The Holy Rosary will be prayed before the Vigil Mass in church beginning at 4:00 P.M. the first Saturday of each month. Please join us.

In approximately 1583, the religious sister You Need to Know: Ursula Benincasa founded the Contemplative Sisters of the Immaculate Conception now known as the Order of the Theatine Sisters of the Immaculate Conception (Ursula was the relative of St. Catherine of Siena). The habit worn by her sisters was revealed to her in a vision. It was to honor the Immaculate Conception of Our Blessed Mother. For wearing this, God promised many graces and blessings for the religious order. Mother Ursula, now Venerable Ursula, requested these same graces and blessings for all who would wear a small blue scapular of the Immaculate Conception with the intent of securing the conversion of sinners. Mother Ursula produced and distributed the original scapulars after they were blessed. On one side of the scapular is an image of the Immaculate Conception. The other side of the scapular has Mary's name. The scapular's use was approved by Pope Clemet X in 1671. A Confraternity, later an archconfraternity, was established in the Theatine Church of St. Andrea della Valls in Rome in honor of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin and Mother of God, Mary. The confraternity members are invested with the blue scapular. This is yet another way we can serve God and honor Our Blessed Mother—and it's something you need to know.
