Team Leader Report Dave Cushing

- 1. Through our discussions with Hispanic Ministry at Queen of Peace, we now have a single policy governing preparation requirements for children's sacraments. Both Anglo and Latino children may now be enrolled in preparation for first Reconciliation and first Communion without a previous year of religious education.
- 2. We in initiated a new process for faith formation registration this spring by sitting down with families and identifying all of the faith formation and sacrament preparation needs at one time. We are hoping to avoid the need for multiple registrations for separate programs which has caused a lot of confusion for families.
- 3. We are taking various steps in our efforts to continue to develop and clarify the working relationship between the parishes and Faith Formation:
- a) individual Team members have now been assigned to attend parish staff meetings on a regular basis, replacing the process by which Team members rotated from one staff meeting to another.
- b) we will be meeting in May with the Administrative Assistants in the parishes to discuss concerns and issues they may have and to clarify their role in guiding parishioners to the appropriate Faith Formation Team member.

- c) we have initiated a discussion with WPL about how we envision the relationship between Faith Formation and the parishes, particularly the services which parish-based faith formation leaders previously provided to the parish and parish staff.
- d) we will be meeting in May with representatives of the parish staffs to coordinate parish and faith formation calendars for the coming school year.
- 4. We have reviewed Team members' job descriptions and postponed making any recommendations for adjustments until next year.
- 5. The Team is working currently on calendaring for the coming year
