FR MICHAEL VILLAVICENCIO

SUMMER PAROCHIAL VICAR

Father Michael was born and raised in Albuquerque, NM and was a lifelong parishioner of Risen Savior Catholic Church. He was homeschooled alongside his two brothers throughout grade school, graduating in 2016 from Seton HomeStudy school. He grew up playing baseball, flyfishing, and he taught himself about music and how to play the organ. Through his education and family upbringing, he became interested in priestly ministry from a young age. As a family, he went to daily Mass and became involved in altar serving as well as sacristan work during his high school years. The example from many priests throughout this time in Father Michael's discernment helped him to develop a love for liturgy and prayer, which contributed to his decision to enter seminary. In August 2016, he went to Assumption Seminary in San Antonio, TX. After graduating from there in 2020, he was sent to the Theological College, the National Seminary of the Catholic University of America in Washington, DC. During his time there, Father Michael took a pastoral internship year, serving at Our Lady of the Annunciation Parish in Albuquerque, NM. He graduated from CUA in 2024 with a Baccalaureate in Sacred Theology and was ordained a deacon on May 16, 2024. In August 2024, he began a two-year study program for the Licentiate in Sacred Theology through the Pontifical John Paul II Institute for studies in marriage and family. In August 2025, he will return to DC to finish his degree. His research includes Christology and the relationship of Christ to human fatherhood, particularly how the father is an image of Christ's sonship within the family.
