Children and Family Catechesis Kelleryn Rauzi (Maternity Leave) Submitted by Dave Cushing

- 1. Catechist Appreciation. The year-end appreciation for religious education catechists will be held May 31 at Old Chicago.
- 2. Registrations for Summer and Fall. Registration information has been mailed to families currently enrolled in religious education and families with children who are not enrolled in either RE or Catholic School. In-person registrations were held May 17 at Sacred Heart and May 21 at Blessed Sacrament; in-person registration for Spanish-speaking families were scheduled May 14 and June 4 at Queen of Peace. In-person registration for fall religious education programs will be scheduled in August.

- April 30: Topic Night: "Why do bad things happen?": Discussion night focusing on how there seems to be so much bad stuff happening. We talked a lot about focusing on the good and how we can use prayer to center us. 16 students attended. (prayer, catechesis)

- May 7: Tough Topic Night: Always good discussion. This time we focused a lot on living together
 before marriage, gay marriage and Donald Trump. Students are told they can speak freely, but must
 be respectful of each other's opinions. I use the YouCat as my guide to what the church says about
 topics that are discussed. 23 students attended. (advocacy, catechesis, prayer)

First Sacraments -

- First Communion Masses at the parishes went well. First Communion pictures have been received from the photographer and were either delivered through school or made available for pick up at parish offices.
- 12 parents completed the First Communion Preparation evaluation survey. This asked about the preparation process only parent meetings, process for at-home involvement, materials used, retreat, etc. All responses fell in the "Strongly Agree" or "Agree" categories when asked if the preparation elements were helpful and effective. On average two-thirds of respondents replied "Strongly Agree."

Children's Initiation

Will work this summer on organizing materials for high school CI classes. I've doing these with
individuals and small groups on an "as needed" basis and have found it necessary to have a sequenced
syllabus.

Confirmation

- "Wrap-up" meeting and celebration with Confirmation Team was held May 24. Overall the Team
 members were pleased with how the preparation program and the April 2 liturgy went. At this point it
 sounds like all team members (Deacon Ray Larsen, Vanessa Gomez, Chris and Carrie Evans) will help
 again next year.
- Newly Confirmed were invited to complete an evaluation survey. Only 9 did so, but results from those
 were favorable. The Confirmation celebration received especially high ratings. Comments indicated
 that favorite sessions for the students were the retreat and the classes that Sponsors attended.
 Team will use the information and comments when planning preparation classes for next year.
