





Christmas is Just Getting Started

DID YOU KNOW CHRISTMAS ISN'T JUST ONE DAY?

THE CHURCH CELEBRATES IT FOR EIGHT! IN THE CHURCH, AN OCTAVE IS AN EIGHT-DAY CELEBRATION OF A GREAT FEAST. FOR CHRISTMAS, THAT MEANS THE JOY OF THE NATIVITY CONTINUES OR EIGHT FULL DAYS--FROM DECEMBER 25 THROUGH JANUARY 1.



EACH DAY OF THE OCTAVE IS CELEBRATED AS IF IT WERE CHRISTMAS DAY ITSELF!

THE CHURCH GIVES US EIGHT DAYS TO PONDER THE WONDER OF THE INCARNATION--GOD MADE FLESH, DWELLING AMONG US. THE CHRISTMAS OCTAVE INVITES US TO REST, REJOICE, AND REFLECT ON THE MYSTERY OF THE INCARNATION--GOD MADE MAN FOR OUR SALVATION.

BUT THERE IS MORE:

ON THE TRADITIONAL LITURGICAL CALENDAR, THE CHRISTMAS SEASON (ALSO KNOWN AS CHRISTMASTIDE) **LASTS 40 DAYS (DECEMBER 25TH - FEBRUARY 2ND).** IT BEGINS WITH THE VIGIL MASS SAID ON CHRISTMAS EVE, WE THEN HAVE:

- THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD, CELEBRATED ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 4TH
- THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 11TH
- JESUS' PRESENTATION IN THE TEMPLE (CANDLEMAS) MONDAY, FEBRUARY 2ND

CELEBRATE THE CHRISTMAS SEASON:

- ATTEND MASS: CONTINUE TO CELEBRATE CHRISTMAS BY ATTENDING MASS DURING THE OCTAVE.
- PRAY DAILY: INCORPORATE DAILY PRAYERS, PERHAPS RECITING THE LITANY TO THE CHILD JESUS OR THE "GLORIA" AT MASS, AND REFLECT ON THE DAILY READINGS.
- HONOR THE SAINTS: LEARN ABOUT AND PRAY FOR THE INTERCESSION OF SAINTS CELEBRATED DURING THE OCTAVE.
- VISIT THE CRIB: SET UP A NATIVITY SCENE AND VISIT IT DAILY FOR QUIET PRAYER, PERHAPS LIGHTING A CANDLE OR PLACING THE BABY JESUS FIGURE.
