

FAITH FORMATION

FEAST OF ST. FRANCIS DE SALES PATRON OF AUTHORS, JOURNALISTS, WRITERS, DEAFNESS

MONDAY, JANUARY 24



St. Francis de Sales was born in 1567 in the Savoy region of France. He studied rhetoric, the humanities and law in preparation for a political career. He abided by religious celibacy and had a deep devotion to the Virgin Mary but he kept his spiritual life secret from the world.

This devotion clashed with the wishes of his father who had arranged a marriage for him. The Bishop of Geneva found Francis de Sales a position in the Swiss Church, leading to his ordination as a priest in 1593. He was named Bishop of Geneva in 1602 after which he worked to restore Geneva's churches and religious orders. He helped St. Jean Frances de Chantal establish a women's religious order – the Sisters of the Visitation. He died in 1622, was canonized in 1665, and named a Doctor of the Church in 1877. He wrote two well-known books, the *Introduction to the Devout Life* and *A Treatise on the Love of God*. For his writings he has been named patron of the Catholic Press.

CONVERSION OF ST. PAUL, APOSTLE TUESDAY, JANUARY 25



St. Paul the Apostle was the greatest of the early Christian missionaries. He first appears in the Acts of the Apostles under the name of Saul. Saul was raised in the Jewish faith as a Pharisee trained in the strict observance of God's Law. Saul was upset by the early Christian Church, believing that the early Christians had broken away

from their Jewish traditions. He actively persecuted the Church in Jerusalem. As the first Christian martyr Stephen was being stoned to death, Saul watched the cloaks of the persecutors (Acts 7:58). After his first missionary journeys, Paul was called by Jesus to proclaim the Gospel to the Gentiles. He spent the rest of his life journeying on his missions, establishing local churches, and writing to them when he heard of their accomplishments and failures. Paul's letters are the earliest records of the life and history of the early Church. As inspired by the Holy Spirit, Paul's letters are part of the Canon of the New Testament. As a record of the happenings in the early Church, they are in invaluable record of the expansion of Christianity.

FEAST OF ST. THOMAS AQUINAS PATRON OF STUDENTS & UNIVERSITIES FRIDAY, JANUARY 28



By universal consent, St. Thomas Aquinas is the preeminent spokesman of the Catholic tradition of reason and of divine revelation. He is one of the great teachers of the medieval Catholic Church, honored with the titles Doctor of the Church and Angelic Doctor.

His greatest contribution to the Catholic Church is his writings. The unity, harmony, and continuity of faith and reason, of revealed and natural human knowledge, pervades his writings. The Summa Theologiae, his last and, unfortunately, uncompleted work, deals with the whole of Catholic theology. He stopped work on it after celebrating Mass on December 6, 1273. When asked why he stopped writing, he replied, "I cannot go on.... All that I have written seems to me like so much straw compared to what I have seen and what has been revealed to me."

His original Feast Day was March 7, the day of his death, but because the date often falls within Lent, in 1969, a revision of the Roman Calendar changed his Feast Day to January 28, the date his relics were moved to the Church of the Jacobins, Toulouse. Pope Pius V declared St. Thomas a Doctor of the Church, saying Thomas was "the most brilliant light of the Church."

On October 17, 2021, the Archdiocese of Newark, launched the first step in participating in the worldwide Synod of the Catholic Church initiated by Pope Francis.

Our parish, Church of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, along with 212 other parishes in this Archdiocese, will be joining the process. We have established a Synod Team and will be sharing our plans with you over the next months.

First, what is a Synod? A Catholic Synod is typically a gathering of bishops, under the authority of the Pope, to discuss and make pastoral decisions for the universal church. This Synod is quite different because it begins by reaching out to all Catholics in parishes throughout the world. We are being asked to share our experiences within our parish, and our hopes for our parishes and the whole Church in this millennium, as we grow in faith and invite others to join us on the journey, especially (as Pope Francis has reminded us) "those at the margins or who feel excluded."

We will be holding group listening sessions in February and March. We encourage all to participate, both active parishioners and those who have drifted away. The sessions will begin by invoking the Holy Spirit to inspire all to respond honestly to several questions that will be posed at each session. In the meantime, please pray with us and the whole church by saying the Synod Prayer which can be found on the prayer card at the end of each pew in Church.

Please watch for updates and join us. This is a "once in a generation moment" that Pope Francis is offering to us. We hope you will be a part of our Synod Journey!

Our Parish has now embarked on this journey, and we have put together a Synod Team to spearhead the initiative. You will be hearing from them, as in today's Bulletin, over the next couple weeks to set-up sessions to hear your "voices". Now is the time, to voice your thoughts, opinions – good and bad, suggestions and ideas to shape the future of our Church. If you would like to join the Synod Team, or have any questions at this time, please email parishcouncil@ihmcmahwah.org. Please stay tuned for next steps.

This weekend, the Archdiocese of Newark will launch the 2022 Annual Appeal campaign. We will see this year's video at all Masses. 
