Happy Father's Day! Sunday, June 21

I had a chat with a Texan's senior lady, (an elderly woman), and our discussion moved to family, which made me to ask her the question: "Do you think that a family needs a Father, in other words, a Father-figure-head in the family?" Her response was not only powerful, but also was very convincing! She says, "Hell why not! You better believe it!" The wisdom of the senior lady's response is loaded with deep meaning and we cannot afford to sacrifice the importance of the truth that her response encompassed at the altar of asking why she should use the term "Hell". When a Texan's lady says, "Hell why not", you can take her word to the bank - because she means "Absolutely ohh yes!" So, Father's Day, is not only to buy gifts for our husbands and dads, it definitely goes beyond the material things and embraces virtues that our husbands and dads ought to possess. Father means the one who loves, cares and protects. Jesus Christ reminds his apostles, "Just as the Father has loved me, so I have loved you. So abide in my love." (John 15:9) A father who loves his wife and children, will lead them to Christ through the Church. He invites his wife and children for night prayer; he develops from the early marriage period, the culture to attend Mass on Sunday - keeping Holy, the Holy Day of obligation; encouraging his family to take advantage of God's mercy at the sacrament of Reconciliation. The Love that Our Lord speaks about is a true love that flows from the Heart of God the Father.
