




## **BAPTISM**



## new a newman 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time September 7, 2025




My name is Obiesie Kevin Akanna. I was born on 21 April 1987 into the family of Nicholas and Christiana Obiesie of Amuleri village, Ichida in Anaocha local government area of Anambra State. I was born in Aba, Abia state, Nigeria. I am the sixth child of seven. I had four elder sisters and two brothers. Chika, Afoma, Chizoba, Ukamaka, Okwuchukwu and Chibuike. I have strong relationship and connection with my parents and siblings; we love, respect and sacrifice for each other. My parents taught me how to say the rosary and other catholic prayers even before I turned 10 years old. They provided for me and most especially allowed me and supported my desire of entering the formation to the priesthood I was just eleven years at that time. My dad wanted me to become a medical doctor but he saw my passion and zeal to serve as a priest. He supported me till his death in 2018.

I did my primary school at Christopher Memorial schools in Aba from 1993 -1999 and high school at Annunciation Seminary Amaudara from 1999-2005. My choice of seminary high school was solely based on my desire to become a catholic priest. I had other options like the Navy College and Federal government science school which I passed their entrance exams before I got admission into the seminary. The experience in the high school seminary was very tough; leaving home to live by myself in the hostel at the age of twelve was my parent's greatest fear but my courage gave them strength. After I graduated high school, I went for one year apostolic assignment at St Leo the Great catholic secondary school in Abia State where I served as the bursar and teacher from 2006-2007. In 2007, I was sent to St Mary's spiritual year seminary as part of my formation process. I entered Seat of Wisdom Major Seminary (an Affiliate Institute of Imo State University Owerri) in September 2008 and graduated with a Bachelor's degree in Philosophy in 2012. I did my degree in Theology in the same seminary in 2012 until 2015. In 2016, I travelled to the United States of America to study Public Administration in Grand Valley State University, Michigan. The desire to become a priest didn't end, and this made me to apply to the Archdiocese. I got admitted into the Archdiocese of Santa Fe, New Mexico and thereafter, was sent to study at the Pontifical College Josephinum, Columbus, Ohio.

I studied at the Josephinum from 2017-2018. Because I was required to renew my student visa, I left the United States for Nigeria. Unfortunately, the visa was not approved. In 2022, I was sent to Pontifical North American College, Rome, where I studied Theology at the Licentiate level. I was finally ordained a priest las May and served as Parochial Vicar at Santa Maria de La Paz in Santa Fe for the past two months. I am now delighted to serve the Archdiocese of Santa Fe as your Parochial Vicar!






