Newman Center. But for now, with one more week to go before we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of our Lord, we have in our Gospel this weekend Jesus' great exhortation that though he will soon be going away, that the Father will send the Holy Spirit to be with us, and then right after that Jesus tells us, "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give to you." So that should tell you right there what the peace of God, the peace of our Lord really is all about. It's a lot more than a sense of serenity, or of things lining up, or of a sense of calm and that everything will be fine. That is because sometimes we don't have a sense of serenity because things are going crazy in our lives. Sometimes we don't have a sense of calm because of all of the people that we have to pray for or all of the things that we still have to get done and haven't even started yet. Sometimes things aren't going fine, and yet we are blessed by our Lord with his peace. So it can only mean what? It's him. Jesus is our peace; his presence in our lives, especially in our hearts and souls is our peace. And that "Advocate" the Holy Spirit, will remind us of all that Jesus did for us and will do for us. So one of the things that we all need to start praying for and preparing for is the upcoming feast of Pentecost which will be here in just two more weeks. Prepare now for a great, fresh, and powerful outpouring of the Holy Spirit in your lives so that not only can you always keep your peace, but so that you can show others how to keep theirs.
